ABSTRACT

- The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, congestion levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of December, 2024. To note therefore is that;
- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.6% from 78,700 in November, 2024 to 79,208 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 1.6% from 40,792 to 41,438;
- Remands decreased by 0.6% from 37,304 to 37,097;
- Civil debtors increased by 11.4% from 604 to 673;
- Remands composed of 46.8%, convicts 52.4%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 2.4% from 370.2% to 372.6%;
- A total of 2,443 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 102 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 31,051 – *a daily average of 1,553 prisoners*;
- 8,665 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,647 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the year 2024, prisoners' escape rate was 4.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 53.8%, while mortality rate stood at 3.1 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 13,972 with 13,484 uniformed and 488 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.7%; Female staff accounted for 30.3%;
- 11,461 (85.0%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 266 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of December, 2024, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.6% from 78,700 in November, 2024 to 79,208.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 1.6% from 40,792 to 41,438;
- Remands decreased by 0.6% from 37,304 to 37,097;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 11.4% from 604 to 673.
- Occupancy rate increased by 2.4% from 370.2 to 372.6

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

During the month of December, 2024, convicted prisoners composed of 52.4%, remand prisoners composed of 46.8%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with November, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.6% from 51.8% to 52.4%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 47.4% to 46.8% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in December, 2024 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison population trends for the year 2024




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the year 2024.

Figure 1.3 shows that, the daily average population of prisoners in custody for the year 2024 was generally on the rise with a remarkable increase of upto 79,530 prisoners registered in July, 2024. During the same period, convicted prisoners increased from a daily average of 39,765 prisoners in January, 2024 to 41,438 prisoners in December, 2024 while remand prisoners increased from 36,936 prisoners in January, 2024 to 37,097 prisoners in December, 2024. The general rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals and expansion of court operations.

1.5 Prison population composition trends for the year 2024




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the year 2024

Figure 1.4 shows the monthly proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population since January, 2024. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 45.8% and 47.9% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 53.4% for the entire time period.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of December, 2024;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Iganga by 5.1%, Kooki by 4.9%, Mid Central by 3.0%, Western by 2.9%, South Western by 2.0%, Central by 1.6%, Southern and North Eastern by 1.3%, Mid Eastern by 1.2%, Northern by 1.1%, East Central by 1.0%, Kigezi by 0.7%, Mid Western by 0.4%, and South Eastern by 0.3%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Kampala Extra by 2.0%, Mid Northern by 1.8%, Eastern by 1.4%, North Central by 0.5%, and North Western by 0.4%. The regional prisoners' population change was

largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 278.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 673.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 266 custodial units countrywide.

During the month of December, 2024, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 16.6% from 37,238 in November, 2024 to 31,051 prisoners, a daily average of 1,553 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in December, 2024 decreased by 2.9% from 2,516 in November, 2024 to 2,443 prisoners, a daily average of 102 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.8 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of December, 2024 decreased by 15.1% from 7,828 in November, 2024 to 6,647 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of November, 2024, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of December, 2024 decreased by 36.8%, from 38

to 24 escapees. This resulted into a drop in monthly escape rate from 0.5 per 1,000 prisoners to 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered in 2024. Northern region registered the highest number of escapees (34 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 16.1 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, followed by Iganga region at 12.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region had the lowest escape rate at 0.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. The

overall escape rate registered for the period was 4.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Out of the 370 prisoners that had escaped from lawful custody during the year 2024, 199 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 53.8%.

1.11 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of December, 2024, the service lost a total of nineteen (19) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.12 shows the mortality of prisoners registered in 2024. Kampala Extra region had the highest mortality rate at 8.7 deaths per 1,000 prisoners while Central region had lowest mortality rate at 0.7 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 239 against the daily average population of 77,945 prisoners, reflecting an overall mortality rate of 3.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st December, 2024 was 13,972 of which 13,484 were uniformed and 488 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,742 (69.7%) males and 4,230 (30.3%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,484 uniformed staff, 11,461 (85.0%) were deployed in custodial units across the 266 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 shows that, in 2024, the service lost a total of 357 staff, with desertion being the leading mode of staff attrition and constituting up to 40.9% of the entire attrition.
