## MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

**JANUARY 2026**

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## ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of January 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of December 2025 and January 2026;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.01% from 79,311 to 79,322 prisoners;
- Convicts decreased by 1.3% from 42,727 to 42,178;
- Remands increased by 2.1% from 35,847 to 36,599;
- Civil debtors decreased by 26.1% from 737 to 545;
- Proportion of remand prisoners increased by 0.9% from 45.2% to 46.1%;
- Occupancy rate remained at 342.1%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners

To note also is that, during the month of January 2026;

- A total of 2,472 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 107 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 32,600 – *a daily average of 1,811 prisoners*;
- 9,783 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 6,088 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July 2025 and January 2026, prisoners' escape rate was 1.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 52.6%, while mortality rate stood at 1.3 per 1,000 prisoners;
- The in-service staff strength was 13,697 with 13,215 uniformed and 482 non-uniformed staff;
- 1,154 Recruit Warders and Wardresses (863 males and 291 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,851 with male staff accounting for 10,358 (69.7%) and female staff accounting for 4,493 (30.3%);
- 11,083 (83.9%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the period July 2025 and January 2026 was 187 staff including 19 staff for the month of January 2026.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

# 1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

## 1.1 Population Change

During the month of January 2026, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.01% (11) from 79,311 in December 2025 to 79,322.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts decreased by 1.3% from 42,727 to 42,178;
- b) Remands increased by 2.1% from 35,847 to 36,599;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors decreased by 26.1% from 737 to 545;
- d) Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners
- e) Occupancy rate remained 342.1%.

## 1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of January 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 53.2%, remand prisoners composed of 46.1%, while civil debtors composed of 0.7%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

### 1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of December 2025, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.7% from 53.9% to 53.2%, remand prisoners increased by 0.9% from 45.2% to 46.1% while that of civil debtors decreased by 0.2% from 0.9% to 0.7%; of the average prison population in January 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

### 1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends from July 2025 to January 2026




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July 2025-January 2026

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from July 2025 to January 2026. The figure indicates a general downward trend in the prison population between July 2025 and September 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually decreased from 79,655 prisoners to 78,052 prisoners. The prison population however, started depicting an upward trend from 78,052 prisoners in September 2025, to the current 79,322 prisoners in January 2026.

### 1.5 Prison population composition trends from July 2025 to January 2026




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2025 and January 2026

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from July 2025 to January 2026. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, decreasing from 46.7% in July 2025 to 45.2% in December 2025, with a slight increase to 46.1% in January 2026. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, increasing from 52.5% in July 2025 to 53.9% in December 2025, with a slight decrease to 53.2% in January 2026. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of January, 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Southern by 3.7%; Kampala Extra by 1.1%; Central 0.9%; Mid Eastern by 0.7%; East Central by 0.5%; North Western by 0.4%; South Eastern and South Western by 0.3%; and Eastern by 0.2%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; Iganga by 5.3%, Mid Central by 2.9%; Kigezi by 2.3%; Kooki by 1.5%; Northern by 0.7%; Western and Mid Northern by 0.6%; North Central by 0.4%; Mid Western by 0.1%; and North Eastern by 0.05%.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 270.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 545.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

### 1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of January 2026. 6.3% of the prisons (17 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 136 prison units were very congested, constituting 50.4% of the total prison units. Only 39 prison units had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 1 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of January 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice decreased by 3.7% from 33,840 in December 2025 to 32,600 prisoners, a daily average of 1,811 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in January 2026 decreased by 2.9% from 2,546 in December 2025 to 2,472 prisoners, a daily average of 107 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

### 1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of January 2026 decreased by 8.7% from 6,667 in December 2025 to 6,088 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of December, 2025, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of January 2026 significantly decreased by 68.4% resulting in a reduction in the escape rate by 0.1% as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered between July 2025 and January 2026. North Western region registered the highest number of escapes (13 escapees), however the number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Iganga region at 7.6 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region had zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 1.7 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that out of the 135 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 71 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 52.6%.

## 1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of January 2026, the Service lost a total of thirteen (13) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prisoners' National Referral Hospital is situated.

The number of deaths registered amongst prisoners during the month of January 2026 was 13, an increase by 8.3% from 12 death cases registered during the previous month (December 2025) as indicated in Table 1.12 above. The crude mortality rate remained at 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered between July 2025 and January 2026. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 4.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki, North Eastern and Central region had zero death of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 99 against the daily average prison population of 78,953 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

## 2 STAFFING POSITION

### 2.1 Staff Strength

The in service staff strength as at 31<sup>st</sup> January 2026 was 13,697 out of which 13,215 were uniformed and 482 were non-uniformed officers. The Prisons Academy and Training School (PATS) had a total of 1,154 trainees (863 males and 291 females), hence the Service had an overall staff strength of 14,851 staff out of which 10,358 (69.7%) were males and 4,493 (30.3%) were females.– see Table 2.1 below.

Of the 13,215 in Service uniformed staff, 11,083 (83.9%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 above shows that, during the period between July 2025 and January 2026, Uganda Prisons Service lost a total of 186 staff with retirement being the leading staff attrition mode, constituting up to 43.0% of the overall attrition.
