## **ABSTRACT**

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of May , 2025. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.6% from 79,494 in April, 2025 to 79,933 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.2% from 41,361 to 41,439;
- Remands increased by 1.0% from 37,469 to 37,855;
- Civil debtors decreased by 3.8% from 664 to 639;
- Occupancy rate increased by 2.0% from 358.0% to 360.0%;
- Remands composed of 47.4%, convicts 51.8%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- A total of 2,315 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 96 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 35,062 – *a daily average of 1,753 prisoners*;
- 8,239 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,039 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July, 2024 to May, 2025, prisoners' escape rate was 3.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 47.6%, while mortality rate stood at 2.4 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The Service staff strength was 13,893 with 13,405 (96.5%) uniformed and 488 (3.5%) non-uniformed staff;
- Overall, Male staff accounted for 69.5%; Female staff accounted for 30.5%;
- 11,291 (84.2%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

### 1.1 Population Change



During the month of May, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.6% from 79,494 in April, 2025 to 79,933.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.2% from 41,361 to 41,439;
- Remands increased by 1.0% from 37,469 to 37,855;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 3.8% from 664 to 639;
- Occupancy rate increased by 2.0% from 358.0% at 360.0%.

### 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors



During the month of May, 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 51.8%, remand prisoners composed of 47.4%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

### 1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with April, 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 52.0% to 51.8%, remand prisoners increased by 0.2% from 47.2% to 47.4% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.8% of the average prisoners' population in May, 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

### 1.4 Monthly Prison population trends from July, 2024 to May, 2025




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July, 2024-May, 2025.

Figure 1.3 shows the prisoners' population trend for the FY2024/25 from July, 2024 to May, 2025. The figure indicates a downward trend for the first four months during which the monthly prisoners population decreased from 79,530 prisoners in July, 2024 to 78,057 prisoners in October, 2024. The prisoners population thereafter started increasing to the current 79,933 prisoners in the month of May, 2025. The general rise in prisoners' population in the last seven months may be attributed to increased crime rate, vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals before, during and after the festive season.

## 1.5 Prison population trends from July, 2024 to May, 2025




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period July, 2024 to May, 2025

Figure 1.4 shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prisoners' population over the last eleven (11) months of the financial year 2024/25. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.7% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 52.6% for the entire time period. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prisoners' population for the entire period.

During the month of May, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Kooki by 2.7%; Mid Northern by 2.3%; Northern by 2.2%; Mid Central by 1.9%; Southern by 1.7%; Kampala Extra by 1.6%; North Eastern by 1.5%, South Western by 0.8%; Central by 0.7%; Mid Western by 0.4%; Mid Eastern by 0.2%; Iganga by 0.1%; North Western by 0.05%; and North Central by 0.04%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; South Eastern by 2.0%, Eastern by 1.9%; Kigezi by 1.8%; East Central by 1.4%, and Western by 0.3%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely

attributed to transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 301.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 639.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 269 custodial units countrywide.

## 1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison

Table 1.3 shows the levels of congestion in prison during the month of May, 2025. 11.2% (30 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 152 prisons units were very congested composing 56.5% of the total Prisons Units. Only 25 prison units composing 9.3% had congestion levels below 200%. See Appendix 6 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of May, 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 13.9% from 40,744 in April, 2025 to 35,062 prisoners, a daily average of 1,753 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in May, 2025 decreased by 18.5% from 2,840 in April, 2025 to 2,315 prisoners, a daily average of 96 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

### 1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of May, 2025 decreased by 12.9% from 6,936 in April, 2025 to 6,039 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of April, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of May, 2025 increased by 63.2%, from 19 to 31 escapees. The increase in the number of escapes resulted into an increase of monthly escape rate from 0.2 escapes per 1,000 prisoners to 0.4 escapes per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered during the period between July, 2024 and May, 2025. Southern, Eastern, and Northern regions registered the highest number of escapes (25 escapees) each, however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 12.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 3.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 290 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 138 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 47.6%.

## 1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of May, 2025, the service lost a total of eleven (11) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 shows the mortality of prisoners registered during the period between July, 2024 and May, 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 7.6 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki and East Central regions had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 190 against the daily average population of 79,095 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

## 2 STAFFING POSITION

### 2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2025 was 13,893 of which 13,405 (96.5%) were uniformed and 488 (3.5%) non-uniformed officers. The staff strength composed of 9,660 (69.5%) males and 4,233 (30.5%) females – see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,405 uniformed staff, 11,291 (84.2%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
