MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

JULY, 2026

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of July 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of June and July 2026;

- The daily average prison population increased by 1.5% from 81,874 to 83,126 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 1.8% from 43,487 to 44,282 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 1.2% from 37,640 to 38,080 prisoners;
- Civil debtors increased by 2.3% from 747 to 764 debtors;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 46.0% to 45.8%;
- The proportion of convicted prisoners increased by 0.2% from 53.1% to 53.3%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 5.3% from 349.3% to 354.7%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,437 prisoners.

To note also is that, during the month of July 2026;

- A total of 2,830 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 105 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 47,490 – *a daily average of 2,065 prisoners*;
- 12,834 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 9,946 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- A total 64 prisoners at UG Prison Nwoya, Gulu (M), Patongo (M) and Patongo (W) were convicted through plea bargain sessions that were concluded in July 2026 in the Northern Region.
- For the period between January 2026 and July 2026, prison escape rate was 1.5 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate was 51.6%, while mortality rate stood at 1.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners;
- Overall, staff strength was 14,779 with male staff accounting for 10,271 (69.5%) and female staff accounting for 4,508 (30.5%);
- 11,850 (82.7%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the period January 2026 to July 2026 was 148 staff including 19 staff for the month of July 2026.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.
- Prisons custodial units reduced from 270 to 269 after indefinite closure of UG. Prison Maliba in Western Uganda.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of July 2026, the overall daily average prison population increased by 1.5% (1,252) from 81,874 in June 2026 to 83,126 prisoners.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts increased by 1.8% from 43,487 to 44,282;
- b) Remands increased by 1.2% from 37,640 to 38,080;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors increased by 2.3% from 747 to 764;
- d) Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,437 prisoners.
- e) Occupancy rate increased by 5.3% from 349.3% to 354.7%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

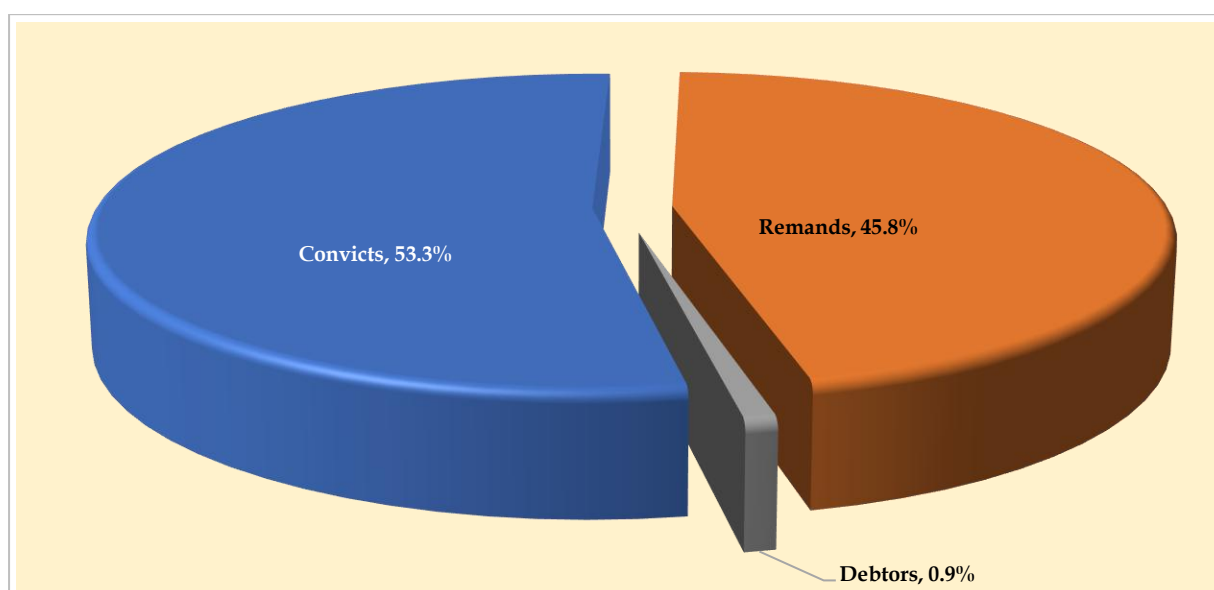


Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of July 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 53.3%, remand prisoners composed of 45.8%, while civil debtors composed of 0.9%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

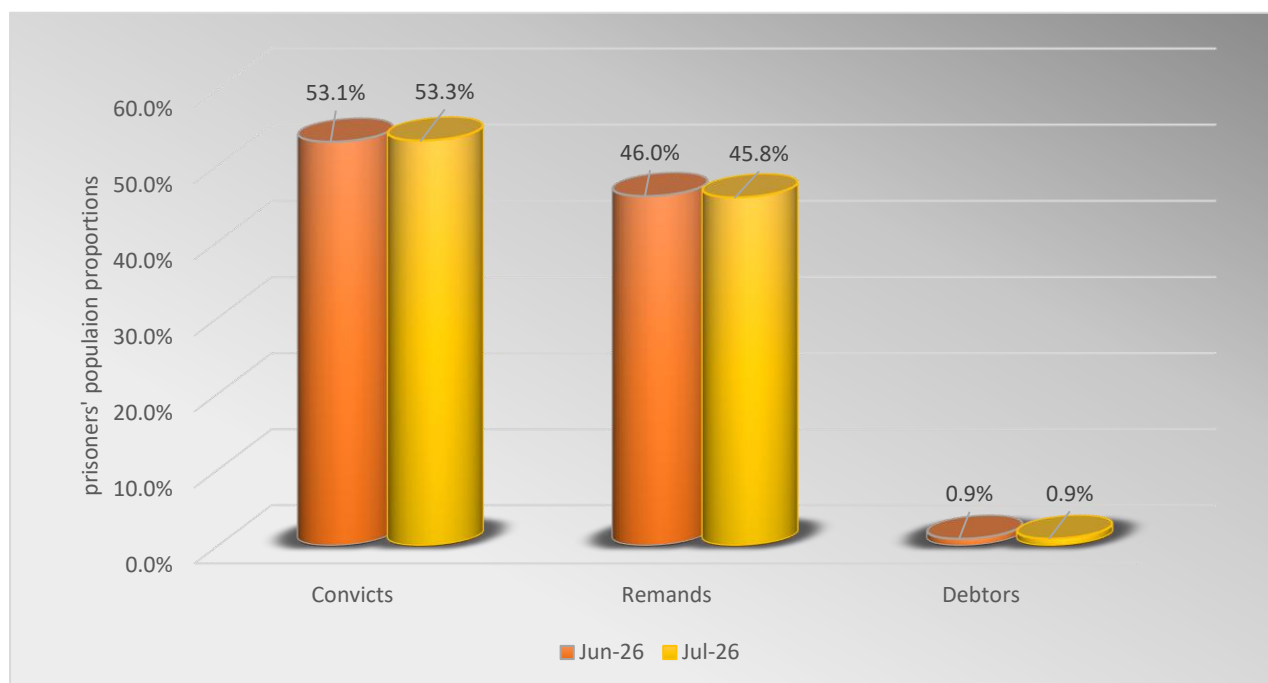


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of June 2026, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.2% from 53.1% to 53.3%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 46.0% to 45.8% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.9%; of the daily average prison population in July 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the period January to July 2026

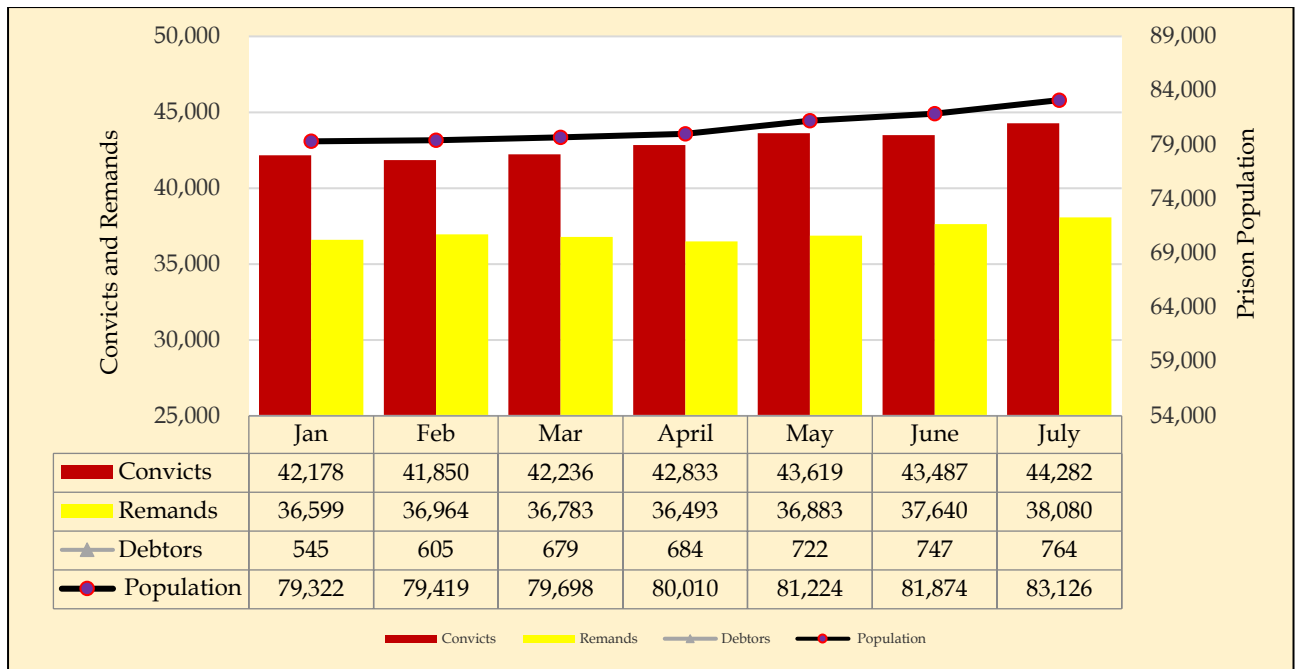


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period January to July 2026

Figure 1.3 below illustrates the trend in the prison population during the last seven months of the year 2026. The daily average prison population has gradually increased at a monthly average growth rate of 0.8% since the beginning of the year 2026. During this period, the prison population increased by 4.7% from 79,322 prisoners in January 2026 to the current population of 83,126 in the month of July 2026.

1.5 Prison population composition trends the period January to July 2026

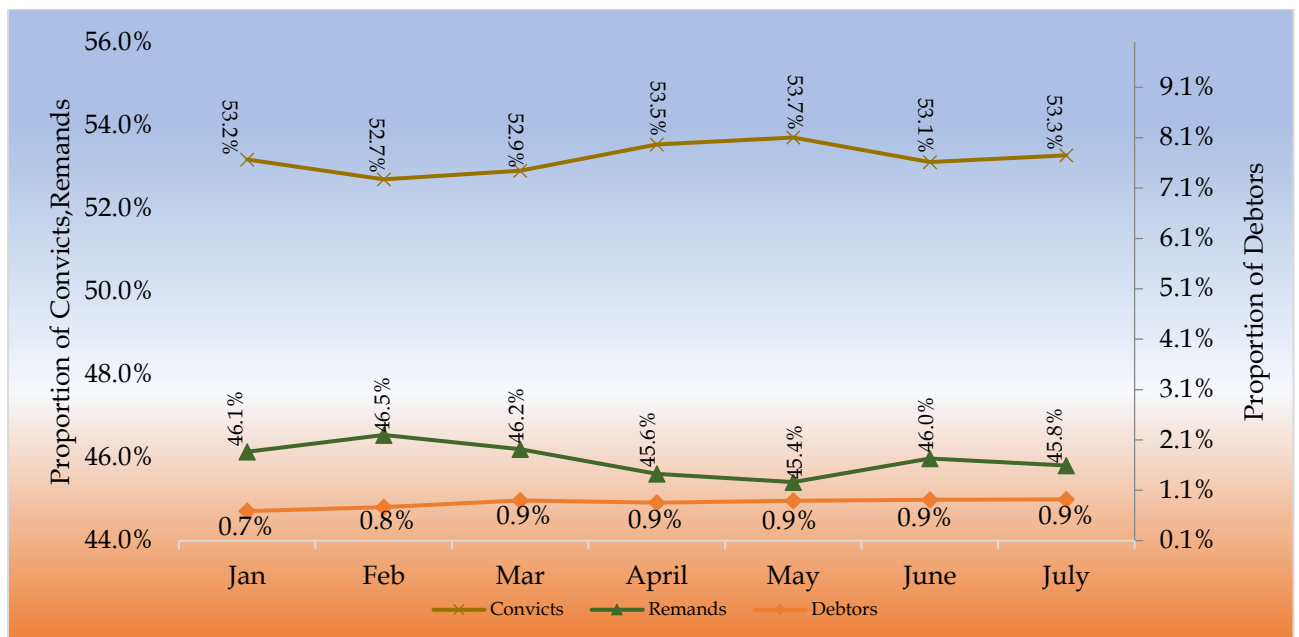


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period January to July 2026

Figure 1.4 below illustrates the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the overall prison population from January to July 2026. The percentage of the remand population fluctuated below the 50.0% threshold, dropping from 46.1% in January 2026 to 45.8% in July 2026. Conversely, the percentage of convicts fluctuated above the 50.0% threshold, rising from 53.2% in January 2026 to 53.3% in July 2026. The average percentage of debtors was 0.8% of the total prison population during the period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of July 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Northern by 4.9%; Kampala Extra by 4.5%; Iganga by 3.4%; Mid Eastern by 2.3%; Mid Western by 2.1%; Eastern by 1.7%; Southern by 1.6%; Mid Central by 1.4%; Mid Northern by 1.2%; Central by 1.0%; Kooki and North Western by 0.8%, and South Western by 0.7%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; South Eastern by 2.0%, Kigezi by 1.1%; Western by 1.0%; North Eastern and North Central by 0.6%; and East Central by 0.4%.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 265.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 764.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of July 2026. 9.3% of the prisons (25 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels above 600%. 53.5% (144 prison units) were very congested, with congestion levels between 301% and 600%, and only 10.4% (28 prison units) had congestion levels below 200%. During the month of July 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 17.4% from 40,438 in June 2026 to 47,490 prisoners, a daily average of 2,065 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in July 2026 increased by 23.5% from 2,292 in June 2026 to 2,830 prisoners, a daily average of 105 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of July 2026 increased by 9.9% from 9,049 in June 2026 to 9,946 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of June 2026, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of July 2026 was twenty-three (23), the same as the number registered in June. The monthly escape rate also remained constant (0.3 escapes per 1,000 prisoners) despite an increase in prisoner population by 1.5 % as shown in Table 1.10.

Table 1.11 shows the recorded prison escapes that occurred between January 2026 and July 2026. Kooki region registered the highest escape rate of 10.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, while Kampala Extra Region recorded the lowest rate at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall prison escape rate for the time period was 1.5 escapees for every 1,000 prisoners. It is important to highlight that, of the 124 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 64 had been recaptured, indicating a recapture rate of 51.6%.

1.13 Prison Mortality

During the month of July 2026, the Service lost a total of ten (10) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the Prison National Referral Hospital is located.

Table 1.14 above shows the prison mortality recorded between January 2026 and July 2026. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate of 4.5 deaths per 1,000 prisoners while North Central region recorded zero deaths during the time period. The overall number of prison deaths during the time period was 100 against the daily average prison population of 80,666 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as of 31st July 2026 was 14,779 constituting 10,271 (69.5%) males and 4,508 (30.5%) females. Of the same strength, 14,301 were uniformed staff while 478 were non-uniformed staff.

Of the 14,301 uniformed staff, 11,850 (82.7%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
