ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of November, 2024. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.8% from 78,057 in October, 2024 to 78,700 prisoners;
- Remands increased by 2.1% from 36,520 to 37,304;
- Convicts decreased by 0.4% from 40,950 to 40,792;
- Civil debtors increased by 2.9% from 587 to 604;
- Remands composed of 47.4%, convicts 51.8%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 3.0% from 367.2% to 370.2%;
- A total of 2,509 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 97 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 37,010 – *a daily average of 1,762 prisoners*;
- 11,508 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 7,828 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period from January to November, 2024, prisoners' escape rate was 4.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 51.7%, while mortality rate stood at 2.8 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 14,021 with 13,528 uniformed and 493 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.8%; Female staff accounted for 30.2%;
- 11,464 (84.7%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of November, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.8% from 78,057 in October, 2024 to 78,700.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 0.4% from 40,950 to 40,792;
- Remands increased by 2.1% from 36,520 to 37,304;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 2.9% from 587 to 604.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

During the month of November, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 51.8%, remand prisoners composed of 47.4%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with October, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 52.4% to 51.8%, remand prisoners increased by 0.6% from 46.8% to 47.4% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in November, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Population Trends of Prisoners, January, 2024 -November, 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prisoners' population trend for the period from January to November, 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that, the daily average population of prisoners in custody since January, 2024 was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 79,530 prisoners registered in July, 2024. In the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 39,765 prisoners in January, 2024 to 40,792 prisoners in November, 2024 while remand prisoners increased from 36,936 prisoners in January, 2024 to 37,304 prisoners in November, 2024. The general rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

1.5 Prisoners' Population composition trends, January, 2024 - November, 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors from January to November, 2024

Figure 1.4 shows the monthly proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population since January, 2024. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 45.8% and 47.9% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 53.4% for the entire time period.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of November, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Southern by 6.0%, North Eastern by 4.2%, Northern by 3.1%, East Central by 2.3%, Kigezi by 2.2%, Mid Eastern by 2.1%, Kampala Extra by 1.1%, North Central by 0.8%, Kooki by 0.7%, North Western by 0.5%, Mid Northern and Mid Western by 0.1%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Eastern by 0.8%, Western by 0.5%, Mid Central by 0.3%, South Eastern, Iganga, and Central by 0.2%, and South Western by 0.1%. The regional prisoners'

population change was largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 310.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 604.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Occupancy rate versus Congestion in Prisons

With the prisons holding capacity maintained at 21,257 prisoners, the occupancy rate increased by 0.3% from 367.2% to 370.2% due to the increase in the prison population by 0.8% from 78,057 in October, 2024 to 78,700 in November, 2024.

Similarly, congestion in prisons increased during the month from 56,800 prisoners (267.2%) in October, 2024 to 57,443 (270.2%) prisoners in November, 2024 over and above the holding capacity of prisons countrywide.

1.8 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of November, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 10.5% from 41,336 in October, 2024 to 37,010 prisoners, a daily average of 1,762 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in November, 2024 decreased by 11.0% from 2,819 in October, 2024 to 2,509 prisoners, a daily average of 97 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of November, 2024 decreased by 10.6% from 8,761 in October, 2024 to 7,828 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of October, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of November, 2024 increased by 58.3%, from 24 to 38 escapees. This resulted into an increase in monthly escape rate from 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners to 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered from January, 2024 to November, 2024. Northern region registered the highest number of escapees (31 escapees), however the number of escapes per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 16.1 per 1,000 prisoners, followed by Iganga region at 11.3 per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region had the lowest escape rate at 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners. The

overall escape rate registered for the period was 4.4 per 1,000 prisoners. Out of the 346 prisoners that had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 179 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 51.7%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of November, 2024, the service lost a total of sixteen (16) prisoners through death.

In comparison with the month of October, 2024, the number of deaths registered during the month of November, 2024 increased by 45.5% from 11 deaths registered in October 2024 to 16 deaths. This resulted into an increase in monthly mortality rate from 0.1 per 1,000 prisoners to 0.2 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.11.

Table 1.12 shows the mortality of prisoners registered from January, 2024 to November, 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 8.1 per 1,000 prisoners while Kigezi region had lowest mortality rate at 0.8 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 220 against daily average population of 77,831 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 2.8 per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 30th November, 2024 was 14,021 of which 13,528 were uniformed and 493 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,784 (69.8%) males and 4,237 (30.2%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,528 uniformed staff, 11,464 (84.7%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.3 shows that there was a decrease in the number of staff declared as deserters in November, 2024 by 54.5% compared to those declared in October, 2024.
