## **ABSTRACT**

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of October, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.1% from 78,098 in September, 2024 to 78,057 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 0.1% from 36,468 to 36,520;
- Convicts decreased by 0.3% from 41,090 to 40,950;
- Civil debtors increased by 8.7% from 540 to 587;
- Remands composed of 46.8%, convicts 52.4%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 0.3% from 367.5% to 367.2%;
- A total of 2,819 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 108 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 41,336 – *a daily average of 1,879 prisoners*;
- 11,941 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 8,761 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period from January to October, 2024, prisoners' escape rate was 4.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 51.6%, while mortality rate stood at 2.6 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,044 with 13,548 uniformed and 496 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.8%; Female staff accounted for 30.2%;
- 11,470 (84.7%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

### 1.1 Population Change

During the month of October, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.1% from 78,098 in September, 2024 to 78,057.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 0.3% from 41,090 to 40,950;
- Remands increased by 0.1% from 36,468 to 36,520;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 8.7% from 540 to 587.

### 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

During the month of October, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 52.4%, remand prisoners composed of 46.8%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

### 1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with September, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 52.6% to 52.4%, remand prisoners increased by 0.1% from 46.7% to 46.8% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1 from 0.7% to 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in October, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

### 1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners, January, 2024 -October, 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend for the period from January to October, 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that, the daily average population of prisoners in custody since January, 2024 was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 79,530 prisoners registered in July, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 39,765 prisoners in January, 2024 to 41,050 prisoners in October, 2024 while remand prisoners decreased from 36,936 prisoners in January, 2024 to 36,520 prisoners in October, 2024. The general rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

## 1.5 Prisoners' Population composition trends, January, 2024 - October, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors from January to October, 2024

Figure 1.4 shows the monthly proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population since January, 2024. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, from 47.9% in January, 2024 to the current 46.8% in the month of October, 2024. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark, from 51.5% in January, 2024 to the current 52.4% in October, 2024. It

should be noted that a remarkable drop of up to 45.8% for remand prisoners and an increase of up to 53.4% for convicted prisoners registered in the month of March, 2024.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of October, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; North Central by 5.4%, Mid Northern by 2.3%, North Eastern by 1.8%, Kampala Extra by 1.6%, Mid Western by 0.8%, Eastern by 0.5%, Mid Eastern by 0.1%, and Kigezi by 0.04%.

2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Iganga by 3.1%, North Western by 2.6%, Kooki by 2.3%, South Western and Mid Central by 1.4%, Northern by 1.0%, Central by 0.9%, East Central by 0.8%, Western by 0.7%, Southern by 0.4% and South Eastern by 0.3%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 291.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 587.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

### **1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons**

With the increase in the prisons holding capacity by 0.04% from at 21,249 to 21,257 prisoners through provision of prisoners accommodation at the new UG. Prison Aswa III, and the decrease in prison population by 0.1% from 78,098 in September, 2024 to 78,057 in October, 2024, the occupancy rate decreased by 0.3% from 367.5% to 367.2%. Similarly, congestion in prisons decreased during the month from 56,849 prisoners (267.5%) in September, 2024 to 56,800 (267.2%) prisoners in October, 2024 over and above the holding capacity of prisons countrywide.

### **1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases**

During the month of October, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 9.8% from 37,655 in September, 2024 to 41,336 prisoners, a daily average of 1,879 prisoners. (See Table 1.3).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in October, 2024 increased by 9.8% from 2,568 in September, 2024 to 2,819 prisoners, a daily average of 108 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.3).

### 1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of October , 2024 increased by 15.8% from 7,568 in September, 2024 to 8,761 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of September, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of October, 2024 decreased by 7.7%, from 26 to 24 escapees. However, the decrease in the number of escapees during the month of October 2024 didn't have any impact on the escape rate due to a drop in prisoners' population by 0.1% as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered from January 2024 to October, 2024. Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (27 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 14.9 per 1,000 prisoners, and lowest in Kampala Extra region at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 4.0 per 1,000

prisoners. Out of the 308 prisoners that had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 159 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 51.6%.

## 1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of October, 2024, the service lost a total of eleven (11) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.1 per 1,000 prisoners.

In comparison with the month of September, 2024, the number of prisoners' deaths registered during the month of October, 2024 decreased by 42.1% from 19 deaths registered in September 2024 to 11 deaths. This resulted into a decrease in monthly mortality rate from 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners to 0.1 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the mortality of prisoners registered from January, 2024 to October, 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 7.2 per 1,000 prisoners while Central region had lowest mortality rate at 0.7 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 204 against daily average population of 77,744 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.6 per 1,000 prisoners.

## 2 STAFFING POSITION

### 2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2024 was 14,044 of which 13,548 were uniformed and 496 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,801 (69.8%) males and 4,243 (30.1%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,548 uniformed staff, 11,470 (84.7%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
