ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of December 2025.

To note therefore is that between the month of November and December 2025;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.2% from 79,186 to 79,311 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 1.2% from 42,240 to 42,727;
- Remands decreased by 1.1% from 36,255 to 35,847;
- Civil debtors increased by 6.7% from 691 to 737;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 45.8% to 45.2%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 0.5% from 341.6% to 342.1%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners

To note also is that, during the month of December 2025;

- A total of 2,546 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 102 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 33,840 – *a daily average of 1,611 prisoners*;
- 8,165 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,667 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the year 2025, prisoners' escape rate was 3.5 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 50.7%, while mortality rate stood at 2.2 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The in-service staff strength was 13,717 with 13,234 uniformed and 483 non-uniformed staff;
- 1,154 Recruit Warders and Wardresses (863 males and 291 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,871 with male staff accounting for 10,378 (69.8%) and female staff accounting for 4,493 (30.2%);
- 11,101 (83.9%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition during the year 2025 was 304 staff including 33 staff for the month of December 2025.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.
- UG. Ntugamo Women was made an independent prison after being carved off Ntugamo Prison, hence raising the total number of prisons from 269 to 270.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of December 2025, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.2% (125) from 79,186 in November 2025 to 79,311.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 1.2% from 42,240 to 42,727;
- Remands decreased by 1.1% from 36,255 to 35,847;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 6.7% from 691 to 737;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners
- Occupancy rate increased by 0.5% from 341.6% at 342.1%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

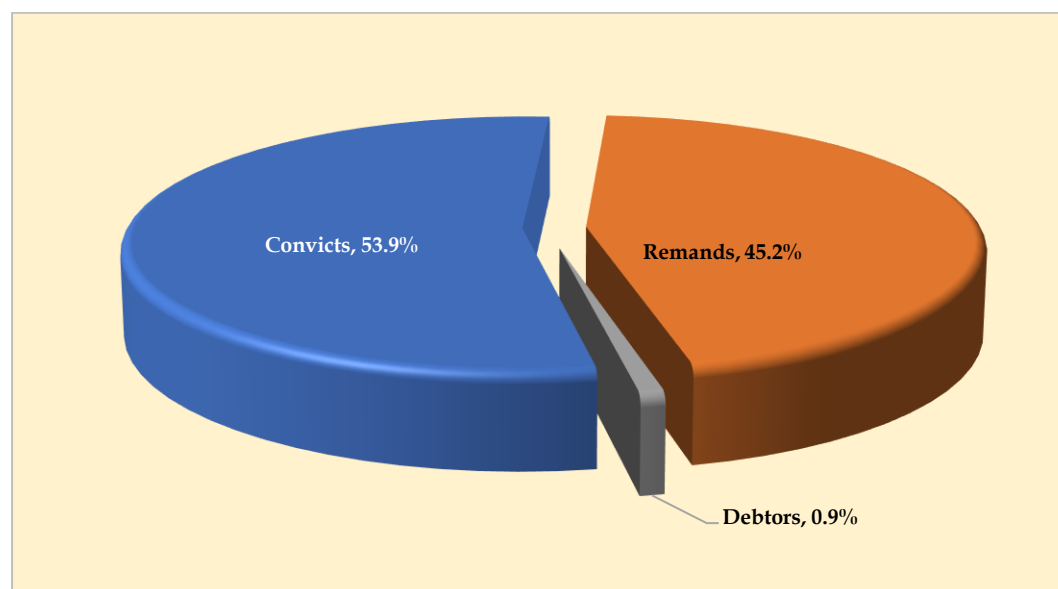


Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of December 2025, convicted prisoners composed of 53.9%, remand prisoners composed of 45.2%, while civil debtors composed of 0.9%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

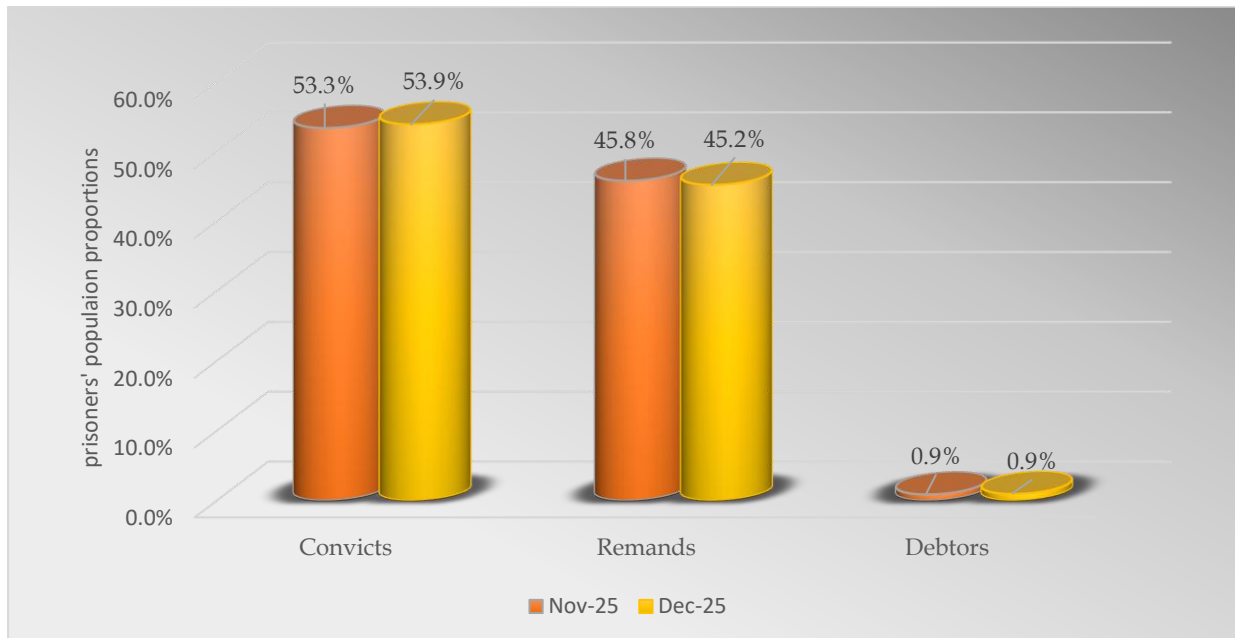


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with November 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.6% from 53.3% to 53.9%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 45.8% to 45.2% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.9%; of the average prison population in December 2025 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends for the year 2025

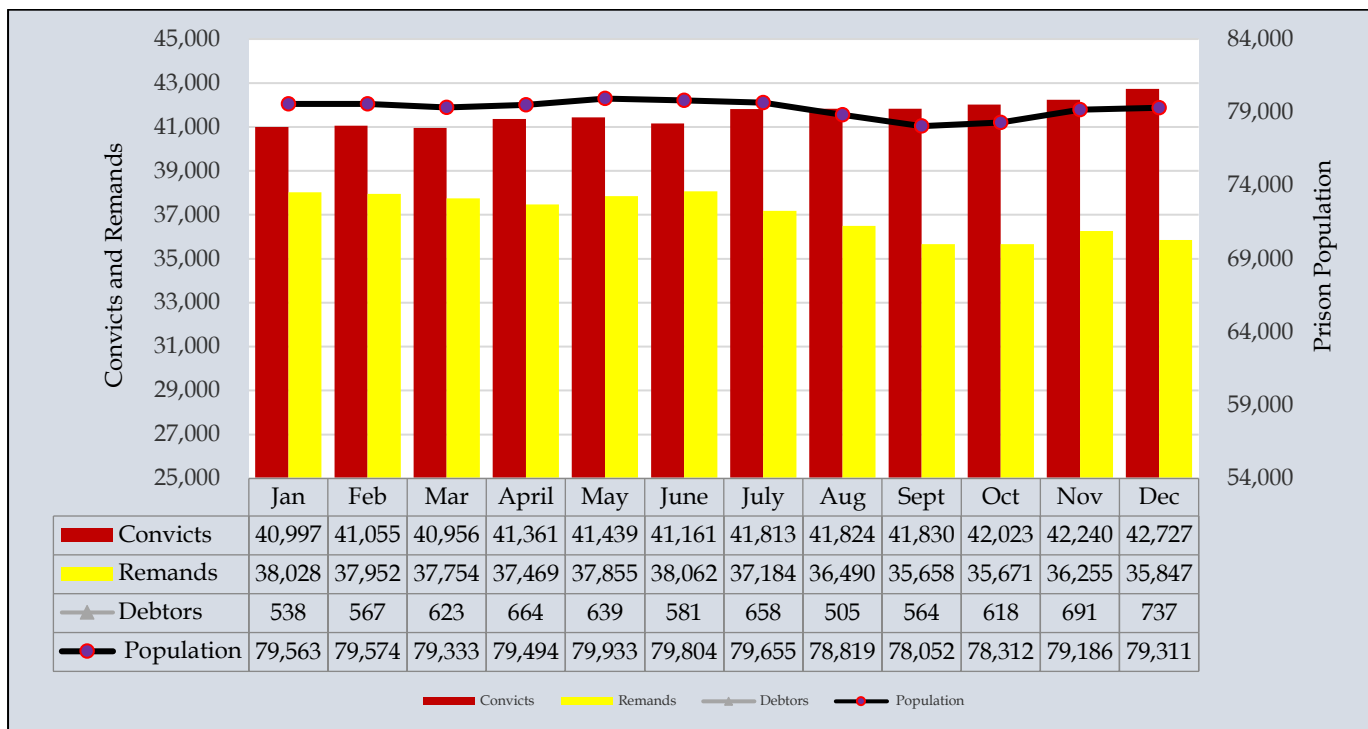


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the year 2025

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from January 2025 to December 2025. The figure indicates a general upward trend in the prison population during the first five months of the year 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually increased from 79,563 prisoners in January 2025 to 79,933 prisoners in May 2025. The prison population however started reflecting a fluctuating trend from 79,933 prisoners in May 2025, to the current 79,311 prisoners in December 2025 with the lowest reduction (78,052 prisoners) registered in September 2025.

1.5 Prison population composition trends for the year 2025

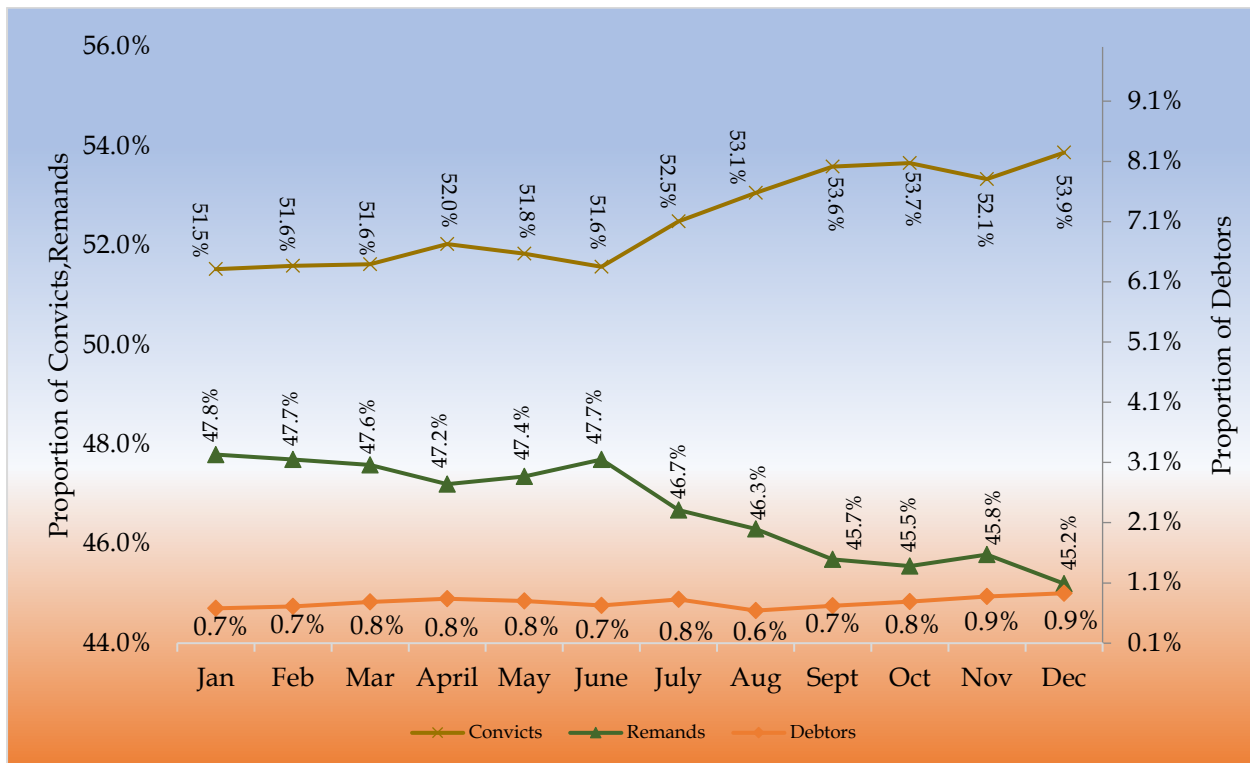


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for year 2025

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from January 2025 to December 2025. The proportion of the remand population oscilated below the 50.0% mark, decreasing from 47.8% in January 2025 to 45.2% in December 2025. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscilated above the 50.0% mark, increasing from 51.5% in January 2025 to 53.9% in December 2025. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of December, 2025;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Iganga by 4.1%; Mid Central by 3.4%; North Central 3.0%; Mid Western by 2.1%; South Western by 2.0%; North Eastern by 1.4%; Eastern by 1.3%; East Central and Mid Eastern by 1.0%; Western by 0.9%; and North Western by 0.05%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; Central by 2.4%, South Eastern by 2.2%; Kampala Extra by 1.9%; Kigezi, Kooki, and Southern by 1.3%; Northern by 0.6%; and Mid Northern by 0.4%.
3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 290.

4. The average number of debtors in custody was 737.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of December 2025. 7.0% of the prisons (19 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 136 prisons units were very congested, constituting 50.4% of the total prison units. Only 36 prison units constituting 13.3% had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 4 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of December 2025, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 9.2% from 37,264 in November 2025 to 33,840 prisoners, a daily average of 1,611 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in December 2025 increased by 10.5% from 2,305 in November 2025 to 2,546 prisoners, a daily average of 102 normal releases of convicts (*See Table 1.4*).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of December 2025 increased by 9.3% from 6,098 in November 2025 to 6,667 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered in 2025. Central region registered the highest number of escapes (26 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 12.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region had zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 3.5 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 274 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 139 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 50.7%.

1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of December 2025, the Service lost a total of twelve (12) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prisoners' National Referral Hospital is situated.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered in 2025. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 7.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki region had zero deaths of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 178 against the daily average prison population of 79,253 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 2.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The in service staff strength as at 31st December, 2025 was 13,717 out of which 13,234 were uniformed and 483 were non-uniformed officers. The Prisons Academy and Training School (PATS) had a total of 1,154 trainees (863 males and 291 females), hence the Service had an overall staff strength of 14,871 staff out of which 10,378 (69.8%) were males and 4,493 (30.2%) were females.– see Table 2.1 below.

Out of the 13,234 in Service uniformed staff, 11,101 (83.9%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

The total number of staff who were declared as deserters during the month of December 2025 was five (05), a decrease by 16.7% compared to the number declared as deserters in the previous month (November 2025) as indicated in Table 2.3 above.
