MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

JUNE, 2026

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of June 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of May and June 2026;

- The daily average prison population increased by 0.8% from 81,224 to 81,874 prisoners;
- Convicts decreased by 0.3% from 43,619 to 43,487 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 2.1% from 36,883 to 37,640 prisoners;
- Civil debtors increased by 3.5% from 722 to 747 debtors;
- Proportion of remand prisoners increased by 0.6% from 45.4% to 46.0%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.2% from 348.1% to 349.3%;
- Prisons holding capacity increased by 0.4% (103) from 23,334 to 23,437 prisoners.

To note also is that, during the month of June 2026;

- A total of 2,292 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 96 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 40,438 – *a daily average of 2,022 prisoners*;
- 12,873 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 9,049 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- During FY2025/26, prison escape rate was 2.9 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate was 54.2%, while mortality rate stood at 2.2 per 1,000 prisoners;
- Overall, staff strength was 14,798 with male staff accounting for 10,288 (69.5%) and female staff accounting for 4,510 (30.5%);
- 11,836 (82.7%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the FY2025/26 was 300 staff including 21 staff for the month of June 2026.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of June 2026, the overall daily average prison population increased by 0.8% (650) from 81,224 in May 2026 to 81,874 prisoners.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 0.3% from 43,619 to 43,487;
- Remands increased by 2.1% from 36,883 to 37,640;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 3.5% from 722 to 747;
- Prisons holding capacity increased by 0.4% (103) from 23,334 to 23,437 prisoners. This resulted from completion of 02 new prison wards each of capacity 36 prisoners and renonation of 01 ward of capacity 31 prisoners at UG. Prison Isimba.
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.2% from 348.1% to 349.3%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

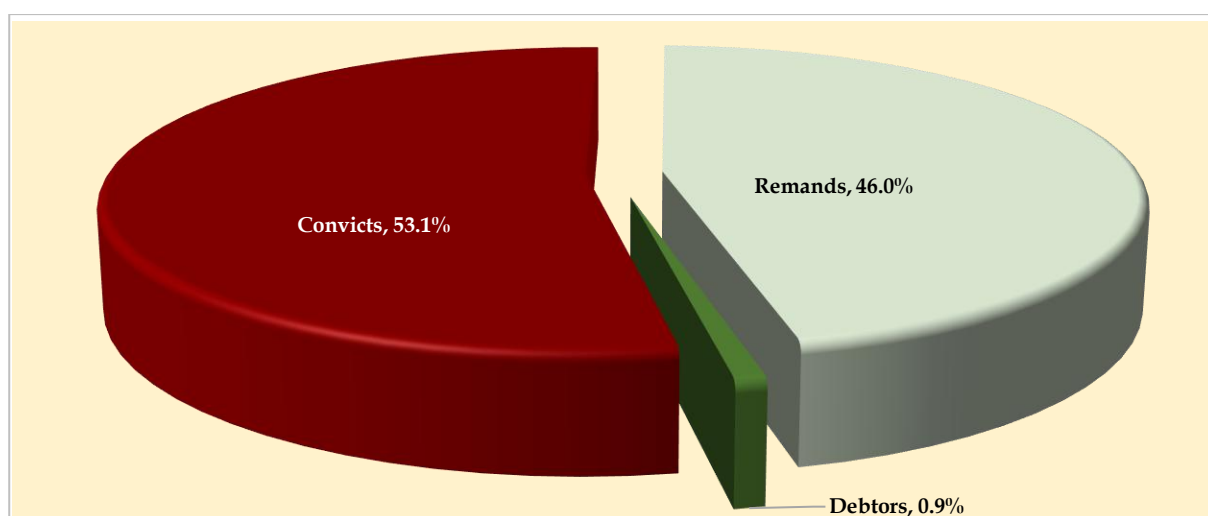


Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of June 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 53.1%, remand prisoners composed of 46.0%, while civil debtors composed of 0.9%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

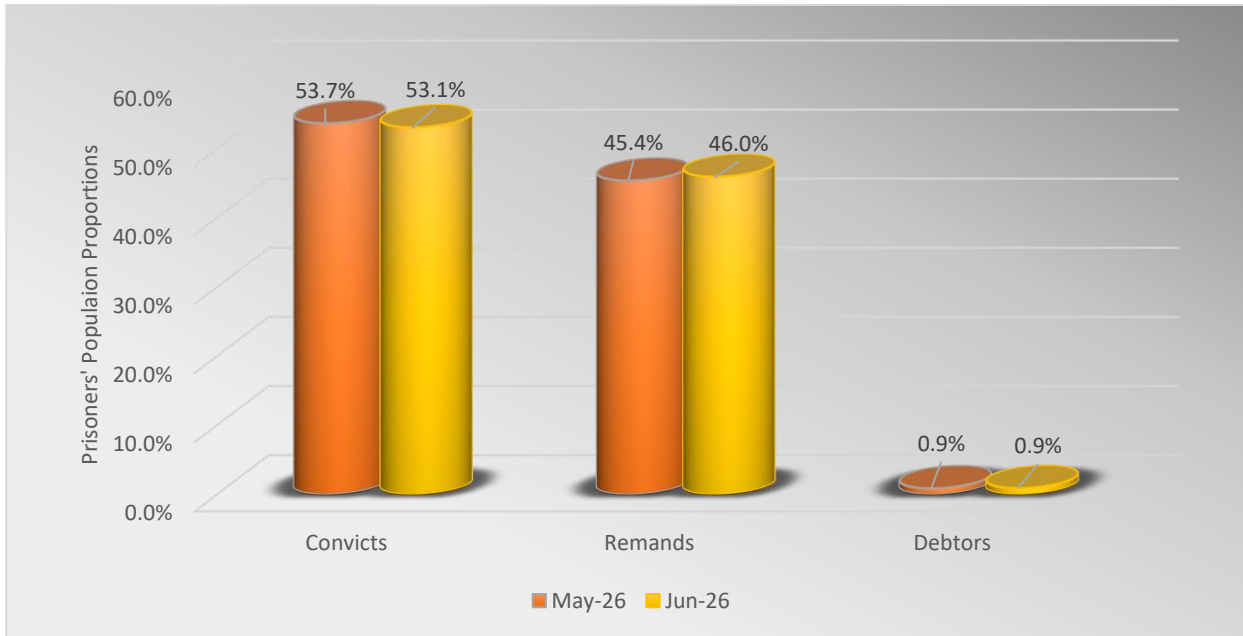


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of May 2026, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 53.7% to 53.1%, remand prisoners increased by 0.6% from 45.4% to 46.0% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.9%; of the daily average prison population in June 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the FY2025/26

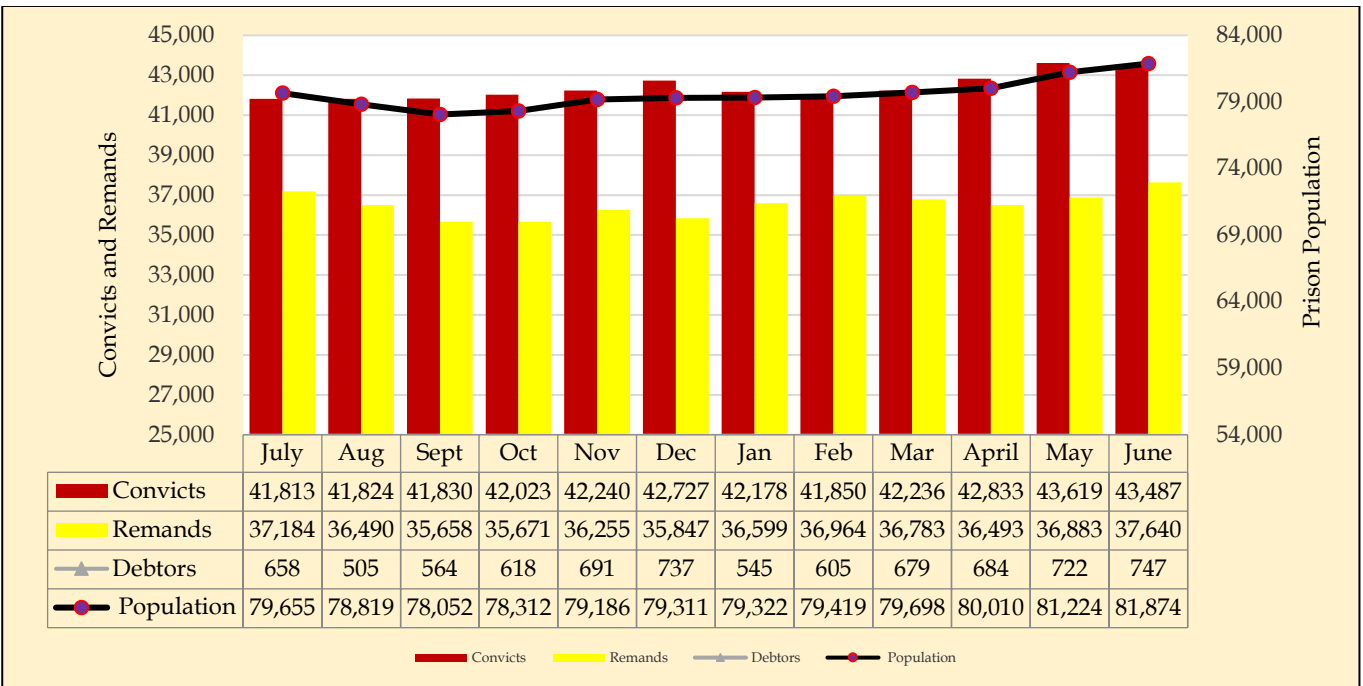


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the FY2025/26

Figure 1.3 above illustrates the trend in prison population during the FY2025/26. The figure shows a general increase in the prison population during the financial year of reporting. However during the first three months of the FY2025/26 there was a decline in the prison population. Throughout this time, the number of prisoners gradually dropped from 79,655 in July 2025 to 78,052 in September 2025. The prison population, however, steadily rose from 78,312 prisoners recorded in October 2025 to the 81,874 prisoners recorded in June 2026.

1.5 Prison population composition trends during the FY2025/26

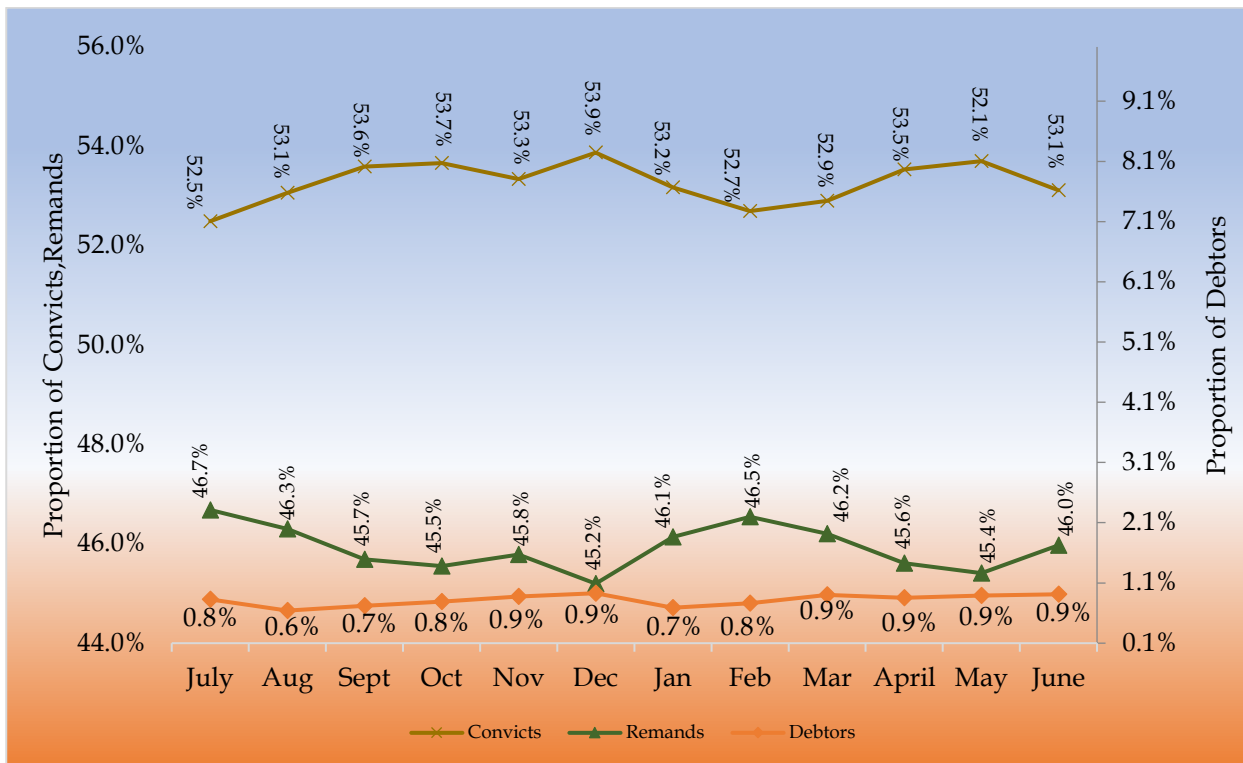


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the FY2025/26

Figure 1.4 above illustrates the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the overall prison population during the FY2025/26. The percentage of the remand population fluctuated below the 50.0% threshold, dropping from 46.7% in July 2025 to 45.2% in December 2025, then rising to up to 46.0% in June 2026. Conversely, the percentage of convicts fluctuated above the 50.0% threshold, rising from 52.5% in July 2025 to 53.9% in December 2025, followed by a slight drop to 53.1% in June 2026. The average percentage of debtors was 0.8% of the total prison population during the period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of June, 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Northern by 3.4%; Kigezi by 3.2%; Southern by 3.1%; Eastern by 1.8%; Central and North Western by 1.6%; North Central by 1.5%; Kooki by 1.3%; Mid Eastern by 1.2%; Mid Northern by 1.0%; Mid Western by 0.9%; Mid Central, South Eastern, and South Western by 0.4%, and North Eastern by 0.05%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; Iganga by 2.2%, East Central by 1.3%; Kampala Extra by 0.9%; and Western by 0.8%.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 270.

4. The average number of debtors in custody was 747.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of June 2026. Only 8.5% of the prisons (23prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels above 600%. 141 prison units were very congested, with congestion levels between 301% and 600%, representing 52.2% of the total prison units and 31 prison units (11.5%) had congestion levels below 200%. During the month of June 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 19.1% from 33,943 in May 2026 to 40,438 prisoners, a daily average of 2,022 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in June 2026 decreased by 12.2% from 2,610 in May 2026 to 2,292 prisoners, a daily average of 96 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of June 2026 increased by 41.6% from 6,376 in May 2026 to 9,049 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of May, 2026, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of June 2026 increased by 27.8% from 18 to 23 prisoners. The monthly escape rate increased from 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners to 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 shows the recorded prison escapes that occurred during FY2025/26. Kooki region registered the highest escape rate of 13.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, while Kampala Extra Region recorded the lowest rate at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall prison escape rate for the time period was 2.9 escapees for every 1,000 prisoners. It is important to highlight that, of the 227 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during this period, 123 have been recaptured, indicating a recapture rate of 54.2%.

1.12 Prison Mortality

During the month of June 2026, the Service lost a total of twelve (12) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prison National Referral Hospital is located.

The number of prison deaths recorded during the month of June 2026 was 12, a decrease by 41.7% from 17 deaths registered during the previous month (May 2026) as indicated in Table 1.12 above. The monthly crude mortality rate decreased from 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners to 0.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the prison mortality recorded during FY2025/26. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate of 7.5 deaths per 1,000 prisoners while Central region recorded the lowest crude mortality rate during the time period of 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of prison deaths during the financial year was 176 against the daily average prison population of 79,574 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as of 30th June 2026 was 14,798 constituting 10,288 (69.5%) males and 4,510 (30.5%) females. Of the same strength, 14,319 were uniformed staff while 479 were non-uniformed staff.

Of the 14,319 uniformed staff, 11,836 (82.7%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Warders and Wardresses were the majority category of staff leaving the Service, constituting up to 35.3% of the overall staff attrition during the period.
