ABSTRACT

- The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of February , 2025. To note therefore is that;
- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.01% from 79,563 in January, 2025 to 79,574 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.1% from 40,997 to 41,055;
- Remands decreased by 0.2%from 38,028 to 37,952;
- Civil debtors increased by 5.4% from 538 to 567;
- Remands composed of 47.7%, convicts 51.6%, and debtors 0.7% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate remained at to 374.3%;
- A total of 2,401 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 100 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 38,269– *a daily average of 1,913 prisoners*;
- 9,653 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 7,221 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July, 2024 to February, 2025, prisoners' escape rate was 2.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 45.5%, while mortality rate stood at 1.9 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 13,922 with 13,436 uniformed and 486 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.7%; Female staff accounted for 30.3%;
- 11,382 (84.7%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 268 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.
- UG. Prison Maracha was opened in the North Western Region, hence increasing the number of prison stations from 267 to 268.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of February, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.01% from 79,563 in January, 2025 to 79,574.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.1% from 40,997 to 41,055;
- Remands decreased by 0.2% from 38,028 to 37,952;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 5.4% from 538 to 567;
- Occupancy rate remained at 374.3%.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

During the month of February, 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 51.6%, remand prisoners composed of 47.7%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with January, 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.1% from 51.5% to 51.6%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.1% from 47.8% to 47.7% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.7% of the average prisoners' population in February, 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison population trends from July, 2024 to February, 2025




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July, 2024-February, 2025.

Figure 1.3 shows the prisoners' population trend for the financial year 2024/25 from July, 2024 to February, 2025. The figure indicates a downward trend for the first four months during which the monthly prisoners population decreased from 79,530 prisoners in July, 2024 to 78,057 prisoners in October, 2024. The prisoners population thereafter started increasing to the current 79,574 prisoners in the month of February, 2025. The general rise in prisoners' population in the last four months may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals before, during and after the festive season.

Between the period July, 2024 and February, 2025, convicts decreased from 41,236 to 41,055 prisoners while remand prisoners increased from 37,644 to 37,952.

1.5 Prison population trends from July, 2024 to February, 2025




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period July, 2024 to February, 2025

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last eight months of the financial year 2024/25. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.7% and

47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0 mark, ranging between 51.5% and 52.6% for the entire time period.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of February, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Southern by 2.3%, North Eastern by 1.9%, Kampala Extra by 1.7%, East Central by 1.3%, Kigezi by 1.1%, North Central and Kooki by 1.0%, South Eastern and Eastern by 0.8%, Mid Central and Northern by 0.7%, Central and North Western by 0.6%, and South Western by 0.3%.

2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Iganga by 5.0%, Mid Eastern by 3.5%, Mid Western by 3.2%, Mid Northern by 2.3%, and Western by 2.2%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 294.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 567.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 268 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of February, 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 0.7% from 38,020 in January, 2025 to 38,269 prisoners, a daily average of 1,913 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in February, 2025 decreased by 0.2% from 2,406 in December, 2025 to 2,401 prisoners, a daily average of 100 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.8 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of February, 2025 increased by 10.6% from 6,528 in January, 2025 to 7,221 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of January, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of February, 2025 increased by 166.7%, from 09 to 24 escapees. This resulted into an increase in the monthly escape rate from 0.1 per 1,000 prisoners to 0.3 per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.8.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered during the period between July, 2024 and February, 2025. Northern region registered the highest number of escapees (23 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 7.5 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate registered during the period was 2.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 213 prisoners that had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 97 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 45.5%.

1.11 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of February, 2025, the service lost a total of twenty (20) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.12 shows the mortality of prisoners registered during the period between July, 2024 and February, 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 5.6 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. East Central and Kooki regions had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 148 against the daily average population of 78,911 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.9 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 28th February, 2025 was 13,922 of which 13,436 were uniformed and 486 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,701 (69.7%) males and 4,221 (30.3%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,436 uniformed staff, 11,382 (84.7%) were deployed in custodial units across the 268 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 shows that, between July, 2024 and February, 2025, the service had lost a total of 217 staff, with retirement being the leading mode of staff attrition, constituting up to 48.8% of the overall attrition.
