# UGANDA PRISONS SERVICE STATUS OF THE PRISONERS' POPULATION & STAFFING POSITION

## ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of January, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.3% from 76,943 in December, 2023 to 77,181 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 1.8% from 36,284 to 36,936;
- Convicts decreased by 0.8% from 40,085 to 39,765;
- Civil debtors decreased by 16.4% from 574 to 480;
- Remands composed of 47.9%, convicts 51.5%, and debtors 0.6% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.1% from 366.5% to 367.6%;
- A total of 2,562 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 102 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 36,239 – *a daily average of 1,726 prisoners*;
- 10,743 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 8,078 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July, 2023 to January, 2024, prisoners' escape rate stood at 3.1 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 45.3%, while mortality rate stood at 2.0 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,261 with 13,753 uniformed and 508 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 70.0%; Female staff accounted for 30.0%;
- 11,630 (84.6%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

### 1.1 Population Change

During the month of January, 2024, the overall average population of prisoners increased by 0.3% (238) from 76,943 in December, 2023 to 77,181.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 0.8% from 40,085 to 39,765;
- Remands increased by 1.8% from 36,284 to 36,936;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 16.4% from 574 to 480.

### 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors





Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of January, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 51.5%, remand prisoners composed of 47.9%, while civil debtors composed of 0.6%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.


### 1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

In comparison with December, 2023, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 52.1% to 51.5%, remand prisoners increased by 0.7% from 47.2% to 47.9% while that of civil debtors reduced by 0.1% from 0.7% to 0.6% of the average prisoners' population in January, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

### 1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners for the period July, 2023 to January, 2024

Figure 1.3 shows that the daily average population of prisoners in custody was on a gradual increase for last the seven months, from a daily average of 76,272 prisoners in July, 2023 to 77,181 prisoners in January, 2024 - *a monthly growth rte of 0.2%*. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 38,987 prisoners in July, 2023 to 39,765 prisoners in January, 2024 while remand prisoners increased from 36,806 prisoners in July, 2023 to 36,936 prisoners in January, 2024. The increase in the prisoners' population may be attributed to increase in crime within the communities and court operations.

## 1.5 Population composition trends for the period July, 2023 to January, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period July, 2023-January, 2024.

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last seven months. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 47.2% in the month of December, 2023 and an increase of up to 48.3% in the month of July, 2023. On the other

hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 52.1% registered in the month of December, 2023 and a drop of up to 51.1% of the total prison population in the month of July, 2023. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.6% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of January, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Southern by 3.6%, Northern by 2.7%, Kigezi by 2.3%, Mid Central by 2.0%, Central by 1.4%, Kampala Extra 1.3%, Eastern 1.2%, North Central by 1.1%, Mid Western by 1.0%, Mid Northern by 0.9%, Mid Eastern by 0.6%, South Western by 0.4%, East Central by 0.2%, and North Eastern by 0.1%.

2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; South Eastern by 6.0%, Kooki by 4.1%, North Western by 1.5%, Western by 1.3%, and Iganga by 1.0%.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 270.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 480.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (09) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

### **1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons**

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 20,996 prisoners, the occupancy rate increased by 1.1% from 366.5% to 367.6% due to the increase in prisoners' population by 0.3% from 76,943 in December, 2023 to 77,181 in January, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons increased during the month from 55,947 prisoners (266.5%) in December, 2023 to 56,185 (267.6%) prisoners in January, 2024 over and above the capacity of prisons countrywide

### **1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases**

During the month of January, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 24.6% from 29,077 in December, 2023 to 36,239 prisoners, a daily average of 1,726 prisoners. (See Table 1.3).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in January, 2024 decreased by 2.1% from 2,617 in December, 2023 to 2,562 prisoners, a daily average of 102 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.3).

## 1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of January, 2024 increased by 24.9% from 6,470 in December, 2023 to 8,078 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of December, 2023, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of January, 2024 decreased by 24.0%, from 25 to 19 escapees. As a result, the monthly escape rate reduced from 0.3 to 0.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners despite the increase in the prisoners' population by 0.3% from 76,943 to 77,181 prisoners in the same period as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered between July, 2023 and January, 2024. Mid Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (33 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 12.4 escapees per 1,000

prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 3.1 per 1,000 prisoners. Out of the 236 prisoners who had escaped from custody within he same period, a total of 107 prisoners had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 45.3%.

## 1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of January, 2024, the service lost a total of thirty four (34) prisoners through death which reflected a mortality rate of 0.4 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of December, 2023, the number of prison deaths registered in the month of January, 2024 significantly increased by 41.7% from 24 deaths to 34 deaths. This resulted into increase in the prisoners' monthly mortality rate from 0.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners to 0.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prison deaths registered between July, 2023 and January, 2024. Kampala extra region had the highest mortality rate of 5.8 deaths per 1,000 prisoners while Central, East Central, Kooki and Mid-Central regions registered zero deaths of prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 156 against daily average population of 76,378 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.0 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. **National Mortality rate is at 6.3 per 1,000 prisoners.**

## 2 STAFFING POSITION

### 2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31<sup>st</sup> January, 2024 was 14,261 of which 13,753 were uniformed and 508 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,986 (70.0%) males and 4,275 (30.0%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,753 uniformed staff, 11,630 (84.6%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
