## **ABSTRACT**

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of August, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 1.2% from 79,530 in July, 2024 to 78,539 prisoners;
- Remands decreased by 2.5% from 37,644 to 36,719;
- Convicts increased by 0.2% from 41,236 to 41,320;
- Civil debtors decreased by 23.1% from 650 to 500;
- Remands composed of 46.8%, convicts 52.6%, and debtors 0.6% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 4.7% from 376.5% to 371.8%;
- A total of 2,970 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 110 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 40,048 – *a daily average of 1,820 prisoners*;
- 12,396 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 9,709 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period from January to August, 2024, prisoners' escape rate was 3.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 50.0%, while mortality rate stood at 2.2 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,097 with 13,596 uniformed and 501 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.8%; Female staff accounted for 30.2%;
- 11,491 (84.5%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

## 1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

### 1.1 Population Change

During the month of August, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 1.2% from 79,530 in July, 2024 to 78,539.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.2% from 41,236 to 41,320;
- Remands decreased by 2.5% from 37,644 to 36,719;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 23.1% from 650 to 500.

### 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of August, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 52.6%, remand prisoners composed of 46.8%, while civil debtors composed of 0.6%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

### 1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with July, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.7% from 51.9% to 52.6%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.5% from 47.3% to 46.8% while that of civil debtors decreased by 0.2 from 0.8% to 0.6% of the average prisoners' population in August, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

### 1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners, January, 2024 -August, 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend for the period from January to August 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that, the daily average population of prisoners in custody since January 2024 was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 79,530 prisoners registered in July, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 39,765 prisoners in January, 2024 to 41,320 prisoners in August, 2024 while remand prisoners decreased from 36,936 prisoners in January, 2024 to 36,719 prisoners in August, 2024. The general rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

## 1.5 Prisoners' Population composition trends, January, 2024 - August, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors from January to August 2024

Figure 1.4 shows the monthly proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population since Janaury 2024. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% in the month of March, 2024 and an increase of up to 47.9% in the month of Janaury, 2024. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 53.4% registered in the month of March, 2024 and a drop of up to 51.5%

of the total prisoners' population in the month of January, 2024. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of August, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Mid Eastern by 5.5%, Mid Northern by 2.4%, South Eastern, Western, and Eastern by 1.1%, North Western by 1.0%, Northern by 0.5%, East Central by 0.4%, Central and Mid Western by 0.2%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Kampala Extra by 8.4%, Kigezi by 4.1%, Mid Central by 2.9%, South Western and North Eastern by 2.1 %, Kooki and North Central by 2.0%, Southern by 1.1%, and Iganga by 0.8%.

The regional prisoners' population change is largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts, reinforce farm labour and sometimes as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 299.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 500.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

### **1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons**

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 21,126 prisoners, the occupancy rate decreased by 4.7% from 376.5% to 371.8% due to the decrease in prison population by 1.2% from 79,530 in July, 2024 to 78,539 in August, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons decreased during the month from 58,404 prisoners (276.5%) in July, 2024 to 57,413 (271.8%) prisoners in August, 2024 over and above the holding capacity of prisons countrywide.

### **1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases**

During the month of August, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 9.2% from 44,082 in July, 2024 to 40,048 prisoners, a daily average of 1,820 prisoners. (See Table 1.3).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in August, 2024 decreased by 18.5% from 3,644 in July, 2024 to 2,970 prisoners, a daily average of 110 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.3).

## 1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of August, 2024 increased by 6.0% from 9,162 in July, 2024 to 9,709 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of July, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of August, 2024 decreased by 16.2%, from 37 to 31 escapees. This resulted into a decrease in the monthly escape rate from 0.5 per 1,000 to 0.4 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered from January 2024 to August 2024. South Western region registered the highest number of escapes (23 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 11.3 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 3.3 per 1,000 prisoners. Out of the 258 prisoners who had escaped from custody within the same period, a total of 129 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 50.0%.

## 1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of August, 2024, the service lost a total of twenty five (25) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of July, 2024, the number of prisoners' deaths registered during the month of August, 2024 increased by 31.6% from 19 deaths registered in July 2024 to 25 deaths. This resulted into an increase in mortality rate by 0.1% as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered from January, 2024 to August, 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 6.0 per 1,000 prisoners while Central region had lowest mortality rate at 0.7 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 174 against daily average population of 77,661 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.2 per 1,000 prisoners.

## 2 STAFFING POSITION

### 2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2024 was 14,097 of which 13,596 were uniformed and 501 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,845 (69.8%) males and 4,252 (30.1%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,596 uniformed staff, 11,491 (84.5%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
