ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of April, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.9% from 76,223 in March, 2024 to 76,946 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 2.0% from 34,887 to 35,571;
- Convicts increased by 0.1% from 40,755 to 40,781;
- Civil debtors increased by 2.2% from 581 to 594;
- Remands composed of 46.2%, convicts 53.0%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 3.5% from 363.0% to 366.5%;
- A total of 2,625 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 105 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 33,913 – *a daily average of 1,615 prisoners*;
- 9,743 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,466 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period between July 2023 and April, 2024, prisoners' escape rate stood at 4.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 50.6%, while mortality rate stood at 2.7 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,198 with 13,694 uniformed and 504 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.9%; Female staff accounted for 30.1%;
- 11,662 (85.2%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of April, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.9% from 76,223 in March, 2024 to 76,946.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.1% from 40,755 to 40,781;
- Remands increased by 2.0% from 34,887 to 35,571;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 2.2% from 581 to 594.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors



Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of April, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 53.0%, remand prisoners composed of 46.2%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with March, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.4% from 53.4% to 53.0%, remand prisoners increased by 0.4% from 45.8% to 46.2% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in April, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners for the period July, 2023 to April, 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend July, 2023-April, 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that the daily average population of prisoners in custody for the last ten (10) months was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 77,181 prisoners registered in January, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 38,987 prisoners in July, 2023 to 40,781 prisoners in April, 2024 while remand prisoners decreased from 36,806 prisoners in July, 2023 to 35,571 prisoners in April, 2024. The rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

1.5 Population composition trends for the period July, 2023 to April, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2023 and April, 2024.

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last ten (10) months. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% in the month of March, 2024 and an increase of up to 48.3% in the month of July, 2023. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 53.4% registered in the month of March, 2024 and a drop down of up to 51.1% of the total prisoners' population in the month of July, 2023. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of March, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Mid Northern by 4.0%, Mid Central by 3.6%, Kigezi by 3.3%, Southern by 3.2%, Kampala Extra and Western by 2.4%, Northern by 1.6%, South Western by 1.3% Kooki by 1.2%, Mid Eastern by 1.0%, Eastern by 0.9%, Mid Western by 0.7%, and North Eastern by 0.4%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Central by 4.2%, East Central by 2.0%, South Eastern by 1.1%, Iganga by 0.9%, North Western and North Central by 0.4%.

The regional prisoners' population change is largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts, reinforce farm labour and sometimes as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 271.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 594.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (09) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 20,996 prisoners, the occupancy rate increased by 3.5% from 363.0% to 366.5% due to the increase in prisoners' population by 0.9% from 76,223 in March, 2024 to 76,946 in April, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons increased during the month from 55,227 prisoners (263.0%) in March, 2024 to 55,950 (266.5%) prisoners in April, 2024 over and above the capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of April, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 5.0% from 35,706 in March, 2024 to 33,913 prisoners, a daily average of 1,615 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in April, 2024 increased by 3.1% from 2,546 in March, 2024 to 2,625 prisoners, a daily average of 105 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of April, 2024 decreased by 5.6% from 6,847 in March, 2024 to 6,466 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of March, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of April, 2024 increased by 8.6%, from 32 to 35 escapees. This resulted into an increase in escape rate by 0.1 from 0.4 per 1,000 to 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered between July, 2023 and April, 2024. Mid Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (40 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 17.0 per 1,000 prisoners,

and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 4.3 per 1,000 prisoners. Out of the 330 prisoners who had escaped from custody within the same period, a total of 167 prisoners had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 50.6%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of April, 2024, the service lost a total of thirteen (13) prisoners through death which reflects a mortality rate of 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of March, 2024, the number of prisoners' deaths registered during the month of April, 2024 decreased by 23.5% from 17 deaths registered in March, 2024 to 13 deaths. Despite decrease in the number of death of prisoners, monthly mortality rate remained at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners due to the 0.9% increase in prisoners' population as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered between July, 2023 and April, 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 7.3 per 1,000 prisoners while East Central region had lowest mortality rate at 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners. Mid Central region registered no death of prisoners in the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 206 against daily average population of 76,463 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.7 per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 30th April, 2024 was 14,198 of which 13,694 were uniformed and 504 non-uniformed officers. 9,926 (69.9%) of the staff strength were males while 4,272 (30.1%) were females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,694 uniformed staff, 11,662 (85.2%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.3 shows that the total number of staff who were declared as deserters in April, 2024 increased by 20.0% as compared to the ones declared in March, 2024.
