MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

NOVEMBER 2025

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ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of November 2025.

To note therefore is that between the month of October and November 2025;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 1.1% from 78,312 to 79,186 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 0.5% from 42,023 to 42,240;
- Remands increased by 1.6% from 35,671 to 36,255;
- Civil debtors increased by 11.8% from 618 to 691;
- Proportion of remand prisoners increased by 0.3% from 45.5% to 45.8%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 3.8% from 337.8% to 341.6%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners

To note also is that, during the month of November 2025;

- A total of 2,305 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 92 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 37,264 – *a daily average of 1,863 prisoners*;
- 9,471 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,098 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period January 2025 to November 2025 prisoners' escape rate was 3.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 47.8%, while mortality rate stood at 2.1 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The in-service staff strength was 13,748 with 13,263 uniformed and 485 non-uniformed staff;
- 1,155 Recruit Warders and Wardresses (864 males and 291 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,903 with male staff accounting for 10,400 (69.8%) and female staff accounting for 4,503 (30.2%);
- 11,012 (83.0%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 269 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the month stood at 17 staff while 271 staff had left the Service since January 2025;
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of November 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 1.1% (874) from 78,312 in November 2025 to 79,186.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 0.5% from 42,023 to 42,240;
- Remands increased by 1.6% from 35,671 to 36,255;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 11.8% from 618 to 691;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners
- Occupancy rate increased by 3.8% from 337.8% at 341.6%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

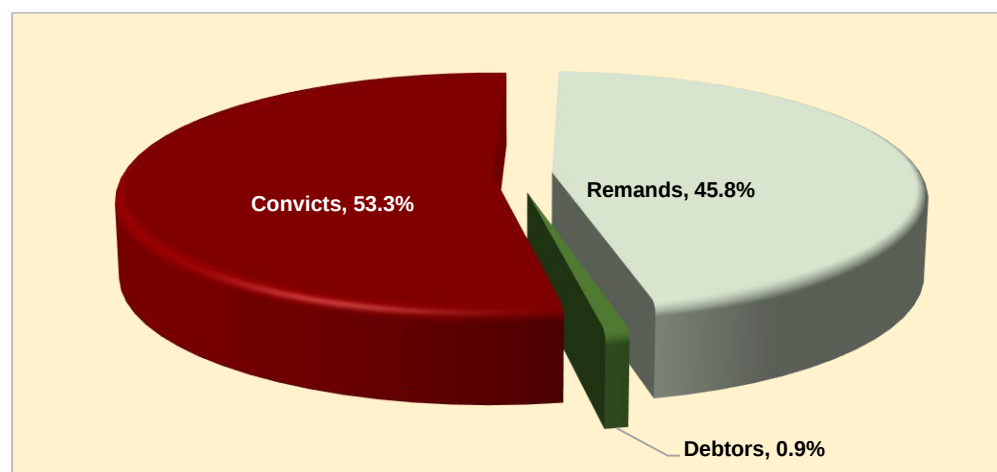


Figure 1.1 Composition of Prison population

During the month of November 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 53.3%, remand prisoners composed of 45.8%, while civil debtors composed of 0.9%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

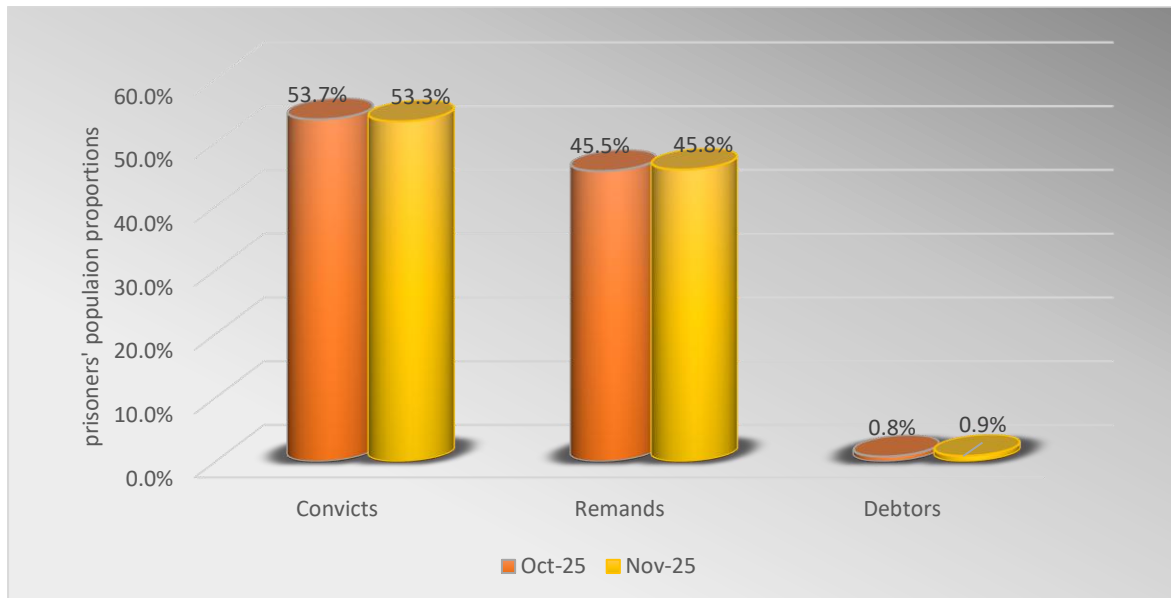


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with October 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.4% from 53.7% to 53.3%, remand prisoners increased by 0.3% from 45.5% to 45.8% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.8% to 0.9%; of the average prison population in November 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the period January 2025 to November 2025

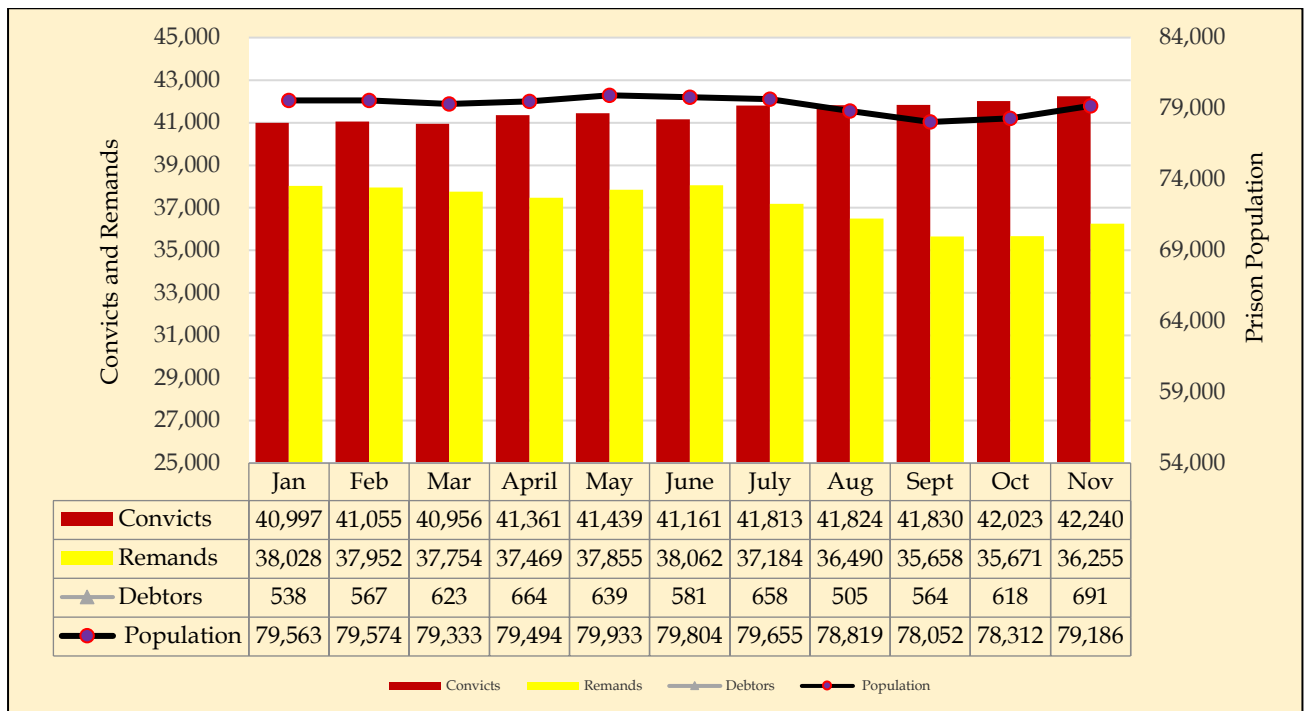


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period January 2025 to November 2025

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from January 2025 to November 2025. The figure indicates a general upward trend in the prison population during the first five months of the year 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually increased from 79,563 prisoners in January 2025 to 79,933 prisoners in May 2025. The prison population however started reflecting a fluctuating trend from 79,933 prisoners in May 2025, to the current 79,186 prisoners in November 2025 with the lowest reduction (78,052 prisoners) registered in September 2025.

1.5 Prison population trends for the period January 2025 to November 2025

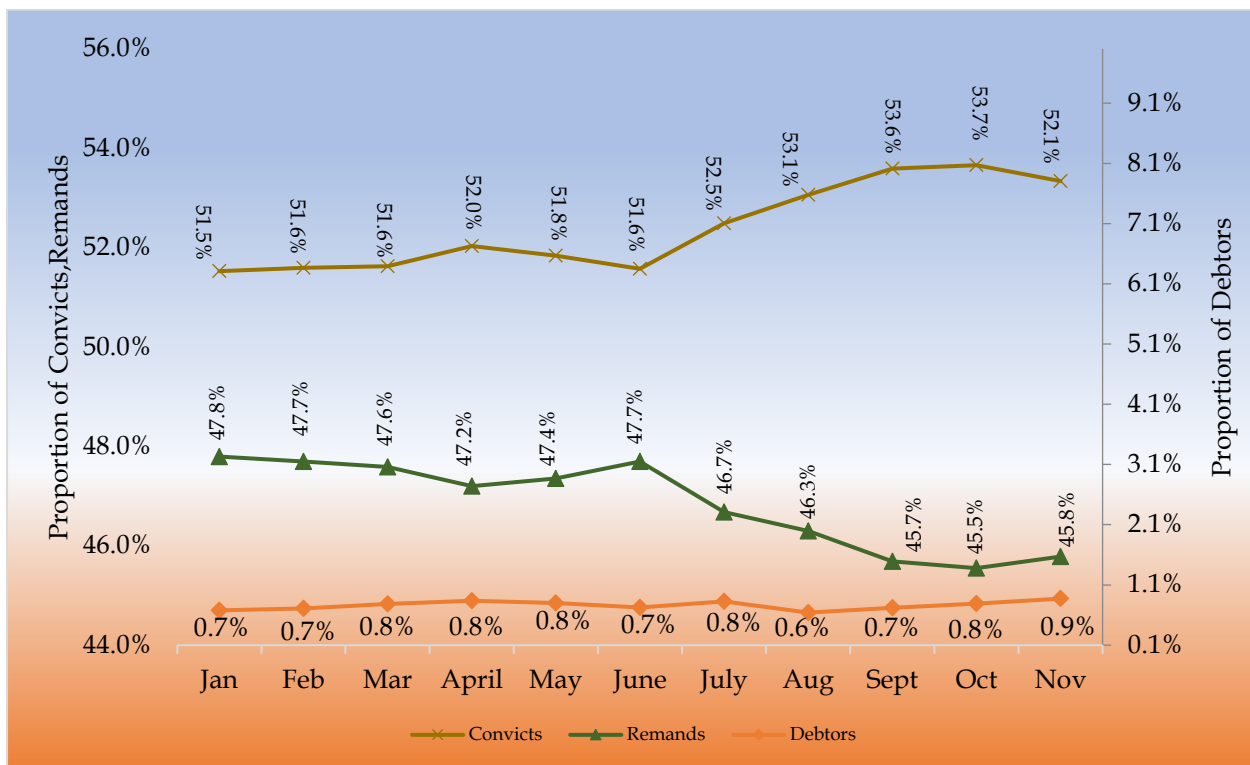


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period January 2025 to November 2025

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from January 2025 to November 2025. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, ranging between 45.5% and 47.8% for the entire time period. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, ranging between 51.5% and 53.7% for the entire time period. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of November, 2025;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Kampala Extra by 4.2%; Mid Western by 2.9%; South Western by 2.3%; Mid Northern by 2.1%; East Central by 2.0%; Iganga by 1.9%; Central by 1.7%; Kigezi by 0.9%; South Eastern by 0.8%; Mid Central and Eastern by 0.7%; Western by 0.3%; and North Central by 0.2%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; Kooki by 4.3%, Southern by 2.6%; North Eastern by 1.4%; North Western by 1.1%; and Northern by 0.6%.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 302.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 691.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of November 2025. 6.3% of the prisons (17 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 137 prisons units were very congested, constituting 50.9% of the total prison units. Only 34 prison units constituting 12.6% had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 4 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of November 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 6.6% from 39,900 in October 2025 to 37,264 prisoners, a daily average of 1,863 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in November 2025 decreased by 10.3% from 2,569 in October 2025 to 2,305 prisoners, a daily average of 92 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of November 2025 decreased by 16.0% from 7,260 in October 2025 to 6,098 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered from January 2025 to November 2025. Central region registered the highest number of escapes (25 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 10.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region had zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 3.2 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 255 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 122 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 47.8%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of November 2025, the Service lost a total of fourteen (14) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prisoners' National Referral Hospital is situated.

The number of deaths registered amongst prisoners during the month of November 2025 was 14, a decrease by 22.2% from 18 death cases registered during the previous month (October 2025) as indicated in Table 1.12 above. The crude mortality rate remained at 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners as registered in October 2025.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered from January 2025 to November 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 7.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki region had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 166 against the daily average prison population of 79,248 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.1 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The in service staff strength as at 30th November, 2025 was 13,748 out of which 13,263 were uniformed and 485 were non-uniformed officers. The Prisons Academy and Training School (PATS) had a total of 1,155 trainees (864 males and 291 females), hence the Service had an overall staff strength of 14,903 staff out of which 10,400 (69.8%) were males and 4,503 (30.2%) were females.– see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,263 in Service uniformed staff, 11,012 (83.0%) were deployed in custodial units across the 269 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
