ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, escapes, deaths and the staff strength during the month of October 2025.

To note therefore is that between the month of September and October 2025;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.3% from 78,052 to 78,312 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.5% from 41,830 to 42,023;
- Remands increased by 0.04% from 35,658 to 35,671;
- Civil debtors increased by 9.6% from 564 to 618;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 45.7% to 45.5%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.1% from 336.7% to 337.8%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners

To note also is that, during the month of October 2025;

- A total of 2,569 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 99 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 39,900 – *a daily average of 1,814 prisoners*;
- 10,321 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 7,260 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period January 2025 to October 2025 prisoners' escape rate was 3.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 44.4%, while mortality rate stood at 1.9 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The in-service staff strength was 13,766 with 13,281 uniformed and 485 non-uniformed staff;
- 1,155 Recruit Warders and Wardresses (864 males and 291 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,921 with male staff accounting for 10,413 (69.8%) and female staff accounting for 4,508 (30.2%);
- 11,085 (83.5%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the month stood at 52 staff while 254 staff had left the Service since January 2025;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of October 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.3% (260) from 78,052 in September 2025 to 78,312.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.5% from 41,830 to 42,023;
- Remands increased by 0.04% from 35,658 to 35,671;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 9.6% from 564 to 618;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.1% from 336.7% at 337.8%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

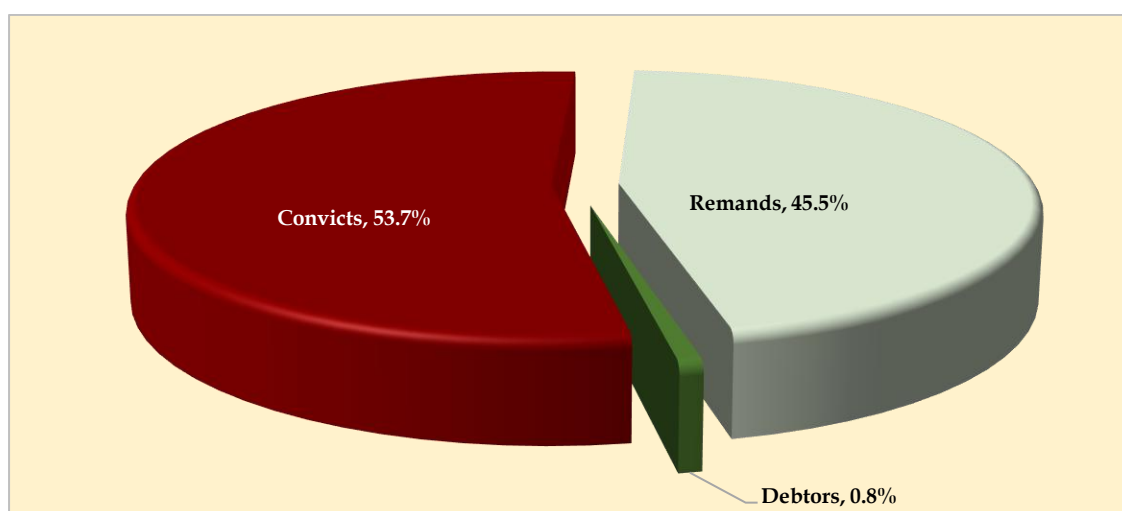


Figure 1.1 Composition of Prison population

During the month of October 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 53.7%, remand prisoners composed of 45.5%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

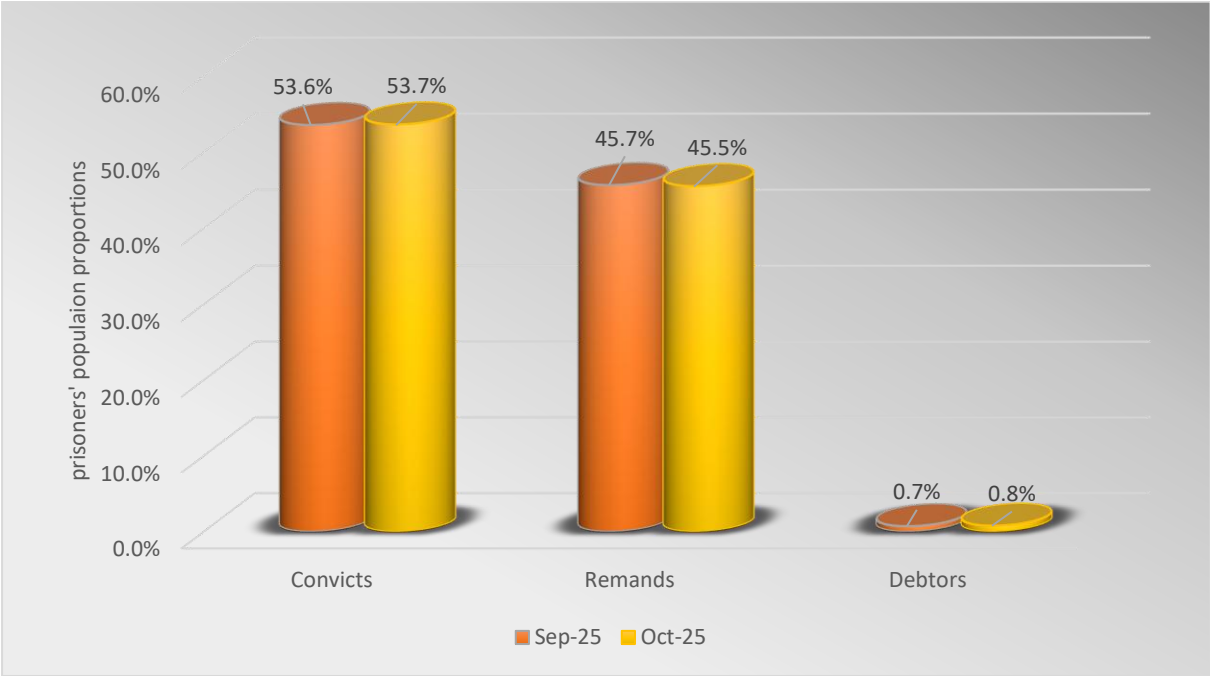


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with September 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.1% from 53.6% to 53.7%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.2% from 45.7% to 45.5% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.7% to 0.8%; of the average prison population in October 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the period January 2025 to October 2025

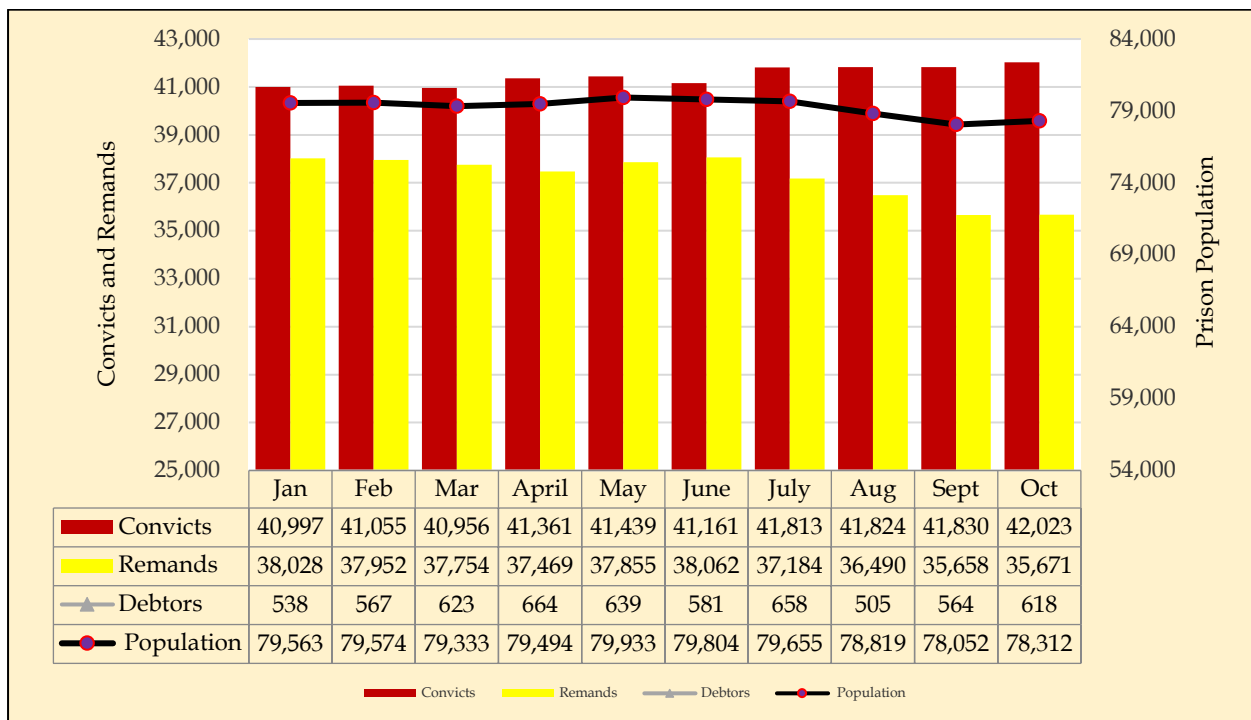


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period January 2025 to October 2025

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from January 2025 to October 2025. The figure indicates a general upward trend in the prison population during the first five months of the year 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually increased from 79,563 prisoners in January 2025 to 79,933 prisoners in May 2025. The prison population however has since been reducing from 79,933 prisoners in May 2025, to 78,052 prisoners in September 2025, though it slightly increased in October 2025 to 78,312 prisoners. The general drop in the prison population in the recent times is as a result of more discharges from prison compared to admissions. In the last four months, 38,470 prisoners have been discharged from prison while 37,428 prisoners have been newly admitted from court.

1.5 Prison population trends for the period January 2025 to October 2025

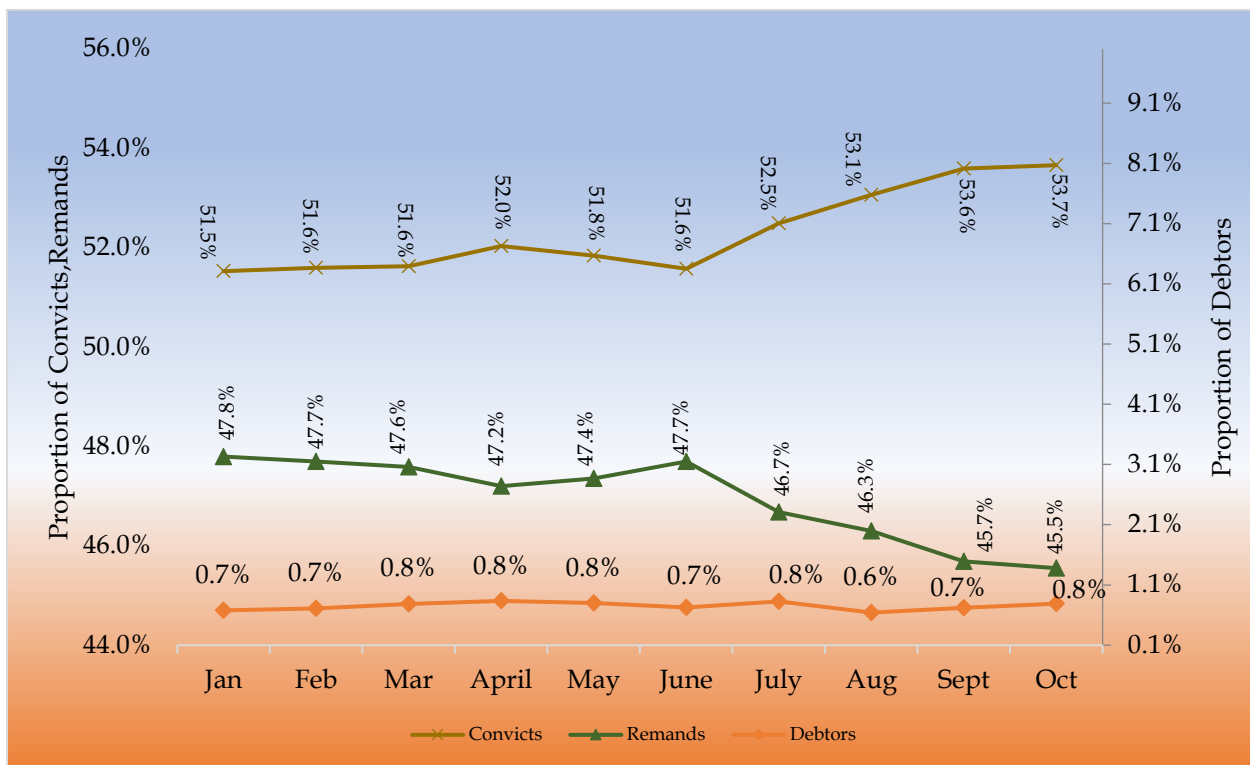


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period January 2025 to October 2025

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from January 2025 to October 2025. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 45.5% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 53.7% for the entire time period. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period. The gap between the convicts and remands has increased in the recent times. This trend may be attributed to number of factors including the increased number of judicial officers especially at the lower courts that has translated into regular trials of cases and subsequent convictions, timely delivery of prisoners to court among other factors.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of October, 2025;

1. The regional population of prisoners increased in the following regions; Eastern by 3.2%; Mid Central by 2.9%; Kigezi by 2.4%; South Western by 2.1%; Mid Eastern by 1.6%; Northern by 1.3%; North Central by 1.1%; Kampala Extra and Western by 0.6%; South Eastern by 0.3%; and North Eastern by 0.05%.
2. The regional population of prisoners however, decreased in the following regions; Kooki by 5.0%, Iganga by 3.2%; Mid Northern by 3.1%; East Central by 1.7%; North Western by 1.6%; Mid Western by 0.9%; Central by 0.7%; and Southern by 0.3%. The regional prison population change was largely attributed to transfer of

inmates between regions to attend courts and reinforce farm labour, and as a decongestion measure.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 301.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 618.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 269 custodial units countrywide.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prison units during the month of October 2025. 7.8% of the prisons (21 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 134 prisons units were very congested, constituting 49.8% of the total prisons units. Only 35 prison units constituting 13.0% had congestion levels below 200%. *See Annex 4* showing the stations under each category.

During the month of October 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 3.4% from 38,582 in September 2025 to 39,900 prisoners, a daily average of 1,814 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in October 2025 increased by 15.4% from 2,226 in September 2025 to 2,569 prisoners, a daily average of 99 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of October 2025 increased by 10.1% from 6,596 in September 2025 to 7,260 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of September, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of October 2025 increased by 22.2%, from 18 to 22 escapees. This resulted into an increase in the monthly escape rate by 0.1, from 0.2 escapes per 1,000 prisoners to 0.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered from January 2025 to October 2025. Central region registered the highest number of escapes (24 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 9.9 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region was the only region with zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 3.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 234 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 104 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 44.4%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of October 2025, the Service lost a total of eighteen (18) prisoners through death which reflects a monthly crude mortality rate of 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered from January 2025 to October 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 6.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki region had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 152 against the daily average prison population of 79,254 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.9 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The overall in service staff strength as at 31stOctober 2025 was 13,766 out of which 13,281 were uniformed and 485 were non-uniformed officers. The Prisons Academy and Training School (PATS) had a total of 1,155 trainees (864 males and 291 females), hence the Service had a total staff strength of 14,921 staff out of which 10,413 (69.8%) were males and 4,508 (30.2%) were females.– see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,281 in Service uniformed staff, 11,085 (83.5%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
