ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of July , 2025. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 79,804 in June, 2025 to 79,655 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 1.6% from 41,161 to 41,813;
- Remands decreased by 2.3% from 38,062 to 37,184;
- Civil debtors increased by 13.3% from 581 to 658;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 0.7% from 356.0% to 355.3%;
- Remands composed of 46.7%, convicts 52.5%, and debtors 0.8% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 22,419 prisoners.
- A total of 2,600 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 96 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 44,818 – *a daily average of 1,949 prisoners*;
- 10,111 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 8,036 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period January 2025 to July 2025 prisoners' escape rate was 2.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 40.1%, while mortality rate stood at 1.3 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The in-service staff strength was 13,848 with 13,360 uniformed and 488 non-uniformed staff;
- 1,048 Recruit Warders and Wardresses (810 males and 238 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,896 with male staff accounting for 10,433 (70.0%) and female staff accounting for 4,463 (30.0%);
- 11,212 (83.9%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of July, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 0.2% (149) from 79,804 in June, 2025 to 79,655.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts increased by 1.6% from 41,161 to 41,813;
- b) Remands decreased by 2.3% from 38,062 to 37,184;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors increased by 13.3% from 581 to 658;
- d) Holding capacity remained at 22,419;
- e) Occupancy rate decreased by 0.7% from 356.0% at 355.3%.

1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

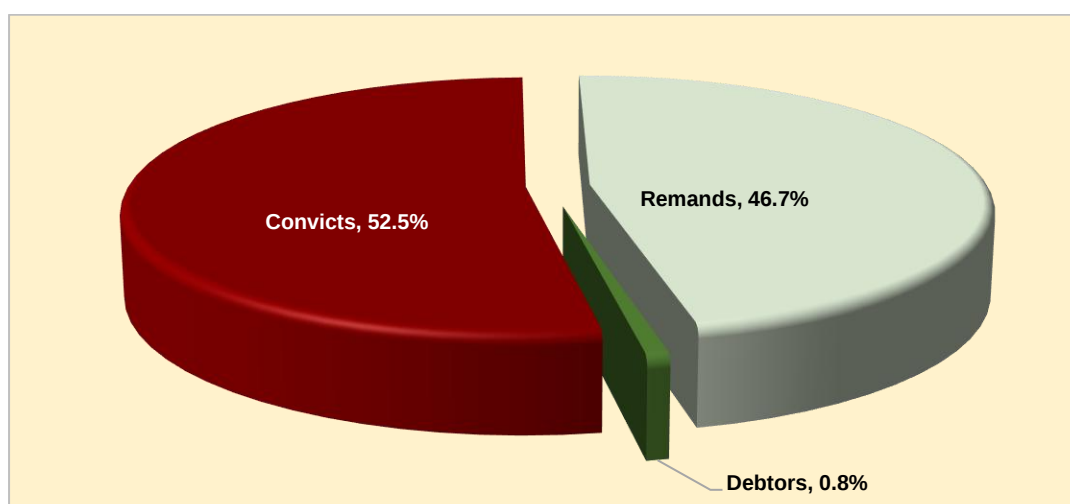


Figure 1.1 Composition of Prisoners' population

During the month of July, 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 52.5%, remand prisoners composed of 46.7%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prisoners' population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

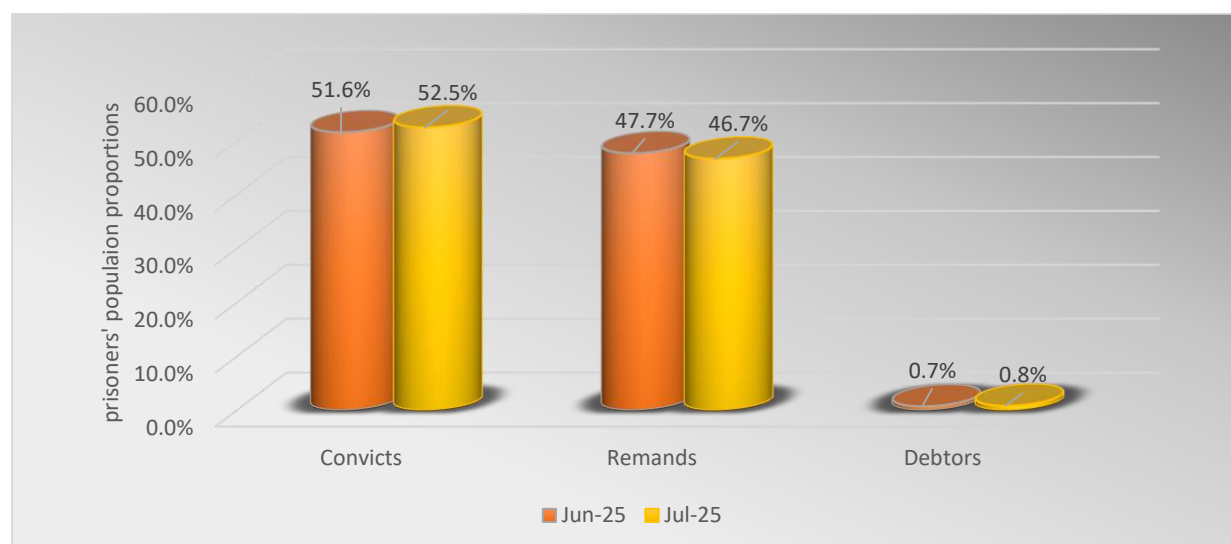


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with June, 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.9% from 51.6% to 52.5%, remand prisoners decreased by 1.0% from 47.7% to 46.7% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.7% to 0.8%; of the average prisoners' population in July, 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison population trends for the period January 2025 to July 2025

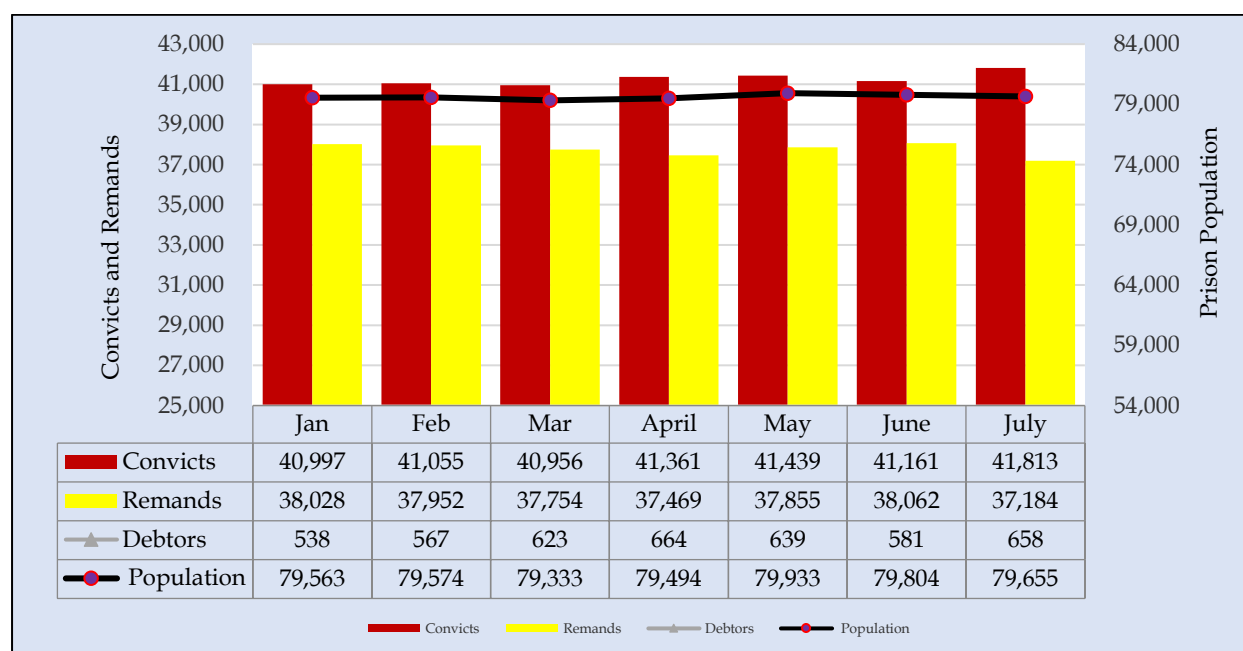


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period January 2025 to July 2025

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from January 2025 to July 2025. The figure indicates a general upward trend in the prison population during which the monthly prisoners population gradually increased from 79,563 prisoners in January, 2025 to 79,655 prisoners in July, 2025. The general rise in prisoners' population may be attributed to increased crime rate, and vigilancy of law enforcement agencies in apprehending criminals.

1.5 Prison population trends for the period January 2025 to July 2025

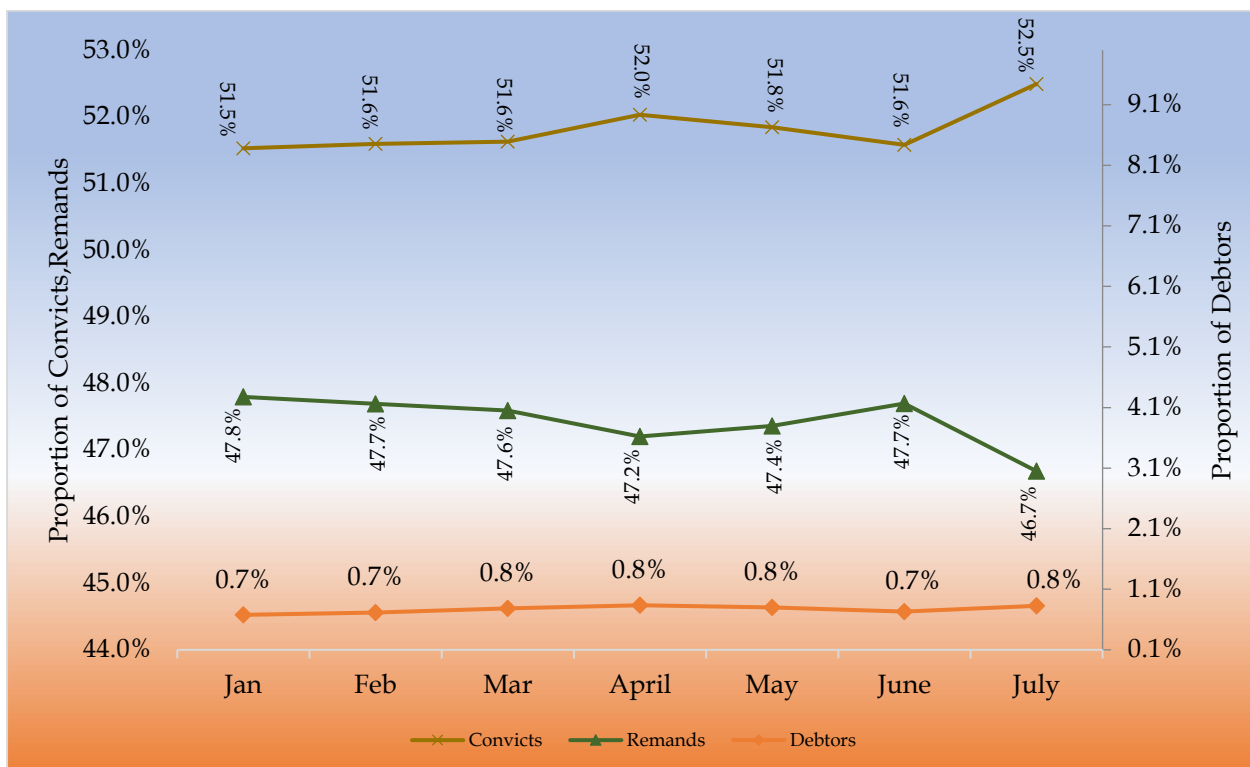


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period January 2025 to July 2025

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from January, 2025 to July, 2025. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.7% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 52.5% for the entire time period.

On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period.

During the month of July, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Iganga by 5.7%; North Central and South Eastern each by 2.7%; Northern by 1.9%; Eastern by 1.8%; and Southern by 0.1%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Kooki by 3.3%, Mid Western and North Eastern each by 2.2%; Mid Central by 2.1%; Mid Northern by 1.9%, Western by 1.8%; East Central by 1.2%; Central by 1.0%; Kampala Extra by 0.6%; North Western by 0.5%; Mid Eastern by 0.3%; Kigezi by 0.1%; and South Western by 0.02%. The regional prisoners' population change

was largely attributed to transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 298.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 658.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 269 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prison units during the month of July, 2025. 9.3% (25 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 149 prisons units were very congested composing 55.4% of the total prisons units. Only 22 prison units composing 8.2% had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 4 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of July, 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 23.3% from 36,335 in June, 2025 to 44,818 prisoners, a daily average of 1,949 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in July, 2025 increased by 18.1% from 2,201 in June, 2025 to 2,600 prisoners, a daily average of 96 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of July, 2025 increased by 16.5% from 6,895 in June, 2025 to 8,036 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered from January 2025 to July 2025. Central region registered the highest number of escapes (19 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 8.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 2.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 172 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 69 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 40.1%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of July, 2025, the service lost a total of ten (10) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered from January 2025 to July 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 4.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki region had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 102 against the daily average prison population of 79,622 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The overall in service staff strength as at 31st July, 2025 was 13,848 of which 13,360 were uniformed and 488 were non-uniformed officers. The Prisons Academy and Training School (PATs) had a total of 1,048 trainees (810 males and 238 females), hence the Service had a total staff strength of 14,896 staff of which 10,433 (70.0%) were males whereas 4,463 (30.0%) were females.- see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,360 in Service uniformed staff, 11,212 (83.9%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
