ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of September, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 78,539 in August, 2024 to 78,098 prisoners;
- Remands decreased by 0.7% from 36,719 to 36,468;
- Convicts decreased by 0.6% from 41,320 to 41,090;
- Civil debtors increased by 8.0% from 500 to 540;
- Remands composed of 46.7%, convicts 52.6%, and debtors 0.7% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 4.0% from 371.8% to 367.8%;
- A total of 2,568 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 103 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 37,655 – *a daily average of 1,793 prisoners*;
- 9,842 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 7,568 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period from January to September, 2024, prisoners' escape rate was 3.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 51.8%, while mortality rate stood at 2.5 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,074 with 13,576 uniformed and 498 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.8%; Female staff accounted for 30.2%;
- 11,435 (84.5%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of September, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 78,539 in August, 2024 to 78,098.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 0.6% from 41,320 to 41,090;
- Remands decreased by 0.7% from 36,719 to 36,468;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 8.0% from 500 to 540.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of September, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 52.6%, remand prisoners composed of 46.7%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with August, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners remained at 52.6%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.1% from 46.8% to 46.7% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1 from 0.6% to 0.7% of the average prisoners' population in September, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners, January -September, 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend for the period from January to September, 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that, the daily average population of prisoners in custody since January, 2024 was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 79,530 prisoners registered in July, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 39,765 prisoners in January, 2024 to 41,090 prisoners in September, 2024 while remand prisoners decreased from 36,936 prisoners in January, 2024 to 36,468 prisoners in September, 2024. The general rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

1.5 Prisoners' Population composition trends, January - September, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors from January to September, 2024

Figure 1.4 shows the monthly proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors to the total prisoners' population since Janaury, 2024. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% in the month of March, 2024. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 53.4% registered in the month of March, 2024.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of September, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Mid Eastern by 4.5%, Iganga by 2.2%, Western by 1.4%, South Eastern by 1.2%, North Western by 1.0%, Southern and Mid Western by 0.7%, Mid Northern by 0.6%, and Kigezi by 0.4%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; North Western by 7.5%, Kooki by 5.4%, East Central by 4.9%, Mid Central by 3.2%, Eastern by 2.3%, South Western by 1.6%, Kampala Extra by 1.3%, Central by 0.9%, and North Central by 0.04%. Northern remained unchanged. The regional

prisoners' population change was largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 309.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 540.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

With the prisons holding capacity increased by 0.4% from 21,126 to 21,201 prisoners resulting from expansion of prisoners' accommodation at Aswa I and Aswa II , and the decrease in prison population by 0.6% from 78,539 in August, 2024 to 78,098 prisoners in September, 2024, the occupancy rate reduced by 3.4% from 371.8% in August, 2024 to 368.4% in September, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons decreased during the month from 57,413 prisoners (271.8%) in August, 2024 to 56,897 (268.4%) prisoners in September, 2024 over and above the holding capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of September, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 6.0% from 40,048 in August, 2024 to 37,655 prisoners, a daily average of 1,793 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in September, 2024 decreased by 13.5% from 2,970 in August, 2024 to 2,568 prisoners, a daily average of 103 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of September, 2024 decreased by 22.1% from 9,709 in August, 2024 to 7,568 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of August, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of September, 2024 decreased by 16.1%, from 31

to 26 escapees. This resulted into a decrease in the monthly escape rate from 0.4 per 1,000 to 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered from January to September, 2024. Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (25 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 13.1 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 3.7 per 1,000 prisoners. Out

of the 284 prisoners that had escaped from lawful custody within the same period, a total of 147 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 51.8%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of September, 2024, the service lost a total of nineteen (19) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered from January to September, 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 6.8 per 1,000 prisoners while Central region had the lowest mortality rate at 0.7 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall

number of deaths in the time period was 193 against a daily average population of 77,709 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.5 per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 30th September, 2024 was 14,074 of which 13,576 were uniformed and 498 were non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,826 (69.8%) males and 4,248 (30.1%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,576 uniformed staff, 11,432 (84.2%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 shows that, for the period from January to September, 2024, the service lost a total of 256 staff, majority of whom were deserters/absconders, accounting for 48.0% of the entire attrition.
