MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

APRIL, 2025

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of April , 2025. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 79,333 in February, 2025 to 79,494 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.1% from 40,956 to 41,361;
- Remands decreased by 0.8% from 37,754 to 37,469;
- Civil debtors increased by 6.6% from 623 to 664;
- Remands composed of 47.2%, convicts 52.0%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Occupancy rate reduced by 2.3% from 360.3% to 358.0%;
- A total of 2,840 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 118 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 40,744 – *a daily average of 2,037 prisoners*;
- 10,444 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,936 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July, 2024 to April, 2025, prisoners' escape rate was 3.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 48.6%, while mortality rate stood at 2.3 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 13,913 with 13,424 uniformed and 489 non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.6%; Female staff accounted for 30.4%;
- 11,203 (83.5%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.
- UG Prison Rubirizi, in South Western Region was established thus increasing the overall number of prisons units to 269.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of April, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.2% from 79,333 in March, 2025 to 79,494.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts increased by 1.0% from 40,956 to 41,361;
- b) Remands decreased by 0.8% from 37,754 to 37,469;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors increased by 6.6% from 623 to 664;
- d) Occupancy rate reduced by 2.3% from 360.3% at 358.0%.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

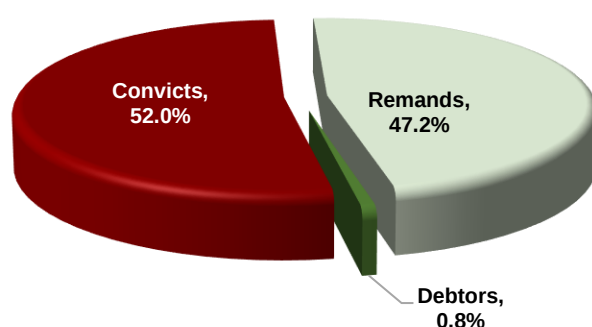


Figure 1.1 Percentage composition prisoners during the month of April, 2025

During the month of April, 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 52.0%, remand prisoners composed of 47.2%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

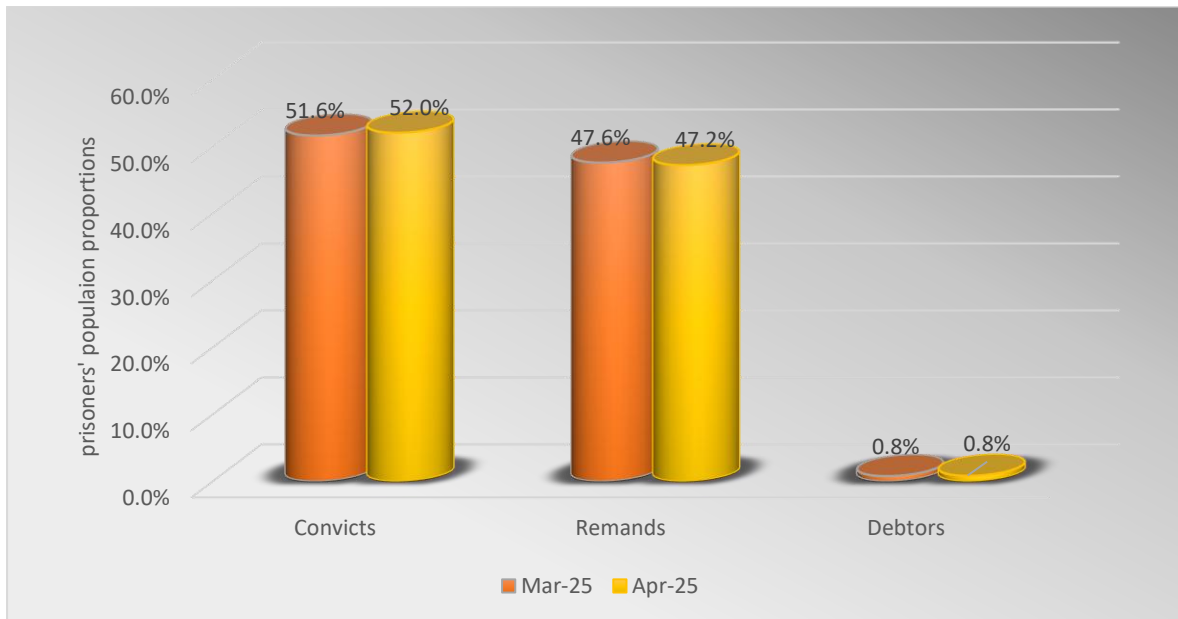


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with March, 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased from 51.6% to 52.0%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.4% from 47.6% to 47.2% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in April, 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison population trends from July, 2024 to April, 2025

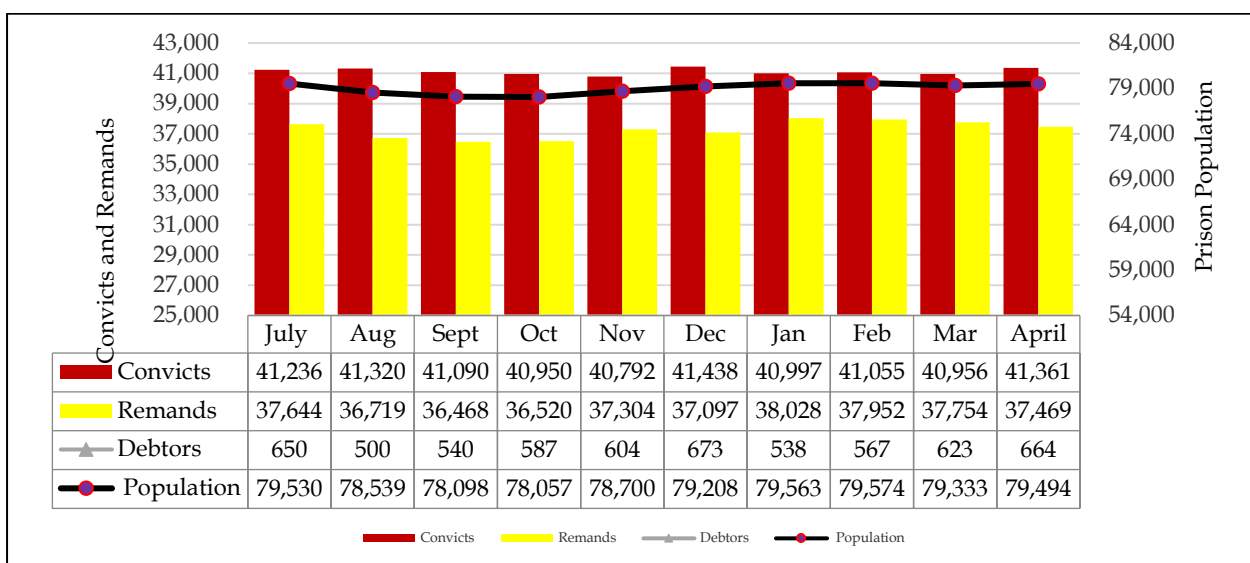


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July, 2024-March, 2025.

Figure 1.3 shows the prisoners' population trend for the financial year 2024/25 from July, 2024 to April, 2025. The figure indicates a downward trend for the first four months during which the monthly prisoners population decreased from 79,530 prisoners in July, 2024 to 78,057 prisoners in October, 2024 and thereafter started fluctuating.

1.5 Prison population trends from July, 2024 to April, 2025

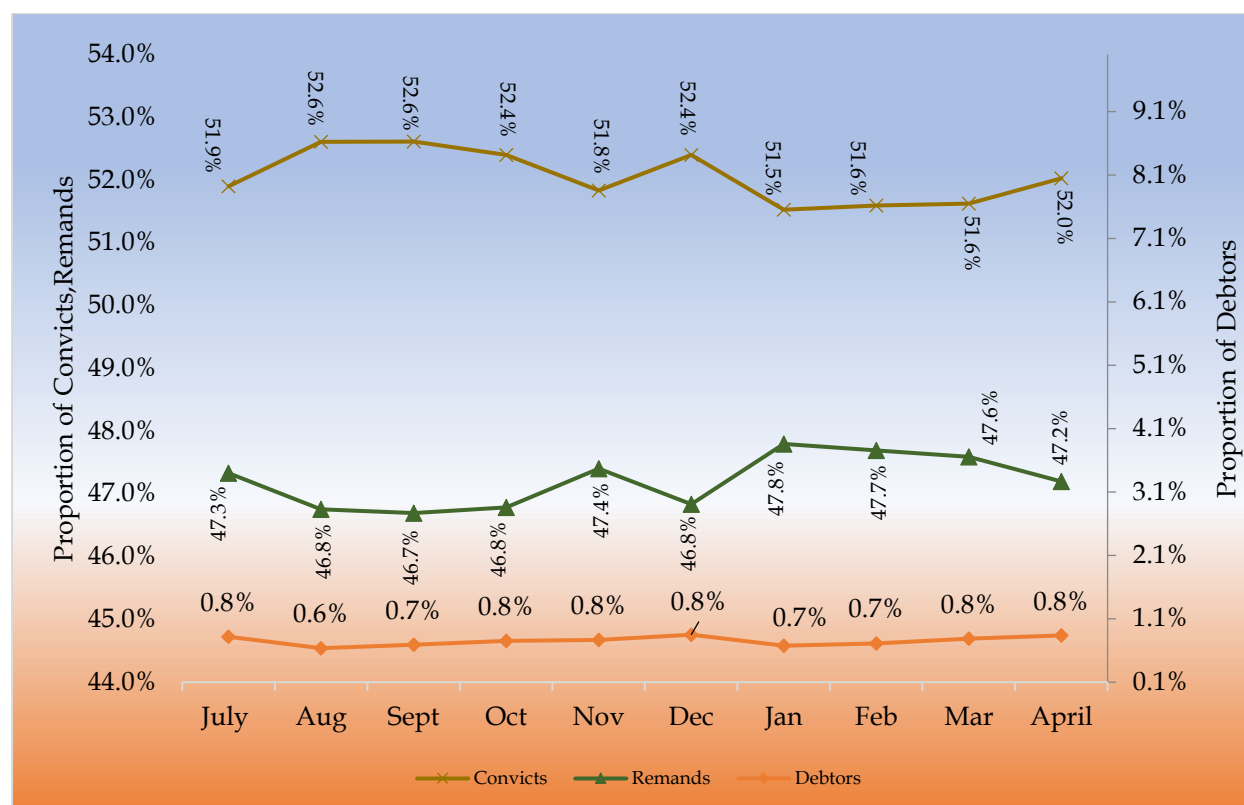


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period July, 2024 to April, 2025

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last ten (10) months of the financial year 2024/25. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.7% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0 mark, ranging between 51.5% and 52.6% during the entire time period. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of April, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Mid Central by 5.4%; Northern by 3.9%; Mid Northern by 2.1%; Kooki by 1.9%; North Central by 1.6%; Eastern and South Western by 1.5%; Central and Iganga by 1.0% and Southern by 0.5 %.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Western by 4.6%, Mid Eastern by 3.2%; South Eastern by 2.6%; North Eastern by 1.7%, East Central by 1.1%; North Western by 0.7%; Kampala Extra by 0.3%; Mid Western by 0.2% and Kigezi by 0.1%. The regional prisoners' population change

was largely attributed to by transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 291.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 664.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and nine (9) across the 269 custodial units countrywide.
6. UG Prison Rubirizi, in South Western Region was established thus increasing the overall number of prisons units to 269 from 268.

1.7 Delivery of prisoners to courts and normal releases

During the month of April, 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 3.5% from 39,367 in March, 2025 to 40,744 prisoners, a daily average of 2,037 prisoners. (See Table 1.3).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in April, 2025 decreased by 0.7% from 2,861 in March, 2025 to 2,840 prisoners, a daily average of 118 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.3).

1.8 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of April, 2025 increased by 4.9% from 6,611 in March, 2025 to 6,936 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.4 below.

In comparison with the month of March, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of April, 2025 decreased by 29.6%, from 27 to 19 escapees. The decrease in the number of escapes resulted in to a reduction in monthly escape rate from 0.3 escapes per 1,000 prisoners to 0.2 escapes per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in table 1.8 above.

Table 1.9 indicates the escapes registered during the period between July, 2024 and April, 2025. Northern region registered the highest number of escapes (25 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 11.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate registered during the period was 3.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that, of the 259 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 126 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 48.6%.

1.11 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of April, 2025, the service lost a total of fifteen (15) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.12 shows the mortality of prisoners registered during the period between July, 2024 and April, 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 7.0 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. East Central and Kooki regions had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 179 against the daily average population of 79,010 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 30th April, 2025 was 13,913 of which 13,424 were uniformed and 489 non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,677 (69.6%) males and 4,236 (30.4%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,424 uniformed staff, 11,203 (83.5%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
