MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

AUGUST 2025

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of August , 2025. To note therefore is that;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 1.0% from 79,655 in July, 2025 to 78,819 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.03% from 41,813 to 41,824;
- Remands decreased by 1.9% from 37,184 to 36,490;
- Civil debtors decreased by 23.3% from 658 to 505;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 6.1% from 355.3% to 349.2%;
- Remands composed of 46.3%, convicts 53.1%, and debtors 0.6% of the daily average prisoners' population respectively;
- Prisons holding capacity increased by 0.7% from 22,419 to 22,569 prisoners resulting from completion of prisoners' wards at Yumbe, Kigandalo, Awei, Aswa II among other stations
- A total of 2,317 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 89 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 37,142 – *a daily average of 1,769 prisoners*;
- 8,004 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,866 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period January 2025 to August 2025 prisoners' escape rate was 2.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 39.4%, while mortality rate stood at 1.5 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The in-service staff strength was 13,832 with 13,344 uniformed and 488 non-uniformed staff;
- 1,158 Recruit Warders and Wardresses (867 males and 291 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,990 with male staff accounting for 10,475 (69.9%) and female staff accounting for 4,515 (30.1%);
- 11,152 (83.6%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of August, 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 1.0% (836) from 79,655 in July, 2025 to 78,819.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.03% from 41,813 to 41,824;
- Remands decreased by 1.9% from 37,184 to 36,490;
- Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 23.3% from 658 to 505;
- Holding capacity increased by 0.7 from 22,419 to 22,569 resulting from completion of prisoners' wards at Yumbe, Kigandalo, Awei, Aswa II among other stations.
- Occupancy rate decreased by 6.1% from 355.3% at 349.2%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

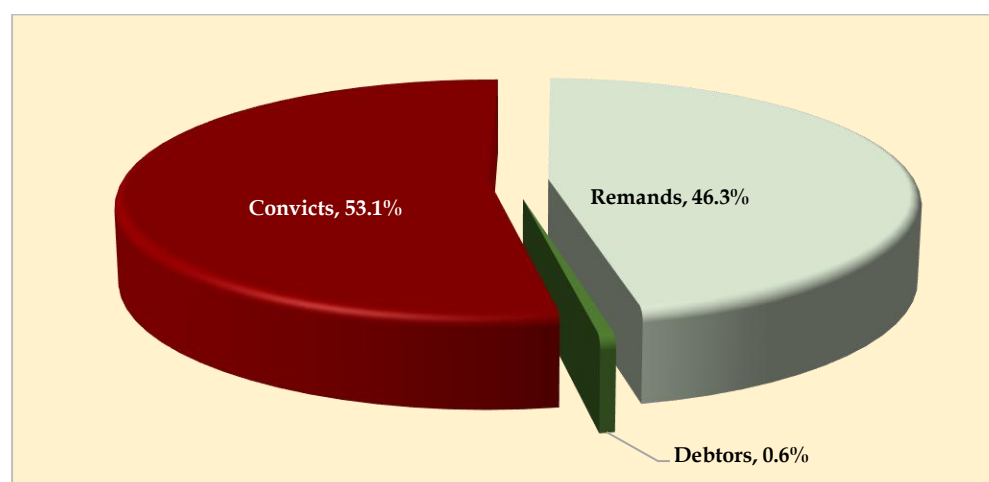


Figure 1.1 Composition of Prison population

During the month of August 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 53.1%, remand prisoners composed of 46.3%, while civil debtors composed of 0.6%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

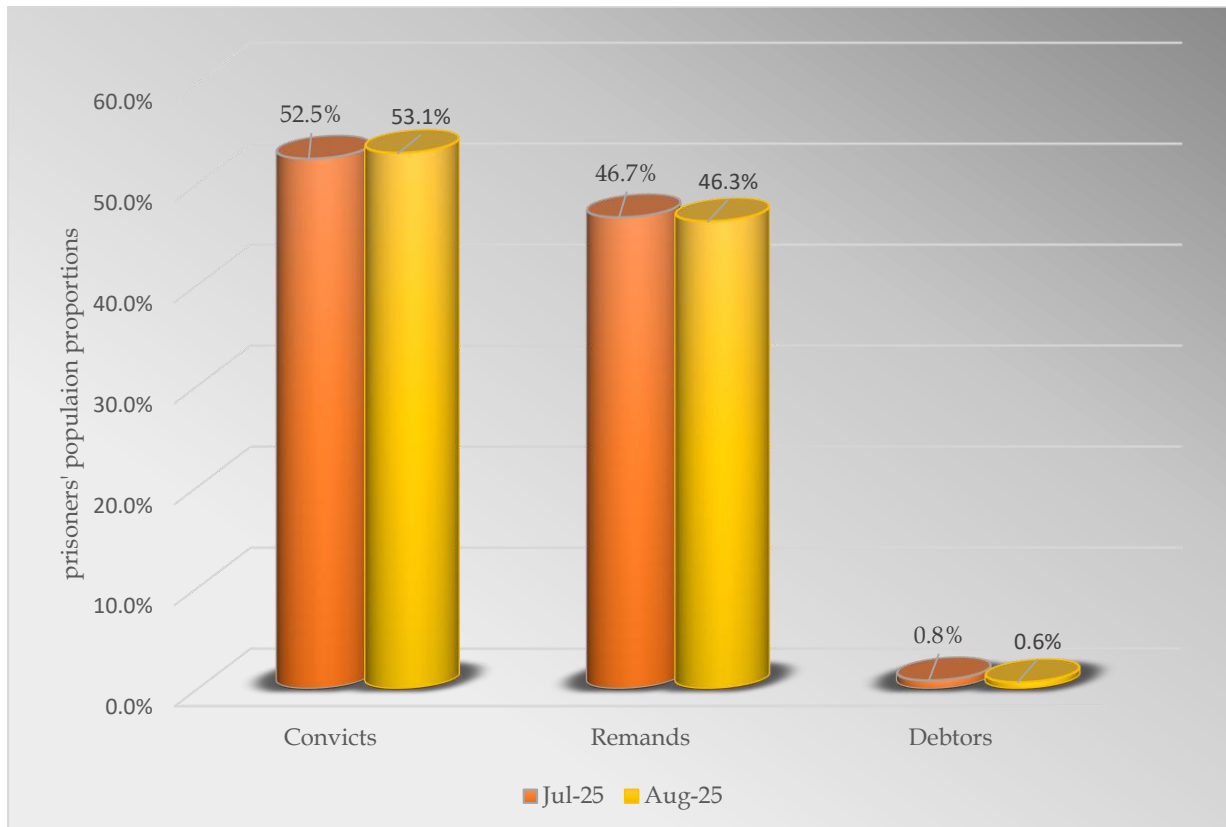


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with July 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.6% from 52.5% to 53.1%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.4% from 46.7% to 46.3% while that of civil debtors decreased by 0.2% from 0.8% to 0.6%; of the average prison population in August 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the period January 2025 to August 2025

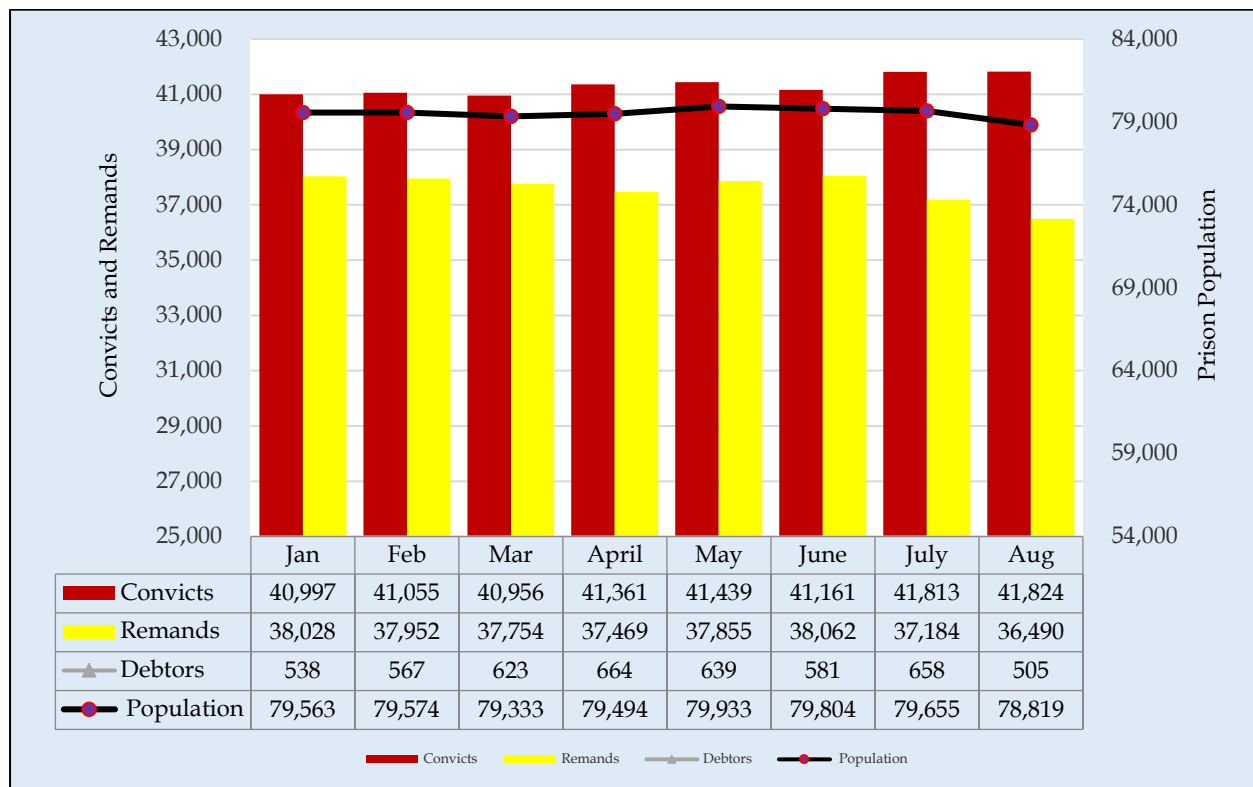


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period January 2025 to August 2025

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from January 2025 to August 2025. The figure indicates a general upward trend in the prison population during the first five months of the year 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually increased from 79,563 prisoners in January 2025 to 79,933 prisoners in May 2025. The prison population however has since been reducing upto the current 78,819 prisoners in August 2025. The general drop in the prison population in the recent times is as a result of more discharges from prison compared to admissions. In the last three months 37,274 prisoners have been discharged from prison while 35,327 prisoners have been newly admitted from court.

1.5 Prison population trends for the period January 2025 to August 2025

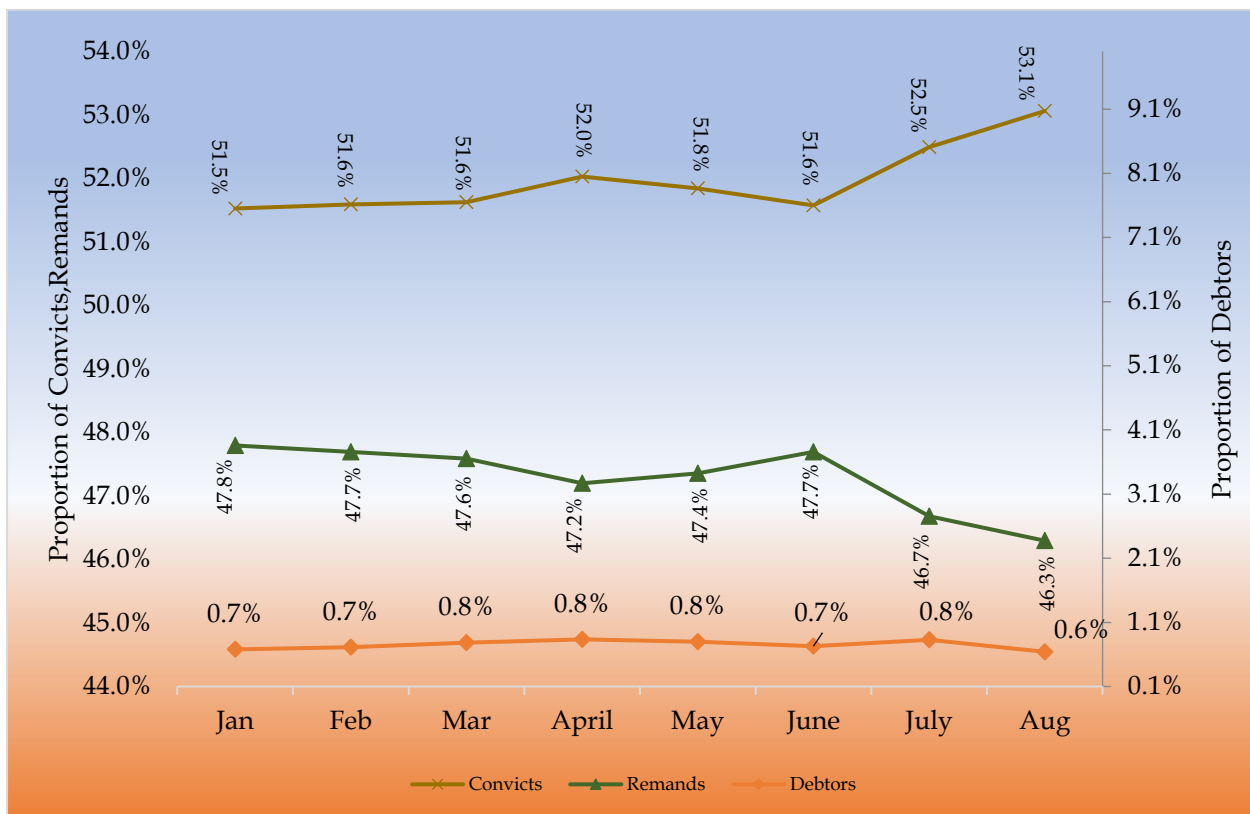


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period January 2025 to August 2025

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from January, 2025 to August, 2025. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 46.3% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 53.1% for the entire time period. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period. The gap between the convicts and remands has increased in the recent times. This trend is attributed to increased judicial officers especially at the lower courts that has translated into regular trials of cases and subsequent convictions. It should also be noted that the number judicial officers increased from 656 in the FY2023/24 to the 704 officers in FY2024/25.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of August, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Western by 1.3%; North Central by 1.1%; Kampala Extra by 0.9%; Northern by 0.5%; North Eastern by 0.4%; and North Western by 0.2%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Kooki by 6.6%, Mid Western and Kigezi each by 3.5%; Mid Eastern by 3.2%; South Western, Mid Northern, and Central each by 2.4%, Mid Central by 2.2%; Iganga by 1.9%; Eastern by 1.0%; South Eastern and East Central each by 0.9%; and Southern by 0.1%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely

attributed to transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 290.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 505.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 269 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prison units during the month of August, 2025. 8.9% (24 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 148 prisons units were very congested, constituting 55.0% of the total prisons units. Only 25 prison units composing 9.3% had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 1 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of August 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 17.1% from 44,818 in July 2025 to 37,142 prisoners, a daily average of 1,769 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in August 2025 decreased by 10.9% from 2,600 in July 2025 to 2,317 prisoners, a daily average of 89 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of August 2025 decreased by 14.6% from 8,036 in July 2025 to 6,866 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of July, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of August 2025 decreased by 1.0%, from 28 to 21 escapees. This resulted into a decrease in the monthly escape rate by 0.1, from 0.4 escapes per 1,000 prisoners to 0.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered from January 2025 to August 2025. Central region registered the highest number of escapes (19 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 8.6 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 2.4 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 193 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 76 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 39.4%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of August 2025, the Service lost a total of fifteen (15) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly mortality rate of 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered from January 2025 to August 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 4.8 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki region had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 117 against the daily average prison population of 79,522 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.5 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The overall in service staff strength as at 31st August 2025 was 13,832 out of which 13,344 were uniformed and 488 were non-uniformed officers. The Prisons Academy and Training School (PATs) had a total of 1,158 trainees (867 males and 291 females), hence the Service had a total staff strength of 14,990 staff out of which 10,475 (69.9%) were males and 4,515 (30.1%) were females.– see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,344 in Service uniformed staff, 11,152 (83.6%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 above shows that the service had lost a total of 176 staff from January 2025 to August 2025, with retirement being the leading mode of staff attrition, constituting up to 43.2% (76) of the overall attrition.

Warders and Wardresses were the majority category of staff leaving the Service, constituting up to 27.3% of the overall staff attrition during the period.
