ABSTRACT

The report includes among other details; the prison population growth, convict-remand ratio, occupancy levels, prison escapes and deaths, and the staff strength during the month of April, 2026.

To note therefore is that between the month of March and April 2026;

- The daily average prison population increased by 0.4% from 79,698 to 80,010 prisoners;
- Convicts increased by 1.4% from 42,236 to 42,833;
- Remands decreased by 0.8% from 36,783 to 36,493;
- Civil debtors increased by 0.7% from 679 to 684;
- Proportion of remand prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 46.2% to 45.6%;
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.4% from 342.7% to 344.1%;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,254 prisoners

To note also is that, during the month of April, 2026;

- A total of 2,570 convicted prisoners were normally released after completion of their sentences – *a daily average of 107 releases*;
- Number of prisoners produced to courts were 44,719 – *a daily average of 2,236 prisoners*;
- 12,911 prisoners were newly admitted from court while 9,487 were released from courts due to various reasons;
- For the period July 2025 and April 2026, prisoners' escape rate was 2.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, recapture rate at 53.8%, while mortality rate stood at 1.9 per 1,000 prisoners;
- 1,238 Trainees (912 males and 326 females) completed the Basic Prisons Management Course at the Prisons Academy and Training School, Luzira and passed out by H.E The Vice President of Uganda on the 17th April 2026.
- Overall, staff strength was 14,833 with male staff accounting for 10,316 (69.5%) and female staff accounting for 4,517 (30.5%);
- 11,693 (81.5%) of the uniformed staff were deployed in the 270 custodial prison units countrywide;
- Staff attrition for the period between July 2025 and April 2026 was 256 staff including 21 staff for the month of April 2026.
- The staff-to-prisoner ratio remained at 1:7.

1.1 Population Change

During the month of April 2026, the overall daily average prison population increased by 0.4% (312) from 79,698 in March 2026 to 80,010 prisoners.

During the same period as observed from Table 1.1:

- Convicts increased by 1.4% from 42,236 to 42,833;
- Remands decreased by 0.8% from 36,783 to 36,493;
- Civil/judgment debtors increased by 0.7% from 679 to 684;
- Prisons holding capacity remained at 23,254 prisoners;
- Occupancy rate increased by 1.4% from 342.7% to 344.1%.

1.2 Percentage composition of Remands, Convicts and Debtors

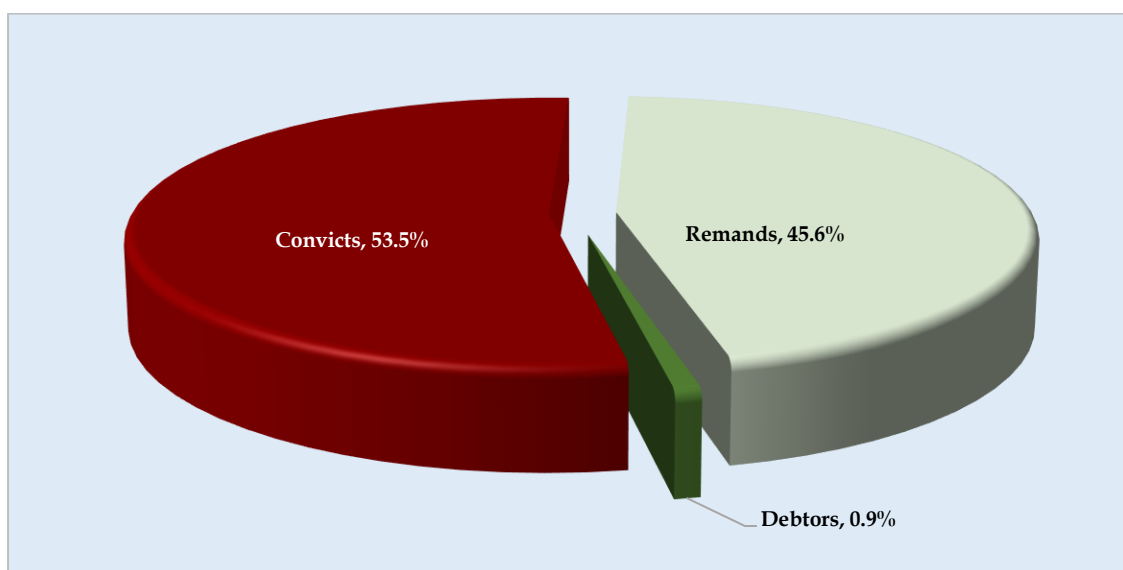


Figure 1.1 Composition of the Prison population

During the month of April 2026, convicted prisoners composed of 53.5%, remand prisoners composed of 45.6%, while civil debtors composed of 0.9%, of the daily average prison population as indicated in Figure 1.1 above.

1.3 Percentage composition change of Remands, Convicts, and Debtors

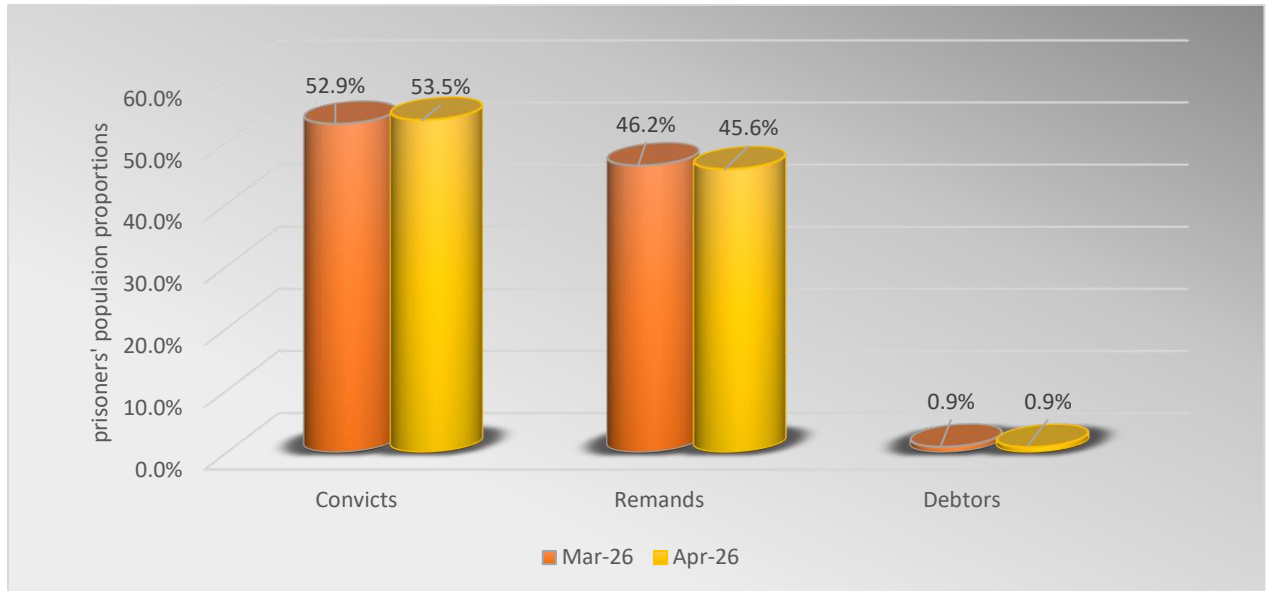


Figure 1.2 Percentage composition of remands, convicts and debtors

In comparison with the month of March 2026, the percentage composition of convicted prisoners increased by 0.6% from 52.9% to 53.5%, remand prisoners decreased by 0.6% from 46.2% to 45.6% while that of civil debtors remained at 0.9%; of the average prison population in April 2026 as indicated in the Figure 1.2 above.

1.4 Monthly Prison Population trends from July 2025 to April 2026

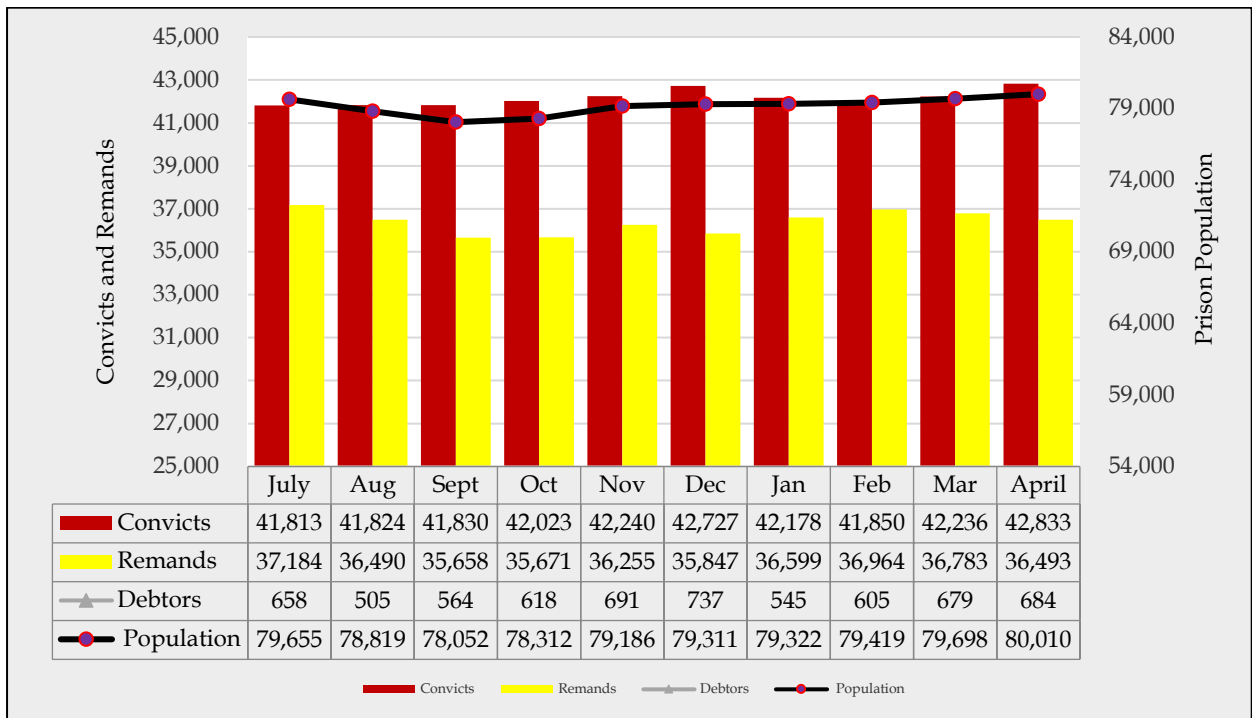


Figure 1.3 Monthly prison population trend for the period July 2025-April 2026

Figure 1.3 above illustrates the trend in prison population from July 2025 through April 2026. The combo chart shows an overall decline in the prison population during the first three months of the financial year 2025/26. Throughout this time, the number of prisoners in prison gradually declined from 79,655 in July 2025 to 78,052 in September 2025. The prison population count, however, has consistently risen from 78,312 prisoners recorded in October 2025 to the present 80,010 prisoners in April 2026.

1.5 Prison population composition trends from July 2025 to April 2026

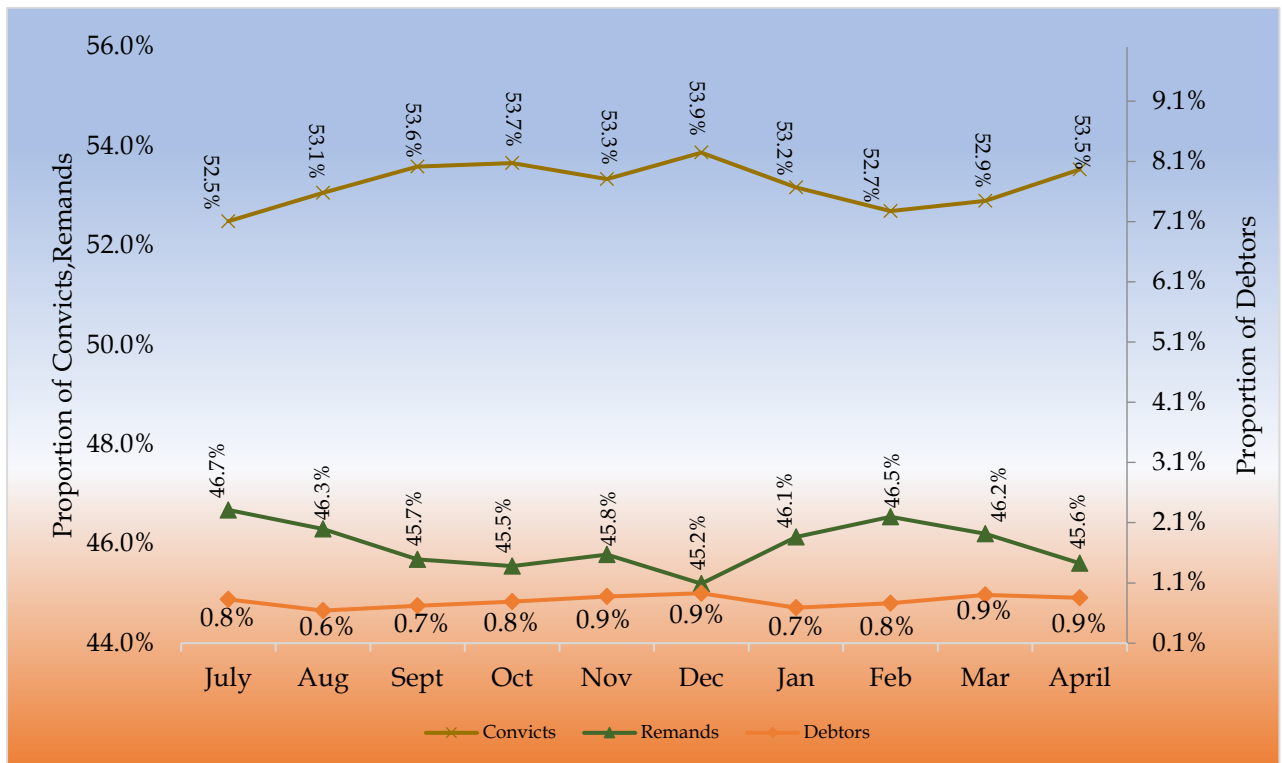


Figure 1.4 Composition trends of convicts, remands, and debtors for the period between July 2025 and April 2026

Figure 1.4 above illustrates the ratio of convicts, remands, and debtors within the overall prison population from July 2025 to April 2026. The percentage of the remand population fluctuated under the 50.0% threshold, dropping from 46.7% in July 2025 to 45.2% in December 2025, then rising to 45.6% in April 2026. Conversely, the percentage of convicts fluctuated above the 50.0% threshold, rising from 52.5% in July 2025 to 53.9% in December 2025, followed by a slight drop to 53.5% in April 2026. The average percentage of debtors represented 0.8% of the total prison population throughout the entire duration.

Table 1.2 shows that during the month of April, 2026;

1. The regional prison population increased in the following regions; Iganga by 9.8%; Mid Central by 7.7%; East Central and South Western by 4.4%; Kooki by 2.6%; Mid Northern and Western by 1.4%; Kigezi by 0.8%; North Western by 0.3%; Eastern by 0.2%; and Kampala Extra by 0.1%.
2. The regional prison population however, decreased in the following regions; South Eastern by 4.5%, North Central by 4.2%; Mid Western by 2.9%; Central by 2.6%; Southern by 2.3%; North Eastern by 0.8%; Mid Eastern by 0.5%; and Northern by 0.4%.

3. The average number of children staying in prisons with their incarcerated mothers was 257.
4. The average number of debtors in custody was 684.
5. The staff to prisoner ratio remained at 1:7. The number of prisoners per custodial staff ranged between four (4) and ten (10) across the 19 administrative regions.

1.7 Status of Congestion/Occupancy levels in prison units

Table 1.3 below shows the levels of congestion in prisons during the month of April 2026. Only 7.8% of the prisons (21 prison units) were extremely congested with occupancy levels of above 600%. 138 prison units were very congested with congestion levels of above 300% upto 600%, representing 51.1% of the total prison units and 38 prison units had congestion levels below 200%. During the month of April 2026, the outturn of prisoners delivered to judicial courts countrywide to access justice increased by 4.4% from 42,835 in March 2026 to 44,719 prisoners, a daily average of 2,236 prisoners. (See Table 1.4).

The outturn of normal releases of convicts in April 2026 decreased by 6.1% from 2,738 in March 2026 to 2,570 prisoners, a daily average of 107 normal releases of convicts (See Table 1.4).

1.9 Releases of remand prisoners

The outturn of prisoners released from court during the month of April 2026 increased by 4.1% from 9,111 in March 2026 to 9,487 prisoners. The breakdown is as shown in Table 1.5 below.

In comparison with the month of March 2026, the number of prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during the month of April 2026 decreased by 30.4% from 23 prison escapes to 16 prison escapes. This resulted into a decrease in the monthly escape rate by 0.1% as indicated in Table 1.9 above.

Table 1.10 shows the recorded prison escapes that occurred from July 2025 to April 2026. In the Kooki region, the escapee rate was the highest at 12.3 escapees per 1,000 prisoners, while Kampala Extra Region recorded the lowest rate at 0.1 per 1,000 prisoners. The overall prison escape rate for the time frame was 2.3 escapees for every 1,000 prisoners. It is important to highlight that, out of the 186 prisoners who escaped from lawful custody during this timeframe, 100 have been recaptured, indicating a recapture rate of 53.8%.

1.12 Prison Mortality

During the month of April 2026, the Service lost a total of twenty-two (22) prisoners through deaths, majority of whom died from Murchison Bay prison where the prisoners' National Referral Hospital is situated.

The number of prison deaths recorded during the month of April 2026 was 22, an increase by 57.1% from 14 deaths registered during the previous month (March 2026) as indicated in Table 1.12 above. The monthly crude mortality rate increased by 0.1 from 0.2 deaths per 1,000 prisoners to 0.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

Table 1.13 above shows the prison mortality recorded between July 2025 and April 2026. Kampala Extra region had the highest crude mortality rate at 6.3 deaths per 1,000 prisoners while North Eastern Region recorded no prison death during the time period. The overall prison deaths in the time period was 147 against the daily average prison population of 79,180 prisoners, reflecting an overall crude mortality rate of 1.9 deaths per 1,000 prisoners.

2 STAFFING POSITION

2.1 Staff Strength

The Service staff strength as at 30th April 2026 was 14,833 constituting 10,316 (69.5%) males and 4,517 (30.5%) females. Of the same strength, 14,354 were uniformed staff while 479 were non-uniformed staff.

Of the 14,354 uniformed staff, 11,693 (81.5%) were deployed in custodial units across the 270 Prisons countrywide. Therefore, the overall staff-to-prisoner ratio was 1:7 against the ideal of 1:3.
