ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of June, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 1.3% from 77,517 in May, 2024 to 78,541 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 1.9% from 36,475 to 37,157;
- Convicts increased by 0.9% from 40,403 to 40,760;
- Civil debtors decreased by 2.3% from 639 to 624;
- Remands composed of 47.3%, convicts 51.9%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Holding Capacity increased by 0.6% from 20,996 to 21,126 prisoners due to the expansion of the holding capacities at Bamunanika prison by 21 prisoners, Mukungwe by 14 prisoners, Maiha by 13 prisoners, Ntwetwe by 36 prisoners, and Lwabenge by 46 prisoners.
- Occupancy rate increased by 2.6% from 369.2% to 371.8%;
- A total of 2,602 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 108 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 38,233 – *a daily average of 2,012 prisoners*;
- 11,952 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 7,904 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- During the FY2023/24, prisoners' escape rate was 5.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 52.0%, while mortality rate stood at 3.3 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,145 with 13,642 uniformed and 503 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.9%; Female staff accounted for 30.1%;
- 11,576 (84.9%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of June, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 1.3% from 77,517 in May, 2024 to 78,541.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.9% from 40,403 to 40,760;
- Remands increased by 1.9% from 36,475 to 37,157;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 2.3% from 639 to 624.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of June, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 51.9%, remand prisoners composed of 47.3%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with May, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 52.1% to 51.9%, remand prisoners increased by 0.2% from 47.1% to 47.3% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in June, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners during the FY2023/24




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend during the FY2023/24.

Figure 1.3 shows that, the daily average population of prisoners in custody for the financial year 2023/24 was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 78,541 prisoners registered in June, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 38,987 prisoners in July, 2023 to 40,760 prisoners in June, 2024 while remand prisoners increased from 36,806 prisoners in July, 2023 to 37,157 prisoners in June, 2024. The rise in prisoners' population in June 2024 may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

1.5 Population composition trends during the FY2023/24




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors during the FY 2023/24

Figure 1.4 shows the monthly proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population for the FY2023/24. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% in the month of March, 2024 and an increase of up to 48.3% in the month of July, 2023. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 53.4% registered in the month of March, 2024 and a drop of up to 51.1% of the total

prisoners' population in the month of July, 2023. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of June, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Mid Eastern by 3.9%, Southern by 3.8%, East Central by 3.6%, Kooki by 3.4%, Kampala Extra by 2.7%, Central by 2.4%, North Western by 2.1%, South Western by 2.0%, Eastern by 1.4%, North Central by 1.3%, Kigezi by 1.0%, Mid Western by 0.9%, Northern by and North Eastern by 0.3%.

- The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Mid Northern by 2.4%, Iganga by 1.1%, Mid Central by 0.7%, Western and South Eastern by 0.4%.

The regional prisoners' population change is largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts, reinforce farm labour and sometimes as a decongestion measure.

- The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 293.
- The average number of debtors in custody was 624.
- The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (09) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

Despite the increase in the prisons holding capacity by 0.6% (130 prisoners) from 20,996 prisoners to 21,126 prisoners due to the expansion of Bamunanika prison by 21 prisoners, Mukungwe by 14 prisoners, Maiha by 13 prisoners, Ntwetwe by 36 prisoners, and Lwabenge by 46 prisoners the occupancy rate increased by 2.6% from 369.2% to 371.8% due to the increase in prisoners' population by 1.3% from 77,517 in May, 2024 to 78,541 in June, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons increased during the month from 56,521 prisoners (269.2%) in May, 2024 to 57,415 (271.8%) prisoners in June, 2024 over and above the holding capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of June, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 5.9% from 40,620 in May, 2024 to 38,233 prisoners, a daily average of 2,012 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in June, 2024 increased by 6.6% from 2,441 in May, 2024 to 2,602 prisoners, a daily average of 108 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of June, 2024 decreased by 4.5% from 8,274 in May, 2024 to 7,904 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of May, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of June, 2024 decreased by 20.9%, from 43 to 34 escapees. This resulted into a drop in the monthly escape rate from 0.6 per 1,000 to 0.4 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered during FY2023/24. Mid Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (48 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 19.2 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 5.3 per 1,000 prisoners. Out of

the 408 prisoners who had escaped from custody within the same period, a total of 212 prisoners had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 52.0%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of June, 2024, the service lost a total of twenty three (23) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of May, 2024, the number of prisoners' deaths registered during the month of June, 2024 dropped by 4.2% from 24 deaths registered in May 2024 to 23 deaths. However, the 4.2% drop did not have any effect on the change in mortality rate as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered during the FY2023/24. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 9.0 per 1,000 prisoners while Mid Central region had lowest mortality rate at 0.8 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 253 against daily average population of 76,724 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 3.3 per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 30th June, 2024 was 14,145 of which 13,642 were uniformed and 503 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,887 (69.9%) males and 4,258 (30.1%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,642 uniformed staff, 11,576 (84.9%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
