MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

MARCH, 2025

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ABSTRACT

- The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of March , 2025. To note therefore is that;
- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.3% from 79,574 in February, 2025 to 79,333 prisoners;
- Convicts decreased by 0.2% from 41,055 to 40,956;
- Remands decreased by 0.5% from 37,952 to 37,754;
- Civil debtors increased by 9.9% from 567 to 623;
- Remands composed of 47.6%, convicts 51.6%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate reduced by 14.1% from 374.3% to 360.3%;
- A total of 2,861 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 114 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 39,367 – *a daily average of 1,875 prisoners*;
- 9,496 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,611 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July, 2024 to March, 2025, prisoners' escape rate was 3.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 47.9%, while mortality rate stood at 2.1 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 13,941 with 13,449 uniformed and 492 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.6%; Female staff accounted for 30.4%;
- 11,264 (83.7%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 268 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change



During the month of March, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.3% from 79,574 in February, 2025 to 79,333.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts decreased by 0.2% from 41,055 to 40,956;
- Remands decreased by 0.5% from 37,952 to 37,754;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 9.9% from 567 to 623;
- Occupancy rate reduced by 14.1% from 374.3% at 360.3%.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors



During the month of March, 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 51.6%, remand prisoners composed of 47.6%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with February, 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners remained at 51.6%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.1% from 47.7% to 47.6% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.7% to 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in March, 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison population trends from July, 2024 to March, 2025




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July, 2024-March, 2025.

Figure 1.3 shows the prisoners' population trend for the financial year 2024/25 from July, 2024 to March, 2025. The figure indicates a downward trend for the first four months during which the monthly prisoners population decreased from 79,530 prisoners in July, 2024 to 78,057 prisoners in October, 2024. The prisoners population thereafter started increasing to the current 79,333 prisoners in the month of March, 2025. The general rise in prisoners' population in the last four months may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals before, during and after the festive season.

Between the period July, 2024 and March, 2025, convicts decreased from 41,236 to 40,956 prisoners while remand prisoners increased from 37,644 to 37,754.

1.5 Prison population trends from July, 2024 to March, 2025




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period July, 2024 to March, 2025

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last nine months of the financial year 2024/25. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.7% and 47.8%

for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0 mark, ranging between 51.5% and 52.6% for the entire time period.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of March, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Southern by 3.4%; Mid Central by 2.2%; Mid Northern by 1.3%; North Eastern by 1.1%; East Central and Northern by 0.7%; North Western by 0.6%; Kigezi by 0.5%; and Central by 0.4%.

2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Iganga by 3.0%; South Eastern by 1.9%; Mid Western and North Central by 1.7%; Western by 1.3%; Kooki by 1.1%, Kampala Extra by 1.0%; Eastern by 0.7%; South Western and Mid Eastern by 0.6%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely attributed to the transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 294.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 623.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 268 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of March, 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 2.9% from 38,269 in February, 2025 to 39,367 prisoners, a daily average of 1,875 prisoners. (*See Table 1.3*).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in March, 2025 increased by 19.2% from 2,401 in February, 2025 to 2,861 prisoners, a daily average of 114 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.3*).

1.8 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of March, 2025 decreased by 8.4% from 7,221 in February, 2025 to 6,611 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of February, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of March, 2025 increased by 12.5%, from 24 to 27 escapees. However, the increase in the number of escapes did not have any significant impact on the monthly escape rates as indicated in table 1.8 above.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered during the period between July, 2024 and March, 2025. Northern region registered the highest number of escapees (23 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 8.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate registered during the period was 3.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 240 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 115 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 47.9%.

1.11 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of March, 2025, the service lost a total of sixteen (16) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.12 shows the mortality of prisoners registered during the period between July, 2024 and March, 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 6.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. East Central and Kooki regions had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 164 against the daily average population of 78,956 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31st March, 2025 was 13,941 of which 13,449 were uniformed and 492 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,700 (69.6%) males and 4,241 (30.4%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,449 uniformed staff, 11,264 (83.7%) were deployed in custodial units across the 268 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 shows that, between July, 2024 and March, 2025, the service had lost a total of 242 staff, with retirement being the leading mode of staff attrition, constituting up to 45.9% of the overall attrition.
