ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of March, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.8% from 76,812 in February, 2024 to 76,223 prisoners;
- Remands decreased by 3.2% from 36,024 to 34,887;
- Convicts increased by 1.2% from 40,271 to 40,755;
- Civil debtors increased by 12.4% from 517 to 581;
- Remands composed of 45.8%, convicts 53.5%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 2.8% from 365.8% to 363.0%;
- A total of 2,546 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 106 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 35,706 – *a daily average of 1,879 prisoners*;
- 9,489 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,847 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period between July 2023 and February 2024, prisoners' escape rate stood at 3.9 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 49.2%, while mortality rate stood at 2.5 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,237 with 13,731 uniformed and 506 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 70.0%; Female staff accounted for 30.0%;
- 11,628 (84.6%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of March, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.8% from 76,812 in February, 2024 to 76,223.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 1.2% from 40,271 to 40,755;
- Remands decreased by 3.2% from 36,024 to 34,887;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 12.4% from 517 to 581.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of March, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 53.5%, remand prisoners composed of 45.8%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with February, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 1.1% from 52.4% to 53.5%, remand prisoners decreased by 1.1% from 46.9% to 45.8% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.7% to 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in March, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners for the period July, 2023 to March, 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend July, 2023-March, 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that the daily average population of prisoners in custody for the last nine (09) months was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 77,181 prisoners registered in January, 2024. The rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations. However, drop of upto 75,764 was registered in prisoners' population which may be attributed to the enhanced investigations and fast handling of cases by courts thus reduced period spent on remand.

In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 38,987 prisoners in July, 2023 to 40,755 prisoners in March, 2024 while remand prisoners decreased from 36,806 prisoners in July, 2023 to 34,887 prisoners in March, 2024. The increase in convicted prisoners' population and the eventual reduction in remand population is mainly due to increased trial and conviction of remand prisoners.

1.5 Population composition trends for the period July, 2023 to March, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2023 and March, 2024.

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last nine (09) months. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% in the month of March, 2024 and an increase of up to 48.3% in the month of July, 2023. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 53.8% registered in the month of March, 2024 and a drop down of up to 51.1% of the total prisoners' population in the month of July, 2023. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of February, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Mid Eastern by 3.7%, Kigezi by 3.4%, Iganga by 3.0%, North Central by 2.2%, North Eastern by 1.7%, Northern by 1.4% and Mid Northern by 0.5%
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; South Eastern 6.0%, South Western by 3.2%, Mid Central by 2.9%, Mid Western by 1.5%, North Western and Kooki by 1.4%, Kampala Extra by 1.1%, East Central and Southern by 0.9%, Central by 0.8%, Eastern by 0.6% and Western by 0.4%.

The regional prisoners' population change is largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts, reinforce farm labour and also partly as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 272.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 581.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (09) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 20,996 prisoners, the occupancy rate decreased by 2.8% from 365.8% to 363.0% due to the decrease in prisoners' population by 0.8% from 76,812 in February, 2024 to 76,223 in March, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons decreased during the month from 55,816 prisoners (265.8%) in February, 2024 to 55,227 (263.0%) prisoners in March, 2024 over and above the capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of March, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 2.2% from 36,499 in February, 2024 to 35,706 prisoners, a daily average of 1,879 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in March, 2024 increased by 8.9% from 2,337 in February, 2024 to 2,546 prisoners, a daily average of 106 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of March, 2024 decreased by 17.4% from 8,294 in February, 2024 to 6,847 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of February, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of March, 2024 increased by 18.5%, from 27 to 32 escapees. However, the monthly escape rate remained at 0.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners despite increase in the number of escapee due to drop in prisoners' population by 0.8% from 76,812 to 76,223 prisoners in the same period as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered between July, 2023 and March, 2024. Mid Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (38 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 14.7 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 3.9 per 1,000

prisoners. Out of the 295 prisoners who had escaped from custody within the same period, a total of 145 prisoners had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 49.2%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of March, 2024, the service lost a total of seventeen (17) prisoners through death which reflects a mortality rate of 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of February, 2024, the number of prisoners' deaths registered in the month of March, 2024 decreased by 15.0% from 20 deaths registered in February, 2024 to 17 deaths. This resulted into decrease in the prisoners' monthly mortality rate from 0.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners to 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered between July, 2023 and March, 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate of 6.7 deaths per 1,000 prisoners and the rate was lowest in East Central region with 0.5 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Mid Central Region registered no death of prisoners in the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 193 against daily average population of 76,410 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.5 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st March, 2024 was 14,237 of which 13,731 were uniformed and 506 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,961 (70.0%) males and 4,276 (30.0%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,731 uniformed staff, 11,628 (84.6%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
