MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

SEPTEMBER 2025

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of September 2025.

To note therefore is that between the month of August and September 2025;

- The daily average population of prisoners decreased by 1.0% from 78,819 to 78,052 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.01% from 41,824 to 41,830;
- Remands decreased by 2.3% from 36,490 to 35,658;
- Civil debtors increased by 11.7% from 505 to 564;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 46.3% to 45.7%;
- Occupancy rate decreased by 12.6% from 349.2% to 336.7%;
- Prisons holding capacity increased by 2.7% from 22,569 to 23,184 prisoners resulting from completion and renovation of prisoners' wards at Kapeeka, Lukaya, Isimba, Jinja (M), among other stations.

To note also is that, during the month of September 2025;

- A total of 2,226 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 86 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 38,582 – *a daily average of 1,754 prisoners*;
- 8,992 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,596 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period January 2025 to September 2025 prisoners' escape rate was 2.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 42.5%, while mortality rate stood at 1.7 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The in-service staff strength was 13,809 with 13,324 uniformed and 485 non-uniformed staff;
- 1,156 Recruit Warders and Wardresses (865 males and 291 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,966 with male staff accounting for 10,454 (69.9%) and female staff accounting for 4,512 (30.1%);
- 11,167 (83.8%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the month stood at 26 staff while 202 staff had left the Service since January 2025;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

1.1 Population Change

During the month of September 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners decreased by 1.0% (767) from 78,819 in August 2025 to 78,052.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.01% from 41,824 to 41,830;
- Remands decreased by 2.3% from 36,490 to 35,658;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 11.7% from 505 to 564;
- Holding capacity increased by 2.7 from 22,569 to 23,184 resulting from completion and renovation of prisoners' wards at Kapeeka, Lukaya, Isimba, Jinja (M), among other stations.
- Occupancy rate decreased by 12.6% from 349.2% at 336.7%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

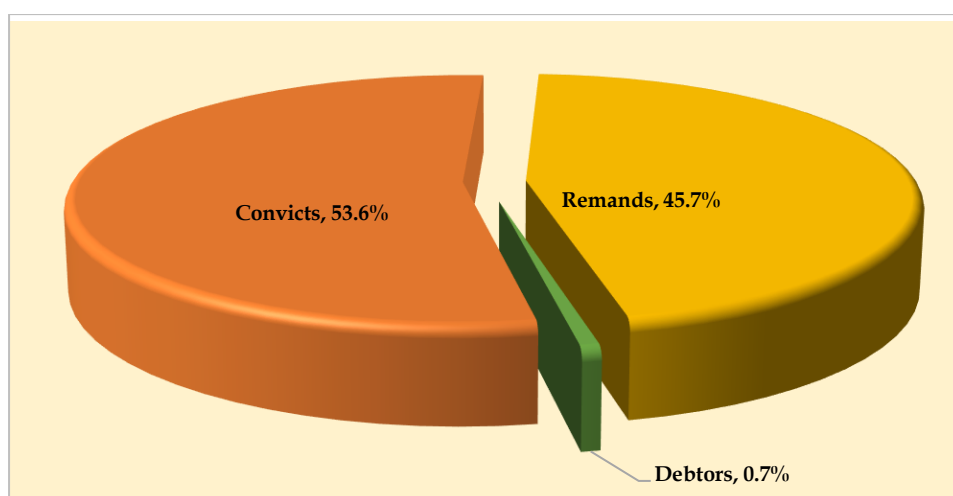


Figure 1.1 Composition of Prison population

During the month of September 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 53.6%, remand prisoners composed of 45.7%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

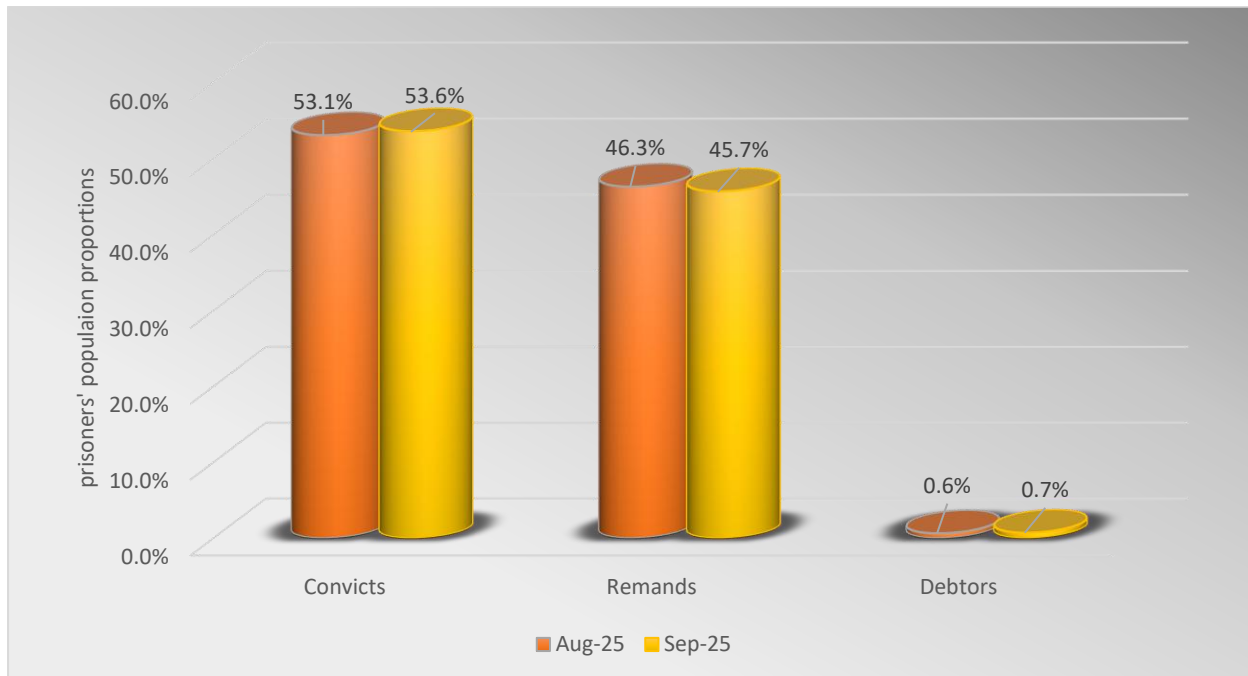


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with August 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.5% from 53.1% to 53.6%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 46.3% to 45.7% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.6% to 0.7%; of the average prison population in September 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the period January 2025 to September 2025

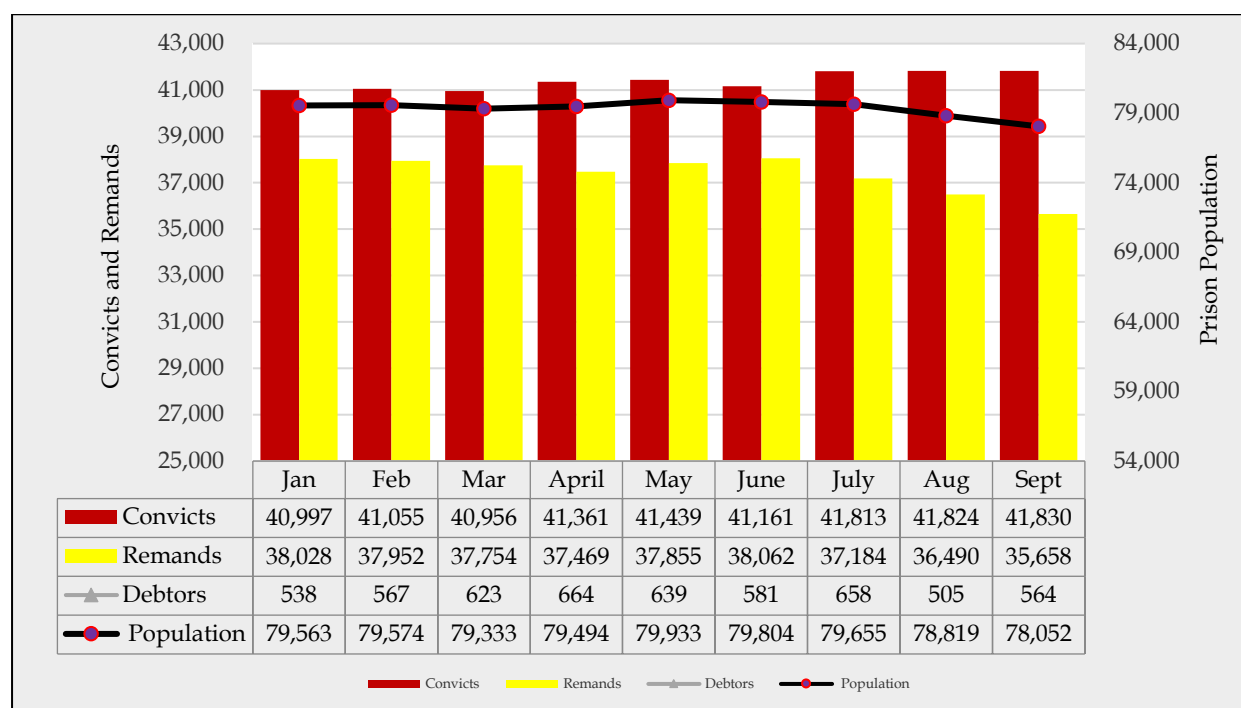


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period January 2025 to September 2025

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from January 2025 to September 2025. The figure indicates a general upward trend in the prison population during the first five months of the year 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually increased from 79,563 prisoners in January 2025 to 79,933 prisoners in May 2025. The prison population however has since been reducing upto the current 78,052 prisoners in September 2025. The general drop in the prison population in the recent times is as a result of more discharges from prison compared to admissions. In the last four months, 37,737 prisoners have been discharged from prison while 36,080 prisoners have been newly admitted from court.

1.5 Prison population trends for the period January 2025 to September 2025

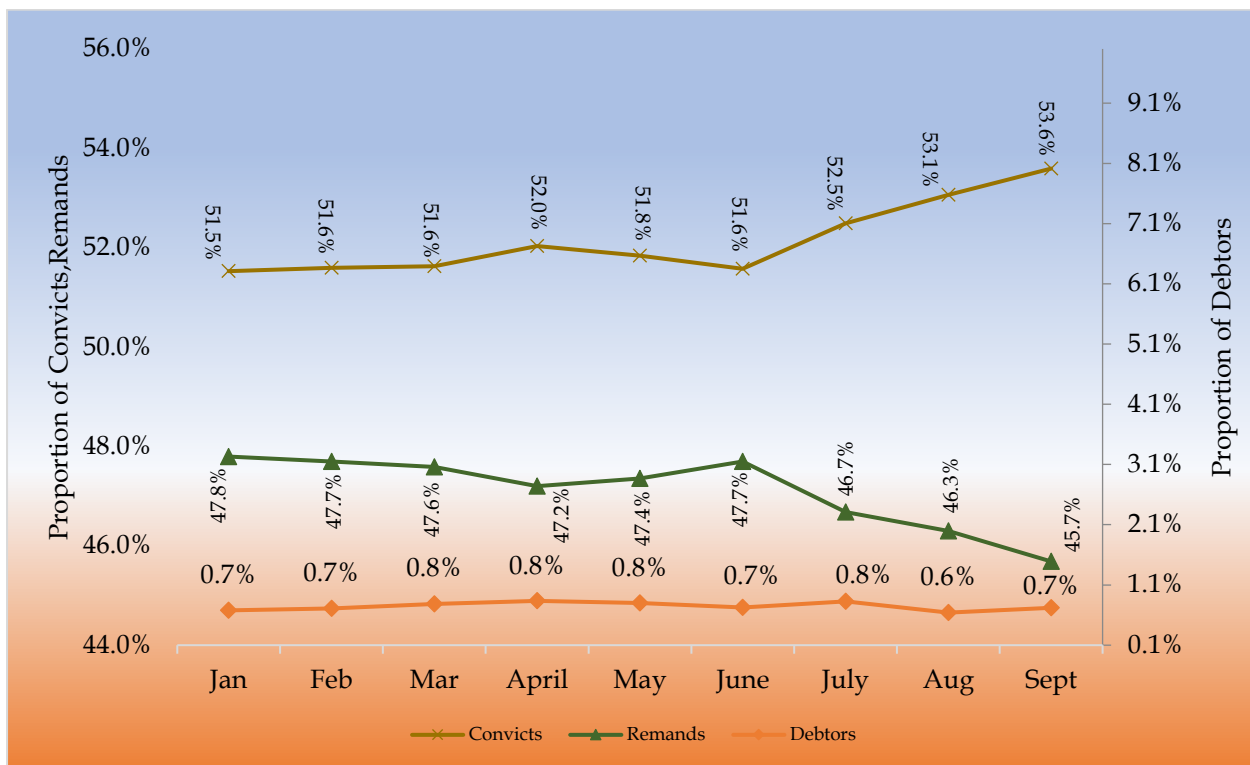


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period January 2025 to September 2025

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from January 2025 to September 2025. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 45.7% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 53.6% for the entire time period. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.7% of the overall prison population for the entire period. The gap between the convicts and remands has increased in the recent times. This trend is attributed to increased number of judicial officers especially at the lower courts that has translated into regular trials of cases and subsequent convictions. It should also be noted that the number of judicial officers increased from 656 in the FY2023/24 to the 704 officers in FY2024/25.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of September, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Iganga by 2.4%; Mid Central and Northern each by 2.1%; North Eastern by 1.9%; Southern by 0.4%; East Central by 0.2%; and Western by 0.1%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; North Central by 3.6%, Mid Northern and South Eastern each by 2.8%; North Western and Eastern each by 2.5%; Mid Western, and Kooki each by 2.4%, Kigezi by 1.4%; South Western by 1.3%; Kampala Extra by 1.2%; Mid Eastern by 1.1%; and Central by 1.0%. The regional prisoners' population change was largely

attributed to transfer of inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 285.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 564.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 269 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prison units during the month of September 2025. 7.4% (20 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 142 prisons units were very congested, constituting 52.8% of the total prisons units. Only 25 prison units composing 9.3% had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 4 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of September 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 3.9% from 37,142 in August 2025 to 38,582 prisoners, a daily average of 1,754 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in September 2025 decreased by 3.9% from 2,317 in August 2025 to 2,226 prisoners, a daily average of 86 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of September 2025 decreased by 3.9% from 6,866 in August 2025 to 6,596 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of August, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of September 2025 decreased by 14.3%, from 21 to 18 escapees. This resulted into a decrease in the monthly escape rate by 0.1, from 0.3 escapes per 1,000 prisoners to 0.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered from January 2025 to September 2025. Central region registered the highest number of escapes (22 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 9.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 2.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 212 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 90 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 42.5%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of September 2025, the Service lost a total of seventeen (17) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly crude mortality rate of 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered from January 2025 to September 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 5.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki region had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 134 against the daily average prison population of 79,359 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.7 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The overall in service staff strength as at 30th September 2025 was 13,810 out of which 13,325 were uniformed and 485 were non-uniformed officers. The Prisons Academy and Training School (PATS) had a total of 1,156 trainees (865 males and 291 females), hence the Service had a total staff strength of 14,966 staff out of which 10,454 (69.9%) were males and 4,512 (30.1%) were females.– see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,325 in Service uniformed staff, 11,167 (83.8%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
