MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

AUGUST 2026

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of August 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of July and August 2026;

- The daily average prison population decreased by 0.5% from 83,126 to 82,734 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 1.5% from 44,282 to 44,940 prisoners;
- Remands decreased by 2.3% from 38,080 to 37,188 prisoners;
- Civil debtors decreased by 20.7% from 764 to 606 debtors;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.9% from 45.8% to 44.9%;
- The proportion of convicted prisoners increased by 1.1% from 53.3% to 54.4%;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 1.7% from 354.7% to 353.0%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,437 prisoners.

To note also is that, during the month of August 2026;

- A total of 2,876 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 111 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 45,325 – *a daily average of 2,158 prisoners*;
- 13,241 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 9,528 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- A total of 176 prisoners were convicted through plea bargain sessions and 47 had their cases deferred;
- For the period between January 2026 and August 2026, prison escape rate was 1.8 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate was 53.4%, while mortality rate stood at 1.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners;
- Overall, staff strength was 14,755 with male staff accounting for 10,250 (69.5%) and female staff accounting for 4,505 (30.5%);
- 11,821 (82.8%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the period January 2026 to August 2026 was 170 staff including 22 staff for the month of August 2026;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7;
- Prisons custodial units increased from 269 to 270 after opening a new prison unit - UG. Prison Bulindi in Hoima District.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of August 2026, the overall daily average prison population decreased by 0.5% (392) from 83,126 in July 2026 to 82,734 prisoners.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 1.5% from 44,282 to 44,940;
- Remands decreased by 2.3% from 38,080 to 37,188;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 20.7% from 764 to 606;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,437 prisoners;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 1.7% from 354.7% to 353.0%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

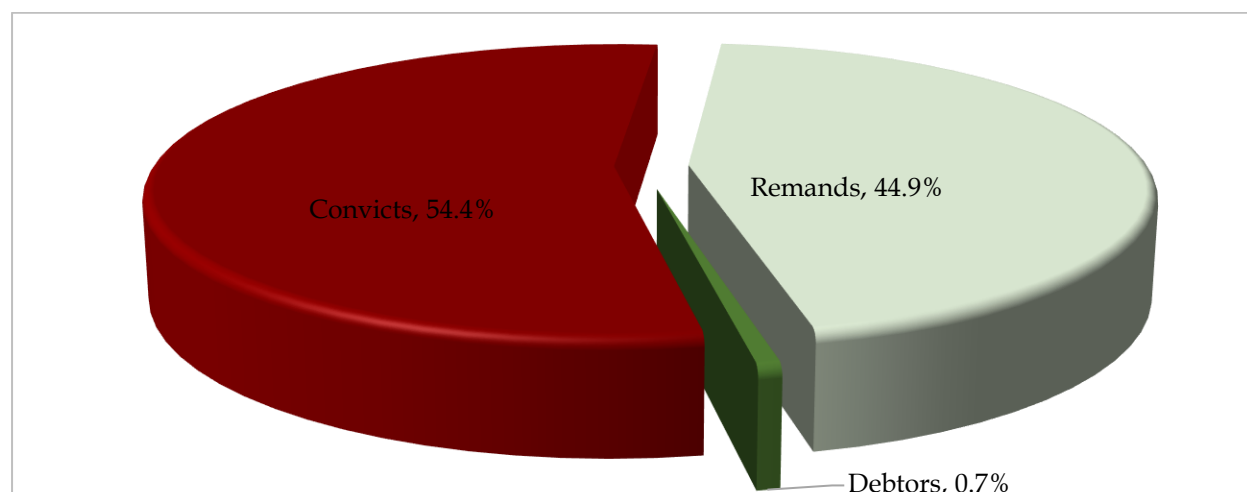


Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of August 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 54.4%, remand prisoners composed of 44.9%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

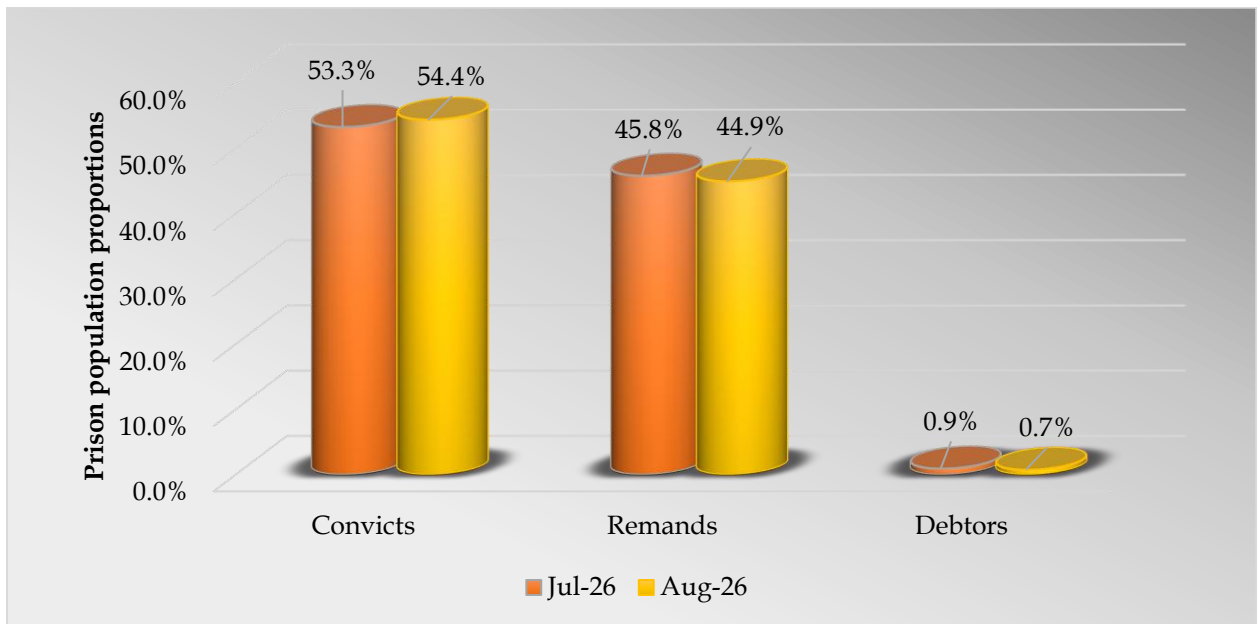


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of July 2026, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 1.1% from 53.3% to 54.4%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.9% from 45.8% to 44.9% while that of civil debtors decreased by 0.2% from 0.9% to 0.7%; of the daily average prison population in August 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the period January to August 2026

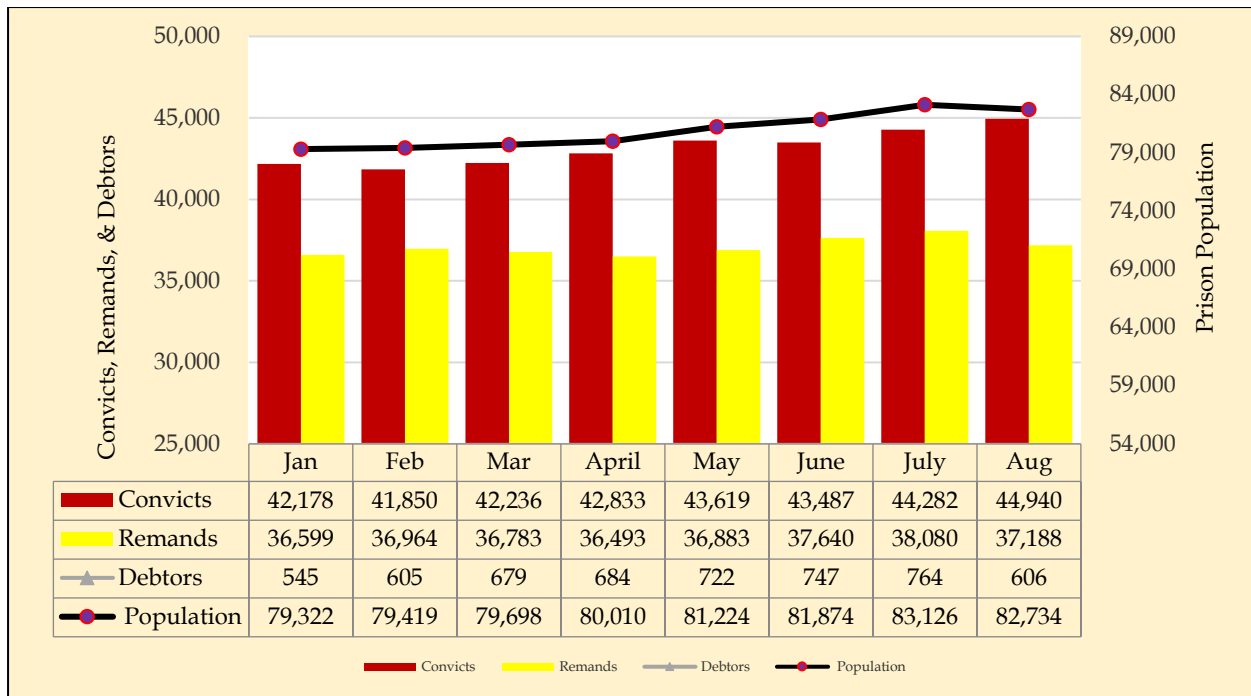


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period January to August 2026

Figure 1.3 illustrates the trend in the prison population during the last eight months of the year 2026. The daily average prison population has gradually increased at a monthly average growth rate of 0.6% since the beginning of the year 2026. During this period, the prison population increased by 4.3% from 79,322 prisoners in January 2026 to the current population of 82,734 in the month of August 2026.

1.5 Prison population composition trends for the period January to August 2026

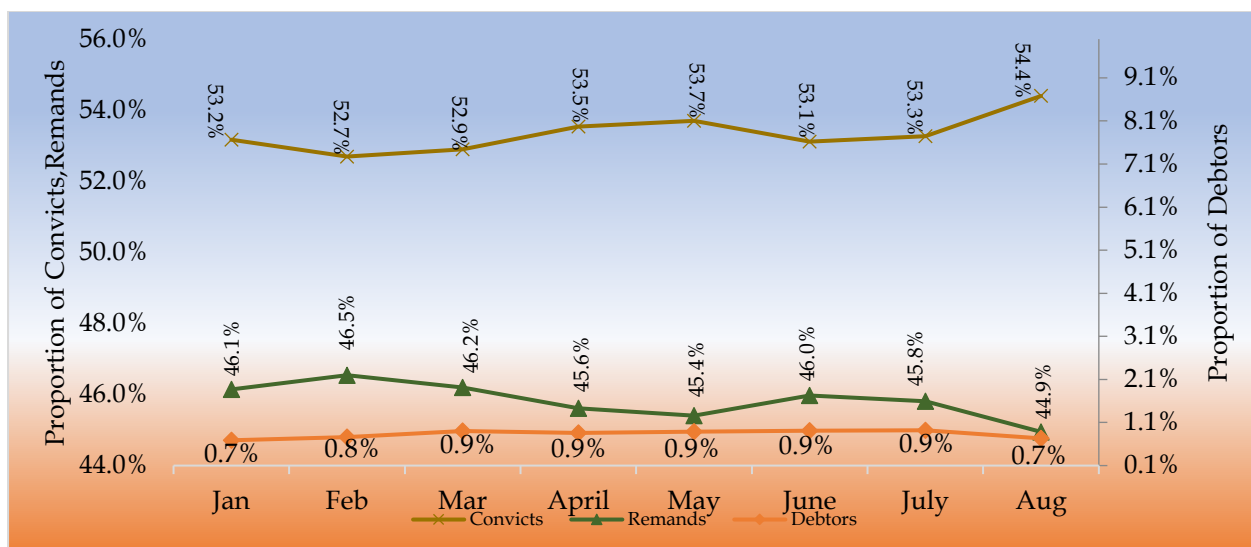


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period January to August 2026

Figure 1.4 below illustrates the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the overall prison population from January to August 2026. The percentage of the remand population fluctuated below the 50.0% threshold, dropping from 46.1% in January 2026 to 44.9% in August 2026. Conversely, the percentage of convicts fluctuated above the 50.0% threshold, rising from 53.2% in January 2026 to 54.4% in August 2026. The average percentage of debtors was 0.8% of the total prison population during the period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of August 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; North Eastern by 5.0%; North Central by 3.4%; Southern by 2.6%; Mid Eastern by 2.2%; North Western by 2.1%; East Central by 1.8%; Eastern by 1.6%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; Mid Central by 5.7%, Iganga by 3.9%; South Western by 3.1%; Kamapala Extra by 3.0%; Mid Western by 1.1%; Kigezi by 0.9%; Mid Northern by 0.5%; Western and Northern by 0.2%; South Eastern and Kooki by 0.1%; and Central by 0.04%..
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 271.

4. The average number of debtors in custody was 606.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of August 2026. 24 prison units were extremely congested with occupancy levels above 600%, 150 prison units were very congested, with congestion levels between 301% and 600%, and 24 prison units had congestion levels below 200% as shown in table 1.3. During the month of August 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 4.6% from 47,490 in July 2026 to 45,325 prisoners, a daily average of 2,158 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in August 2026 increased by 1.6% from 2,830 in July 2026 to 2,876 prisoners, a daily average of 111 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of August 2026 decreased by 4.2% from 9,946 in July 2026 to 9,528 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of July 2026, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of August 2026 increased by 4.3% from 23 escapees to 24 escapees. The monthly escape rate was 0.3 escapes per 1,000 prisoners, same as the rate registered in July 2026 as shown in Table 1.10.

Table 1.11 shows the recorded prison escapes that occurred between January 2026 and August 2026. Kooki region registered the highest escape rate of 10.8 escapes per 1,000 prisoners, while Kampala Extra Region recorded the lowest rate at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall prison escape rate for the time period was 1.8 escapes for every 1,000 prisoners. It is important to note that, of the 146 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 78 had been recaptured, indicating a recapture rate of 53.4%.

1.13 Prison Mortality

During the month of August 2026, the Service lost a total of seventeen (17) prisoners through deaths, distributed in 17 prison units across the country as shown in table 1.12.

The number of prison deaths recorded during the month of August 2026 was 17, an increase by 70.0% from 10 deaths registered during the previous month (July 2026). The monthly crude mortality rate also increased from 0.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners in July 2026 to 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners in August 2026 as shown in table 1.13.

Table 1.14 above shows the prison mortality recorded between January 2026 and August 2026. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate of 4.5 deaths per 1,000 prisoners, while North Central region recorded zero deaths during the time period. The overall number of prison deaths during the time period was 117 against the daily average prison population of 80,926 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as of 31st August 2026 was 14,755 comprising of 10,250 (69.5%) males and 4,505 (30.5%) females. Of the same strength, 14,278 were uniformed staff while 477 were non-uniformed staff.

Of the 14,278 uniformed staff, 11,821 (82.8%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 above shows that, between January 2026 and August 2026, the Service lost a total of 170 staff with retirement being the leading staff attrition mode, constituting up to 42.9% of the overall attrition.
