MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

MAY 2024

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of May, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.7% from 76,946 in April, 2024 to 77,517 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 2.5% from 35,571 to 36,475;
- Convicts decreased by 0.9% from 40,781 to 40,403;
- Civil debtors increased by 7.6% from 594 to 639;
- Remands composed of 47.1%, convicts 52.1%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 2.7% from 366.5% to 369.2%;
- A total of 2,441 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 94 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 40,620 – *a daily average of 1,846 prisoners*;
- 12,120 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 8,274 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period between July 2023 and May, 2024, prisoners' escape rate stood at 4.9 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 50.5%, while mortality rate stood at 3.0 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,175 with 13,672 uniformed and 503 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.9%; Female staff accounted for 30.1%;
- 11,585 (84.7%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of May, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.7% from 76,946 in April, 2024 to 77,517.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts decreased by 0.9% from 40,781 to 40,403;
- b) Remands increased by 2.5% from 35,571 to 36,475;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors increased by 7.6% from 594 to 639.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

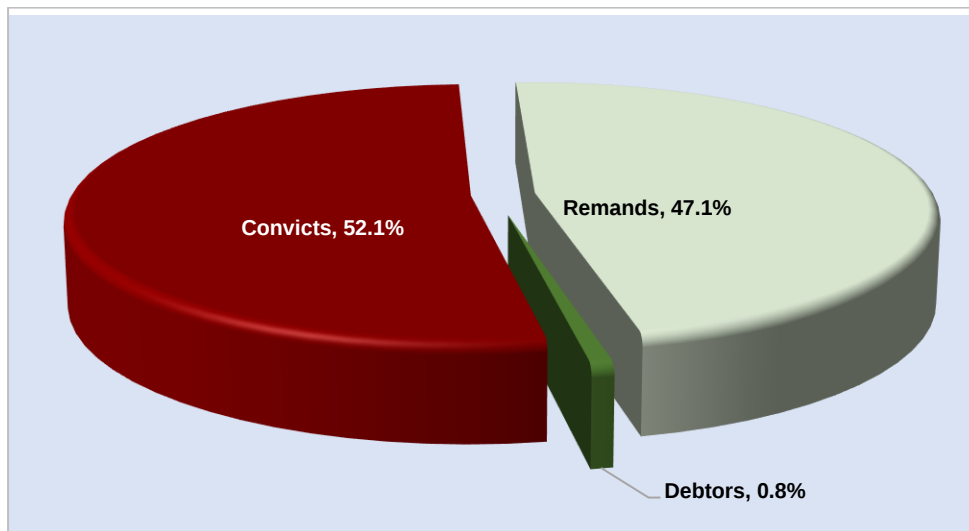


Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of May, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 52.1%, remand prisoners composed of 47.1%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners’ population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

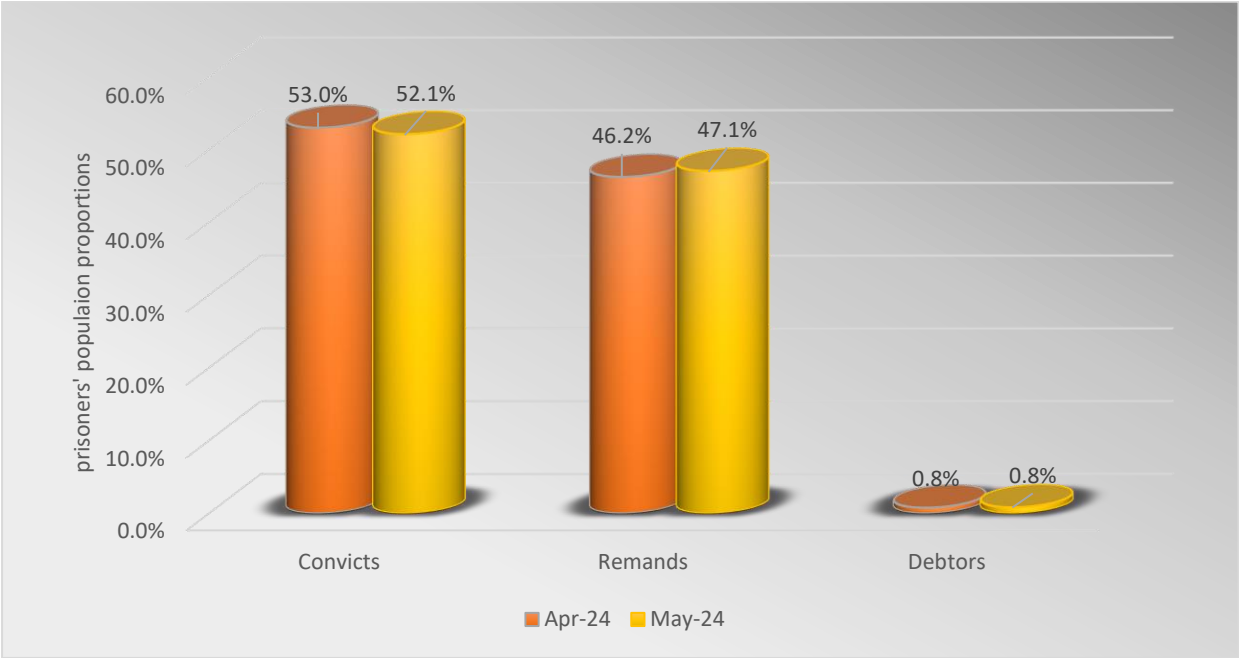


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with April, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.9% from 53.0% to 52.1%, remand prisoners increased by 0.9% from 46.2% to 47.1% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.8% of the average prisoners’ population in May, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners for the period July, 2023 to May, 2024

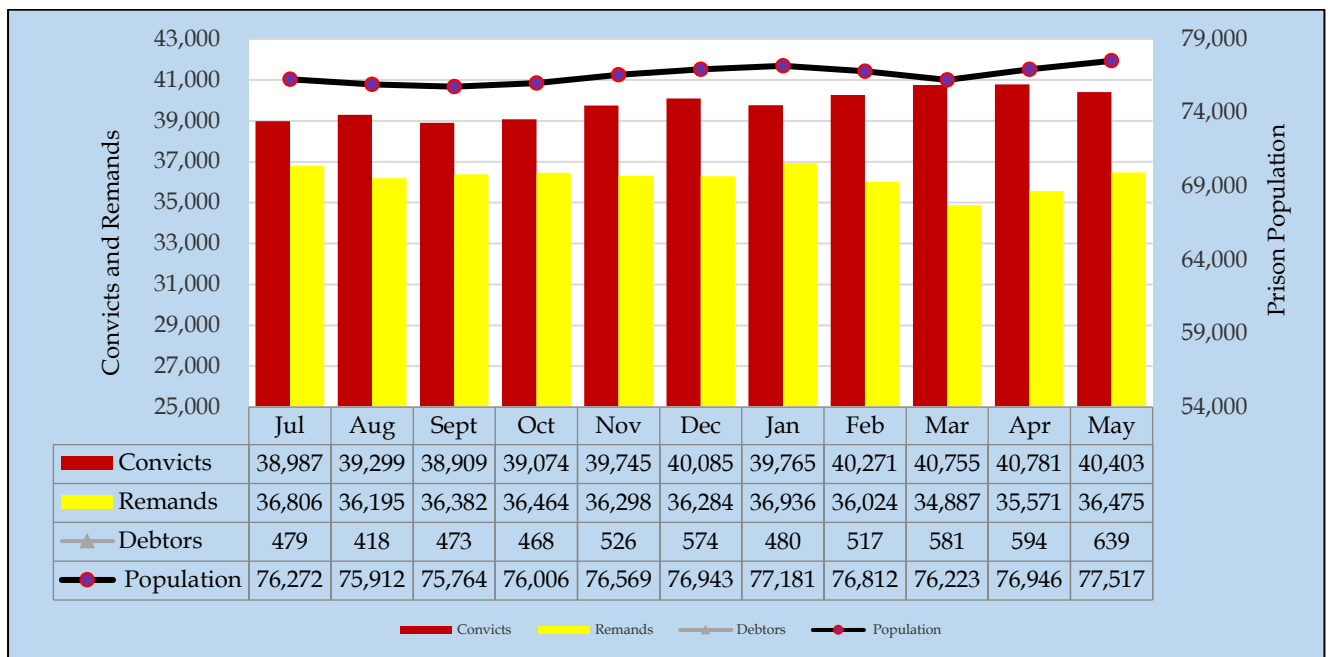


Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend July, 2023-May, 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that the daily average population of prisoners in custody for the last eleven (11) months was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 77,517 prisoners registered in May, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 38,987 prisoners in July, 2023 to 40,403 prisoners in May, 2024 while remand prisoners decreased from 36,806 prisoners in July, 2023 to 36,475 prisoners in May, 2024. The rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

1.5 Population composition trends for the period July, 2023 to May, 2024

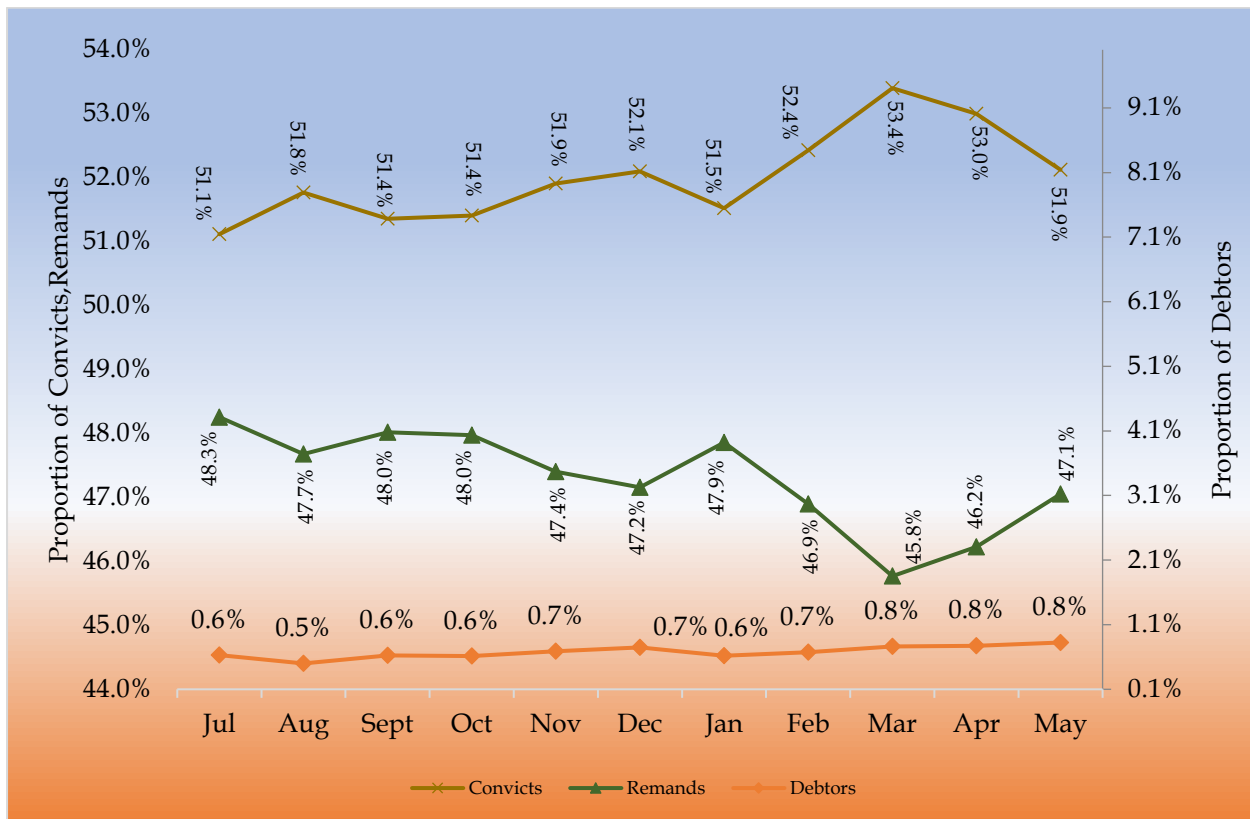


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2023 and May, 2024.

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last eleven (11) months. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% in the month of March, 2024 and an increase of up to 48.3% in the month of July, 2023. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 53.4% registered in the month of March, 2024 and a drop of up to 51.1% of the total prisoners' population in the month of July, 2023. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of May, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; East Central by 4.7%, Mid Eastern by 4.5%, Southern by 3.7%, Iganga by 3.4%, Kooki by 3.2%, Western by 2.2%, South Western by 2.0%, Mid Western by 1.8%, North Eastern by 1.6%, Kigezi by 0.8%, Northern and North Western by 0.7%, Kampala Extra by 0.2%, and Central by 0.1%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Mid Northern by 3.9%, North Central by 2.3%, South Eastern by 1.6%, Mid Central by 1.2%, and Eastern by 1.0%.

The regional prisoners' population change is largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts, reinforce farm labour and sometimes as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 278.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 639.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (09) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 20,996 prisoners, the occupancy rate increased by 2.7% from 366.5% to 369.2% due to the increase in prisoners' population by 0.9% from 76,946 in April, 2024 to 77,517 in May, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons increased during the month from 55,950 prisoners (266.5%) in April, 2024 to 56,521 (269.2%) prisoners in May, 2024 over and above the holding capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of May, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 19.8% from 33,913 in April, 2024 to 40,620 prisoners, a daily average of 1,846 prisoners. (See Table 1.3).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in May, 2024 decreased by 7.0% from 2,625 in April, 2024 to 2,441 prisoners, a daily average of 94 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.3).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of May, 2024 increased by 28.0% from 6,466 in April, 2024 to 8,274 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of April, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of May, 2024 increased by 22.9%, from 35 to 43 escapees. This resulted into an increase in the monthly escape rate from 0.5 per 1,000 to 0.6 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered between July, 2023 and May, 2024. Mid Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (46 escapes), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 19.3 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 4.9 per 1,000

prisoners. Out of the 374 prisoners who had escaped from custody within the same period, a total of 189 prisoners had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 50.5%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of May, 2024, the service lost a total of twenty four (24) prisoners through death which reflects a mortality rate of 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of April, 2024, the number of prisoners' deaths registered during the month of May, 2024 increased by 84.6% from 13 deaths registered in April, 2024 to 24 deaths. This resulted into an increase in the monthly mortality rate from 0.2/1,000 to 0.3/1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered between July, 2023 and May, 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 8.1 per 1,000 prisoners while Mid Central region had lowest mortality rate at 0.4 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 230 against daily average population of 76,556 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 3.0 per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st May, 2024 was 14,175 of which 13,672 were uniformed and 503 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,910 (69.9%) males and 4,265 (30.1%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,672 uniformed staff, 11,585 (84.7%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 shows that between July, 2023 and May, 2024, the service lost a total of 316 staff, majority of whom were deserters/absconders, accounting for 48.1% (152) of the entire attrition registered.
