MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

JANUARY, 2025

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ABSTRACT

- The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of January, 2025. To note therefore is that;
- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.4% from 79,208 in December, 2024 to 79,563 prisoners;
- Convicts decreased by 1.1% from 41,438 to 40,997;
- Remands increased by 2.5% from 37,097 to 38,028;
- Civil debtors decreased by 20.1% from 673 to 538;
- Remands composed of 47.8%, convicts 51.5%, and debtors 0.7% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.7% from 372.6% to 374.3%;
- A total of 2,406 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 93 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 38,020 – *a daily average of 1,728 prisoners*;
- 9,990 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,528 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July, 2024 to January, 2025, prisoners' escape rate was 2.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 46.0%, while crude mortality rate stood at 1.6 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 13,944 with 13,457 uniformed and 487 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.7%; Female staff accounted for 30.3%;
- 11,384 (84.6%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 267 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.
- UG. Prison Moroto Women was made independent of UG. Prison Moroto Main, hence increasing the number of prison stations to 267 from 266.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of January, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.4% from 79,208 in December, 2025 to 79,563.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 1.1% from 41,438 to 40,997;
- Remands increased by 2.5% from 37,097 to 38,028;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 20.1% from 673 to 538;
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.7% from 372.6 to 374.3.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

During the month of January, 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 51.5%, remand prisoners composed of 47.8%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with December, 2024, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.9% from 52.4% to 51.5%, remand prisoners increased by 1.0% from 46.8% to 47.8% while that of civil debtors decreased by 0.1% from 0.8% to 0.7% of the average prisoners' population in January, 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison population trends from July, 2024 to January, 2025




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July, 2024-January, 2025.

Figure 1.3 shows the prisoners' population trend for the financial year 2024/25 from July, 2024 to January 2025. The figure indicates a downward trend for the first four months during which the monthly prisoners population decreased from 79,530 prisoners in July, 2024 to 78,057 prisoners in October 2024. The prisoners population thereafter started increasing to the current 79,563 prisoners in the month of January, 2025. The general rise in prisoners' population in the last three months may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals before, during and after the festive season.

Between the period July, 2024 and January, 2025, convicts decreased from 41,236 to 40,997 prisoners while remand prisoners increased from 37,644 to 38,028.

1.5 Prison population trends from July, 2024 to January, 2025




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period July, 2024 to January, 2025

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last seven months of the financial year 2024/25. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.7% and

47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 52.6% for the entire time period.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of January, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; North Central and South Western by 2.3%, North Western by 1.9%, Central and Kigezi by 1.7%, Mid Western by 1.5%, Southern by 1.4%, North Eastern by 1.2%, Iganga and Northern by 0.9%, Eastern by 0.3%, Western by 0.2%, and Mid Eastern by 0.1%.

2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Kooki by 3.2%, Mid Central by 1.9%, East Central by 1.6%, South Eastern by 1.5%, Kampala Extra by 1.0% and Mid Northern by 0.7%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 271.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 538.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 267 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of January, 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 22.4% from 31,051 in December, 2025 to 38,020 prisoners, a daily average of 1,728 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in January, 2025 decreased by 1.5% from 2,443 in December, 2025 to 2,406 prisoners, a daily average of 93 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.8 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of January, 2025 decreased by 1.8% from 6,647 in December, 2025 to 6,528 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of December, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of January, 2025 decreased by 62.5%, from 24 to 9 escapees. This resulted into a drop in the monthly escape rate from 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners to 0.1 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered during the period between July, 2024 and January, 2025. Northern region registered the highest number of escapees (22 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 7.5 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, followed by Iganga region at 6.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate registered for the period was 2.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Of the 189 prisoners that had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 87 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 46.0%.

1.11 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of January, 2025, the service lost a total of twenty (20) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.12 shows the mortality of prisoners registered during the period between July, 2024 and January, 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 4.9 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Central, East Central and Kooki regions had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 128 against the daily average population of 78,814 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.6 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st January, 2025 was 13,944 of which 13,457 were uniformed and 487 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,719 (69.7%) males and 4,225 (30.3%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,457 uniformed staff, 11,384 (84.6%) were deployed in custodial units across the 267 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
