ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of July, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 1.3% from 78,541 in June, 2024 to 79,530 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 1.3% from 37,157 to 37,644;
- Convicts increased by 1.2% from 40,760 to 41,236;
- Civil debtors increased by 4.2% from 624 to 650;
- Remands composed of 47.3%, convicts 51.9%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 4.7% from 371.8% to 376.5%;
- A total of 3,644 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 135 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 44,082 – *a daily average of 1,917 prisoners*;
- 11,918 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 9,162 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period from January to July, 2024, prisoners' escape rate was 2.9 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 50.2%, while mortality rate stood at 1.9 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,121 with 13,642 uniformed and 502 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.9%; Female staff accounted for 30.1%;
- 11,510 (84.5%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of July, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 1.3% from 78,541 in June, 2024 to 79,530.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 1.2% from 40,760 to 41,236;
- Remands increased by 1.3% from 37,157 to 37,644;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 4.2% from 624 to 650.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

In the month of July, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 51.9%, remand prisoners composed of 47.3%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with June, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners ,remand prisoners, and civil debtors remained the same at 51.9%, 47.3%, and 0.8% of the average prisoners' population respectively in July, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners, January, 2024 -July, 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend for the period from January to July 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that, the daily average population of prisoners in custody since January 2024 was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 79,530 prisoners registered in July, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 39,765 prisoners in January, 2024 to 41,236 prisoners in July, 2024 while remand prisoners increased from 36,936 prisoners in January, 2024 to 37,644 prisoners in July, 2024. The rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

1.5 Prisoners' Population composition trends, January, 2024 - July, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors from January to July 2024

Figure 1.4 shows the monthly proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population since Janaury 2024. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, with a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% in the month of March, 2024 and an increase of up to 47.9% in the month of Janaury, 2024. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark with a remarkable increase of up to 53.4% registered in the month of March, 2024 and a drop of up to 51.5% of the total prisoners' population in the month of Janaury, 2024. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of July, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Southern by 4.5%, Kampala Extra by 3.5%, East Central by 3.1%, South Eastern by 2.6%, North Central by 2.4%, Eastern by 2.2%, Mid Western by 2.0%, Central and Northern by 1.7%, Iganga by 1.5%, North Western by 1.0%, South Western by 0.8%, Mid Eastern by 0.7%, and North Eastern by 0.3%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Kigezi by 3.6%, Western by 2.0%, Mid Central by 1.9%, Kooki by 1.1 %, and Mid Northern by 0.4%.

The regional prisoners' population change is largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts, reinforce farm labour and sometimes as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 273.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 650.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 21,126 prisoners, the occupancy rate increased by 4.7% from 371.8% to 376.5% due to the increase in prison population by 1.5% from 78,541 in June, 2024 to 79,530 in July, 2024. Similarly, congestion in prisons increased during the month from 57,415 prisoners (271.8%) in June, 2024 to 58,404 (276.5%) prisoners in July, 2024 over and above the holding capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of July, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 15.3% from 38,233 in June, 2024 to 44,082 prisoners, a daily average of 1,917 prisoners. (See Table 1.3).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in July, 2024 increased by 40.0% from 2,602 in June, 2024 to 3,644 prisoners, a daily average of 135 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.3).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of July, 2024 increased by 15.9% from 7,904 in June, 2024 to 9,162 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of June, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of July, 2024 increased by 8.8%, from 34 to 37 escapees. This resulted into an increase in the monthly escape rate from 0.4 per 1,000 to 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered for the period from January, 2024 to July, 2024. South Western region registered the highest number of escapes (14 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 10.8 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 2.9 per 1,000 prisoners. Out of the 227 prisoners who had escaped from custody within the same period, a total of 114 prisoners had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 50.2%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of July, 2024, the service lost a total of nineteen (19) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.12 shows the number of prisoners' death registered from January, 2024 to July 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 5.0 per 1,000 prisoners while Central region had lowest mortality rate at 0.7 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 150 against daily average population of 77,536 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 1.9 per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st July, 2024 was 14,121 of which 13,619 were uniformed and 502 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,868 (69.9%) males and 4,253 (30.1%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,619 uniformed staff, 11,510 (84.5%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
