UGANDA PRISONS SERVICE STATUS OF THE PRISONERS' POPULATION & STAFFING POSITION

ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of February, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.5% from 77,181 in January, 2024 to 76,812 prisoners;
- Remands decreased by 2.5% from 36,936 to 36,024;
- Convicts increased by 1.3% from 39,765 to 40,271;
- Civil debtors increased by 7.7% from 480 to 517;
- Remands composed of 46.9%, convicts 52.4%, and debtors 0.7% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 1.8% from 367.6% to 365.8%;
- A total of 2,337 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 102 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 36,499 – *a daily average of 1,921 prisoners*;
- 10,257 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 8,294 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July, 2023 to February, 2024, prisoners' escape rate stood at 3.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 46.8%, while mortality rate stood at 2.3 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,268 with 13,762 uniformed and 506 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 70.0%; Female staff accounted for 30.0%;
- 11,611 (84.4%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of February, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.5% (369) from 77,181 in January, 2024 to 76,812.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts increased by 1.3% from 39,765 to 40,271;
- b) Remands decreased by 2.5% from 36,936 to 36,024;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors increased by 7.7% from 480 to 517.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

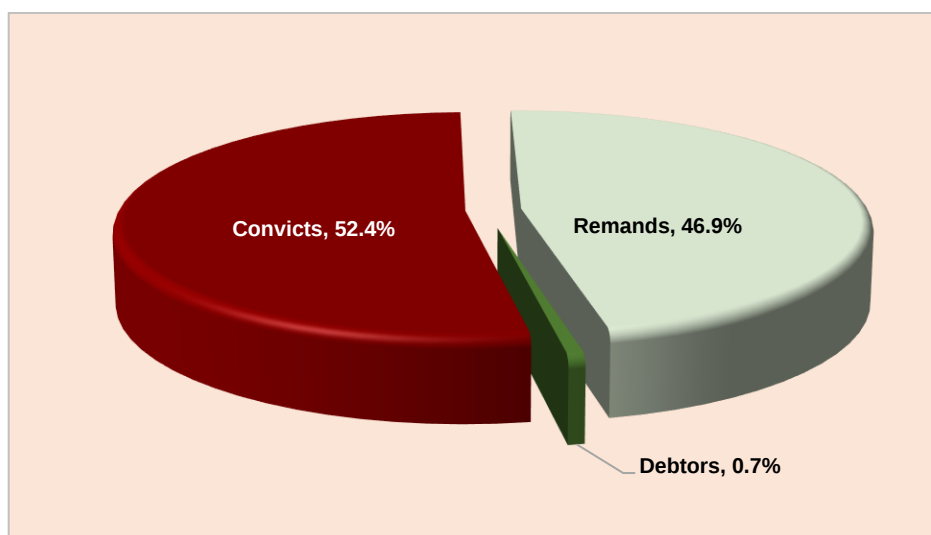


Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of February, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 52.4%, remand prisoners composed of 46.9%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prisoners’ population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

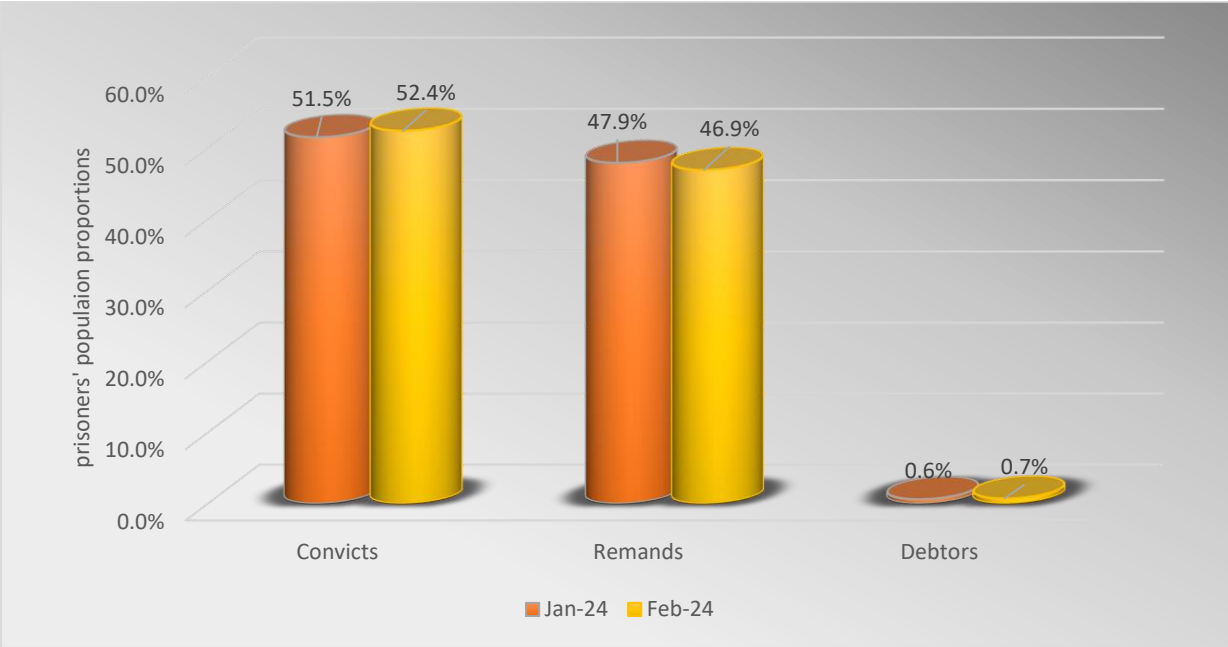


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with January, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.9% from 51.5% to 52.4%, remand prisoners decreased by 1.0% from 47.9% to 46.9% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.6% to 0.7% of the average prisoners’ population in February, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners for the period July, 2023 to February, 2024

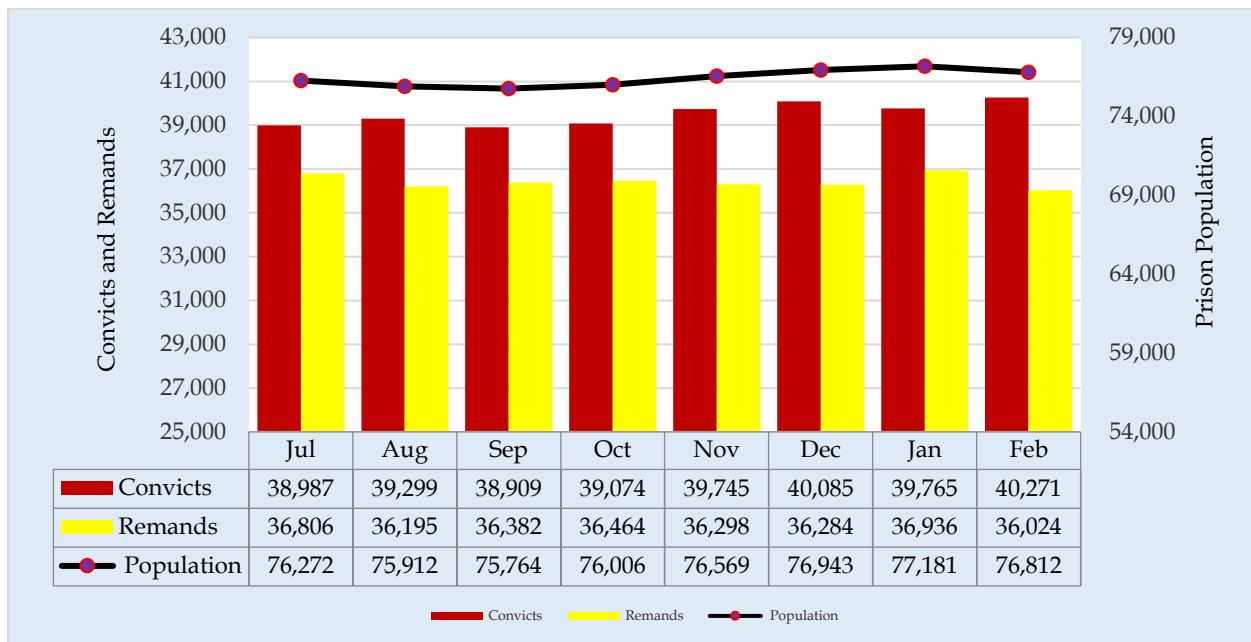


Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend July, 2023-February, 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that the daily average population of prisoners in custody was on a gradual increase for last the eight months, from a daily average of 76,272 prisoners in July, 2023 to 76,812 prisoners in February, 2024 - *a mothly growth rate of 0.1%*. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 38,987 prisoners in July, 2023 to 40,271 prisoners in February, 2024 while remand prisoners decreased from 36,806 prisoners in July, 2023 to 36,024 prisoners in February, 2024. The general increase in the prisoners' population may be attributed to increase in crime within the communities and court operations.

1.5 Population composition trends for the period July, 2023 to February, 2024

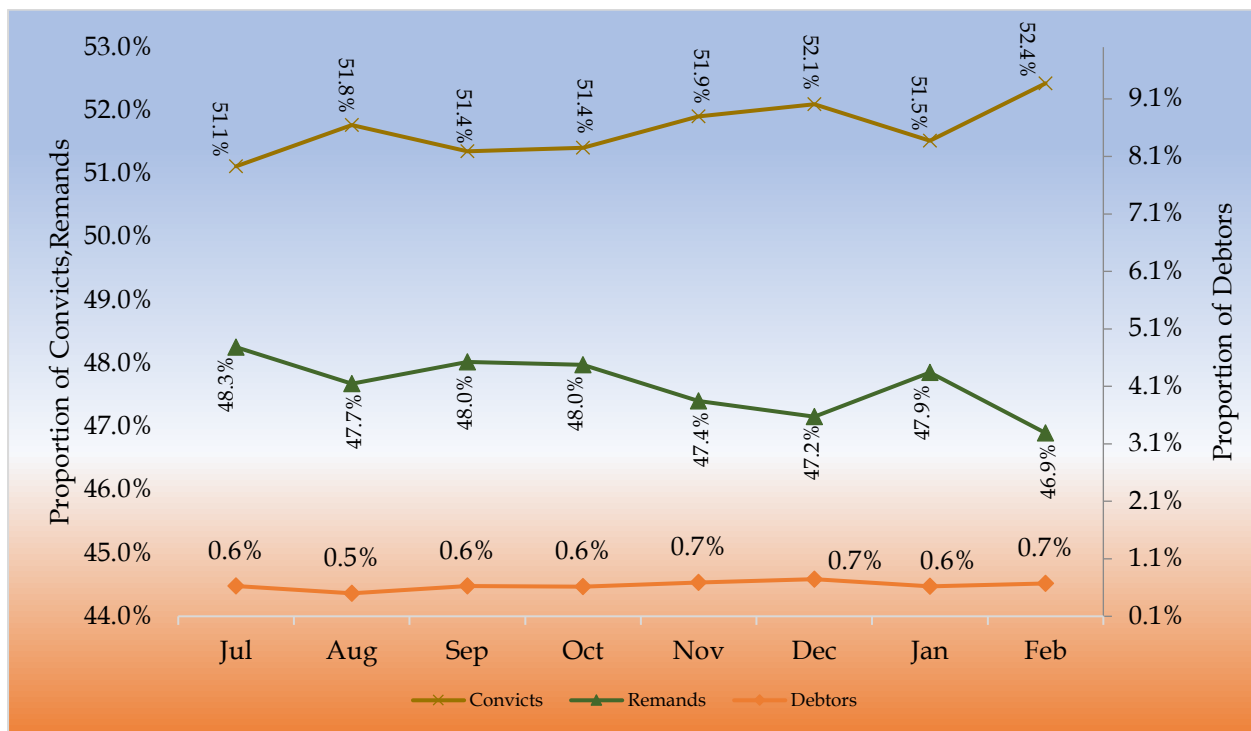


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period July, 2023-February, 2024.

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last eight months. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 46.9% in the month of February, 2024 and an increase of up to 48.3% in the month of July, 2023. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 52.4% registered in the month of February, 2024 and a drop down of up to 51.1% of the total prisoners' population in the month of July, 2023. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.6% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of February, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Kooki by 3.6%, Southern by 1.6%, Eastern by 0.7%, North Central and Central by 0.6%, Kigezi by 0.4%, and Kampala Extra 0.1%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Iganga by 3.0%, Mid Central by 2.4%, East Central by 2.3%, Mid Eastern by 2.2%, South Eastern by 2.1%, Mid Northern by 1.9%, North Eastern by 1.8%, North Western 1.0%, Mid Western 0.7%, South Western 0.5%, Western 0.4%, and Northern by 0.3%.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 305.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 517.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (09) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 20,996 prisoners, the occupancy rate decreased by 1.8% from 367.6% to 365.8% due to the decrease in prisoners' population by 0.5% from 77,181 in January, 2024 to 76,812 in February, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons decreased during the month from 56,185 prisoners (267.6%) in January, 2024 to 55,816 (265.8%) prisoners in February, 2024 over and above the capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of February, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 0.7% from 36,239 in January, 2024 to 36,499 prisoners, a daily average of 1,921 prisoners. (See Table 1.3).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in February, 2024 decreased by 8.8% from 2,562 in January, 2024 to 2,337 prisoners, a daily average of 102 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.3).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of February, 2024 increased by 2.7% from 8,078 in January, 2024 to 8,294 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of January, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of February, 2024 increased by 42.1%, from 19 to 27 escapees. As a result, the monthly escape rate increased from 0.2 to 0.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners despite the decrease in the prison population by 0.5% from 77,181 to 76,812 prisoners in the same period as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered between July, 2023 and February, 2024. Mid Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (37 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 12.9 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.4 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 3.4 per 1,000 prisoners. Out of the 263 prisoners who had escaped from custody within the same period, a total of 123 prisoners had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 46.8%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of February, 2024, the service lost a total of twenty (20) prisoners through death which reflects a mortality rate of 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of January, 2024, the number of prisoners' deaths registered in the month of February, 2024 significantly decreased by 41.2% from 34 deaths registered in January, 2024 to 20 deaths. This resulted into decrease in the prisoners' monthly mortality rate from 0.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners to 0.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered between July, 2023 and February, 2024. Kampala extra region had the highest mortality rate of 6.6 deaths per 1,000 prisoners and rate was lowest in the Central region with 0.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Mid Central Region registered no death of prisoners in the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 176 against daily average population of 76,325 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 29th February, 2024 was 14,268 of which 13,762 were uniformed and 506 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,988 (70.0%) males and 4,280 (30.0%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,762 uniformed staff, 11,611 (84.4%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
