



# UGANDA PRISONS SERVICE

## MONTHLY STATISTICAL ABSTRACT

**FEBRUARY 2026**

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## ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of February 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of January and February 2026;

- The daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.1% from 79,322 to 79,419 prisoners;
- Convicts decreased by 0.8% from 42,178 to 41,850;
- Remands increased by 1.0% from 36,599 to 36,964;
- Civil debtors increased by 11.0% from 545 to 605;
- Proportion of remand prisoners increased by 0.4% from 46.1% to 46.5%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 0.5% from 342.1% to 342.6%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners

To note also is that, during the month of February 2026;

- A total of 2,222 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 97 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 38,680 – *a daily average of 2,036 prisoners*;
- 9,828 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 7,772 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July 2025 and February 2026, prisoners' escape rate was 1.9 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 52.4%, while mortality rate stood at 1.4 per 1,000 prisoners;
- 1,240 Trainees (914 males and 326 females) were still undergoing training at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,867 with male staff accounting for 10,352 (69.6%) and female staff accounting for 4,515 (30.34%);
- 10,917 (75.9%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the period July 2025 and February 2026 was 217 staff including 27 staff for the month of February 2026.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

# 1 CHARACTERISTICS OF PRISONERS' POPULATION

## 1.1 Population Change

During the month of February 2026, the overall daily average population of prisoners increased by 0.1% (97) from 79,322 in January 2026 to 79,419.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- a) Convicts decreased by 0.8% from 42,178 to 41,850;
- b) Remands increased by 1.0% from 36,599 to 36,964;
- c) Civil/judgment debtors increased by 11.0% from 545 to 605;
- d) Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,184 prisoners
- e) Occupancy rate increased by 0.5% from 342.1% to 342.6%.

## 1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors




Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of February 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 52.7%, remand prisoners composed of 46.5%, while civil debtors composed of 0.8%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

### 1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors




Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of January 2026, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners decreased by 0.5% from 53.2% to 52.7%, remand prisoners increased by 0.4% from 46.1% to 46.5% while that of civil debtors increased by 0.1% from 0.7% to 0.8%; of the average prison population in February 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

### 1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends from July 2025 to February 2026




Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July 2025-February 2026

Figure 1.3 above shows the prison population trend from July 2025 to February 2026. The figure indicates a general downward trend in the prison population between July 2025 and September 2025. During this period, the monthly prison population gradually decreased from 79,655 prisoners to 78,052 prisoners. The prison population however, started portraying an upward trend from 78,312 prisoners in October 2025, to the current 79,419 prisoners in February 2026.

### 1.5 Prison population composition trends from July 2025 to February 2026




Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2025 and February 2026

Figure 1.4 above shows the proportion of convicts, remands, and debtors of the total prison population from July 2025 to February 2026. The proportion of the remand population oscillated below the 50.0% mark, decreasing from 46.7% in July 2025 to 45.2% in January 2026, with an increase to 46.5% in February 2026. On the other hand, the proportion of convicts oscillated above the 50.0% mark, increasing from 52.5% in July 2025 to 53.9% in January 2026, with a decrease to 52.7% in February 2026. On average, the proportion of debtors was 0.8% of the overall prison population for the entire period.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of February, 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Southern by 3.7%; Western by 3.0%; North Western 2.9%; South Eastern and Mid Eastern by 1.8%; North Eastern by 1.6%; North Central by 1.5%; Kooki by 0.5%; Northern and Eastern by 0.4%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; Mid Northern by 4.0%, Iganga by 2.7%; South Western by 2.0%; Kigezi by 1.9%; Mid Central by 1.6%; East Central by 1.4%; Kampala Extra by 0.6%; Mid Western by 0.3%; and Central by 0.2%.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 281.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 605.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

### 1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of February 2026. 7.4% of the prisons (20 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 132 prison units were very congested with congestion levels between 301% and 600%, constituting 48.9% of the total prison units. Only 39 prison units had congestion levels below 200%. See Annex 4 showing the stations under each category.

During the month of February 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 18.7% from 32,600 in January 2026 to 38,680 prisoners, a daily average of 2,036 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in February 2026 decreased by 10.1% from 2,472 in January 2026 to 2,222 prisoners, a daily average of 97 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

### 1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of February 2026 increased by 27.7% from 6,088 in January 2026 to 7,772 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

Table 1.10 indicates the escapes registered between July 2025 and February 2026. The number of escapees per 1,000 prisoners was highest in Kooki region at 9.0 escapees per 1,000 prisoners and lowest in Western Region at 0.7 per 1,000 prisoners. Kampala Extra region had zero escapes during the time period. The overall escape rate during the period was 1.9 escapees per 1,000 prisoners. It is noteworthy that of the 147 prisoners who had escaped from lawful custody during the period, 77 had been recaptured, representing a recapture rate of 52.4%.

## 1.12 Mortality of Prisoners

During the month of February 2026, the Service lost a total of twelve (12) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prisoners' National Referral Hospital is situated.

The number of deaths registered amongst prisoners during the month of February 2026 was 12, a decrease by 7.7% from 13 death cases registered during the previous month (January 2026) as indicated in Table 1.12 above. The monthly crude mortality rate remained at 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the mortality of prisoners registered between July 2025 and February 2026. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 4.9 deaths per 1,000 prisoners. Kooki, North Eastern and Central region had not registered death of prisoners during the time period. The overall number of deaths in the time period was 111 against the daily average prison population of 79,012 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.4 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

## 2 STAFFING POSITION

### 2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 28<sup>th</sup> February 2026 was 14,867 constituting 10,352 (69.6%) males and 4,515 (30.4%) females. Of the same strength, 14,388 were uniformed staff while 479 were non-uniformed staff. Of the 14,388 uniformed staff, 1,240 staff (914 males and 326 females) were undergoing the Basic Prison Training Course at the Prisons Academy and Training School (PATS) in Luzira as shown in Table 2.1 below.

Of the 14,388 uniformed staff, 10,917 (75.9%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.

Table 2.4 above shows that, during the period between July 2025 and February 2026, Uganda Prisons Service lost a total of 217 staff with retirement being the leading staff attrition mode, constituting up to 43.8% of the overall attrition.
